The Knife and Fork Club was founded on November 29, 1898, by attorneys Herbert Hadley, Denton Dunn, and J. J. Vineyard as a monthly dinner club for business and professional men. By 1902, membership totaled about 400. The club disbanded in 1934. The club's dinners hosted many prominent, national and local personalities. Members included notables such as William Allen White and James A. Reed.
