### **Kansas City Public Works Collection (SC163)**

#### Introduction

This collection contains reports, correspondence, permits, regulations, blueprints, and notes concerning the operations of the Kansas City Public Works Department in the early to mid-20th century. The majority of the collection relates to the construction, operation, and maintenance of area sewers, water lines, and their infrastructure.

#### **Biographical/Historical Sketch**

The Kansas City Public Works Department (also known as the Department of Public Works of Kansas City) has its origins in the appointment of the first City Engineer, Fred Breckinridge, for the Town of Kansas in 1855. As Kansas City developed and expanded during the 19th and 20th centuries, the duties of the City Engineer's office developed and expanded as well, transforming into the Standing Committee of Public Works, then the Board of Public Works, and eventually into the Public Works Department. The Public Works Department oversees city planning, construction,

maintenance, and engineering projects, including issues relating to roads, buildings and structures, sewers, waste disposal, water service, and utilities.

#### Scope and Content Note

This collection contains reports, correspondence, permits, regulations, blueprints, and notes concerning the operations of the Kansas City Public Works Department in the early to mid-20th century. The majority of the collection relates to the construction, operation, and maintenance of area sewers, water lines, and their infrastructure. Much of the collection appears to have been part of the office files for O. M. Nichols, a sewer engineer for the city.

The collection is arranged primarily by department and subject, and therein by project, type, and date. Oversize blueprints, notes, and charts have been removed and stored in a  $20 \times 24$  in. box and a map cabinet drawer.

#### Series 1: Engineering Department annual reports, 1915, 1916, and 1919

This series contains annual reports produced by the Public Works Engineering Department. The reports include details on street improvement work, contractors, project costs, highways, structural issues, and sewers. There are two copies of the 1919 report.

#### Series 2: Sewer reports and construction materials, 1905-1961 and n.d.

Materials in this series relate to the construction of sewers in both Jackson and Clay counties by the Kansas City Public Works Department. Reports include information and updates on various construction projects, including details of sewer mileage, costs, contractors, funding, and payments. Also included are law and regulatory information, applications, permits, and correspondence pertaining to the Missouri Water Pollution Board for sewer work along the Missouri River and Big Blue River. The applications were approved by the City Engineer of Kansas City and then submitted to the Missouri Water Pollution Board for review and approval. Many of the applications correlate to the permits contained in this series. Some of the permits also contain correspondence regarding details of projects under consideration.

# Series 3: Sewer correspondence, operations, projects, and miscellaneous materials, 1918-1978 and n.d.

This series consists of items concerning the operations and functions of the Kansas City sewer system. Included are correspondence and reports relating to issues with sewers in and around the city. Specific areas discussed include the Kansas City Stockyards and the Blue River area. The series also contains miscellaneous items related to sewers and the Public Works Department, including a report of wells and cisterns, a chart of city toilet facilities, a Public Works newsletter, rock elevation lists, information on a traffic accident involving two employees from the City Engineer's office, and correspondence from the Missouri Bureau of Public Health Engineering.

#### Series 4: Manhole construction materials and list, 1947-1962 and n.d.

This series contains materials product specifications and pricing information, as well as construction blueprints, drawings, and notes relating to manholes built and used by the Public Works Department. Also included is a list of manholes used in snow removal.

#### Series 5: Pollution Control Department, 1961-1970

Materials in this series include correspondence, reports, a program summary, progress reports, and policy, regulation, and a fee schedule relating to the Pollution Control Department of Kansas City. Catch basin maintenance, joint sewage treatment facilities for Kansas City, Missouri and Kansas City, Kansas, industrial waste issues, and project bidding information are some of the topics discussed.

#### Series 6: Grandview Airport construction, 1940-1949 and n.d.

This series contains materials regarding the construction of the Grandview Airport in the 1940s. Included are newspaper clippings on the project and its role in the war effort, construction guidelines, reports, correspondence, materials product information, topography studies, cost and bidding information, proposals, blueprints, drawings, and notes. Most of these items relate to the airport's sewers and manhole construction. Correspondence and regulations for contracts with the Works Progress Administration (WPA) are also included.
