Historical Sketch

Bishop Lillis High School, 3740 Forest Avenue, in Kansas City, Missouri, opened in April 1941, and was named after Bishop Thomas F. Lillis, the Bishop of Kansas City, Missouri, for the Catholic Church from 1915 to 1938. The high school closed in 1978 and the De La Salle Education Center moved into the facility in 1979. The building has since been renovated and expanded for the education center.
