Historical Sketch

The Grand Army of the Republic was an organization for veterans of the Union Army who served in the American Civil War. The organization was founded in 1866 in Decatur, Illinois and grew to include local units throughout the nation. The A.D. McCook Post No. 34 was mustered in September 30, 1882 by William Warner and Albion P. Pease.

Scope and Content Note

This collection consists of one record book for A.D. McCook Post No. 34, located in Lamar, Missouri, of the Grand Army of the Republic. The record book contains 346 numbered entries that show the name of soldier, age, birthplace, residence, occupation, entry into the service, date of muster, nature of wounds received, and remarks. A name index is housed with the record book, and available upon request.
