Collection Description

Scope and content note

The collection was originally comprised of 65 audiocassettes containing interviews of 59 people from Kansas City's Hispanic community. It was also referred to as the Mexican-American archives project. In 2008, CDs were produced from the audiocassettes. Subjects interviewed cover a substantial cross-section of the population, ranging from state legislators to persons who were unemployed at the time of the interview. The interviews follow a common structure, beginning with the subject's origins and largely moving chronologically through their life. Six of the interviews are in Spanish and 51 of the interviews have a printed guide which summarizes the contents of the tapes. There are also 55 handwritten summaries from which the printed guides were produced. Several of the manuscript summaries do not have tapes in the collection. The interviewer

was Irene Ruiz, former librarian of the West Branch (Irene H. Ruiz Biblioteca de las Americas) of the Kansas City Public Library.
