Biographical/Historical Sketch

J. W. Jenkins and Sons Music Company was founded in 1878 by John Woodward Jenkins. The company was headquartered in Kansas City in its flagship store at 1217 Walnut. By the mid 20th century, Jenkins Music had grown to be one of the largest music stores in the county, with locations in five different states, but its success faded in the following decades. It was sold to the Minnesota-based Schmitt Music Company in 1997.

Scope and Content Note

This collection contains items produced by Jenkins Music Co. for its employees. Included are an employee manual and eight issues of *The Chimes*, the company newsletter. Also included are two photographs: one of a 1962 Christmas party, and the other of a dinner for the Sheet Music Department from an unknown date.
