Biographical/Historical Sketch

The Kansas City Council on Education was established in June 1947 with a focus on "the advancement of education in all of its phases and the creation of citizen interest on education." It was comprised of delegates from local business, community, social, philanthropy, education, and religious organizations. The council met to discuss the actions of the school board, as well as financing, personnel and building issues, and the "post-war demands on education." Its goal was to create and present recommendations to address educational issues to school and city leaders.

Scope and Content Note

This collection contains minutes from meetings from June through December 1947. These minutes contain information on the structure and purpose of the committee, its officers, attendance and delegates, discussions, and actions.
