Collection Description

Scope and content note

This collection consists of local aerial views taken by the Curtiss or Curtiss-Wright Flying Service, Photo Division, 350 West 31st Street, New York City. This company's name was formed in 1929 from pioneer aircraft engine developer and airplane manufacturer Glenn Curtiss and the famous Wright brothers. There are 57 images, all 8" x 10" and black and white. Most of the photographs are not dated, but they appear to have been taken in the circa 1930s time period. All were placed in a cardboard paper frame as found in the first folder of the box. Although these were mostly labeled "Kansas City", the photos also include areas around Kansas City, Missouri.

Views include the downtown area; West Bottoms; Kansas City, Missouri; Kansas City, Kansas; the riverfront; and industrial areas. Some interesting views of the midtown area of Kansas City include the Union Station and Liberty Memorial. Other views include the Fairfax area, Municipal Airport, college campus scenes, and rural areas mostly unidentified. The collection includes an interesting mix of aerial views of the metropolitan area.

A number of pictures of the Curtiss-Wright Flying Service appeared in the local newspaper, probably in the *Journal Post*. One of the scrapbooks found in the department's unprocessed area had a number of these newspaper pictures in it. They were extracted from the scrapbook and added to this collection, being placed in the front of the box. The other pictures in this scrapbook were added to the vertical files.
