To the Future...with its unmeasured store of faith and hope and love.

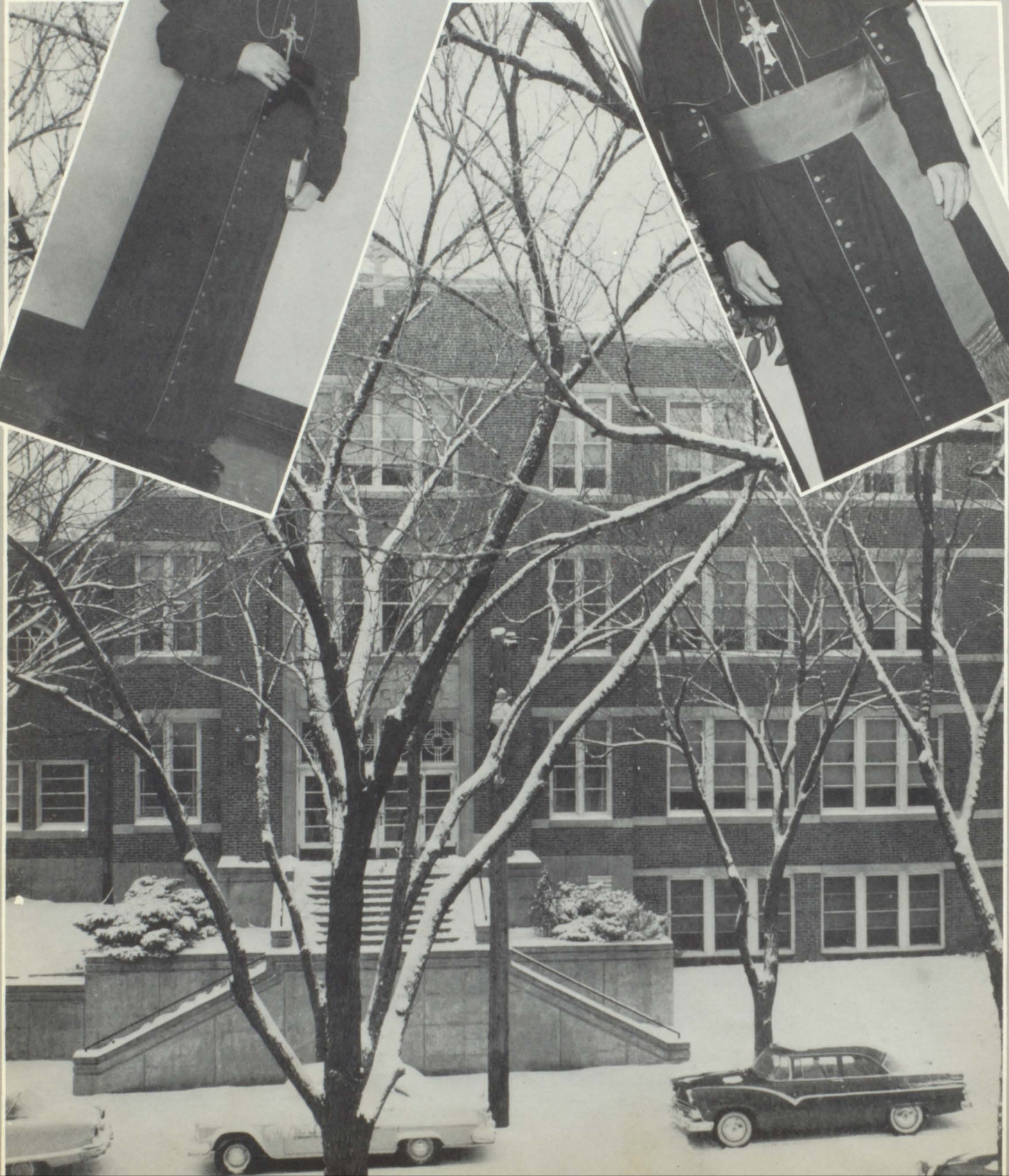

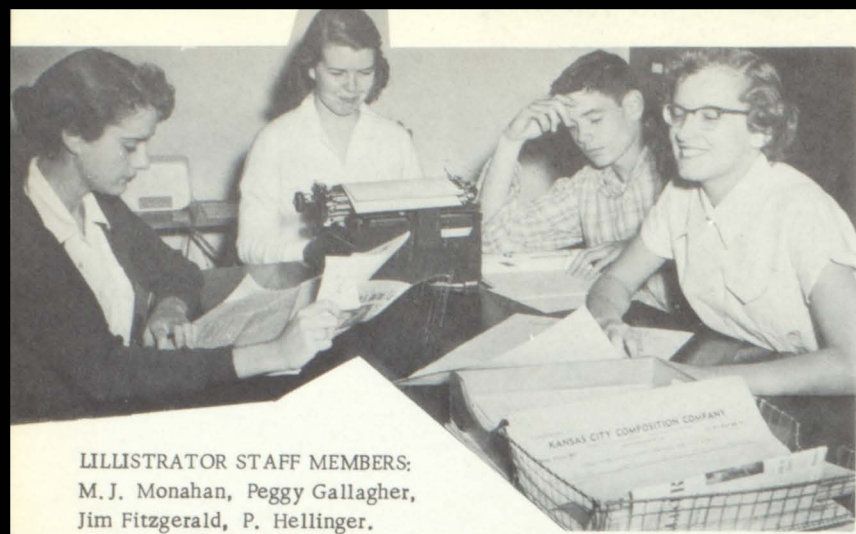

DRAFTING

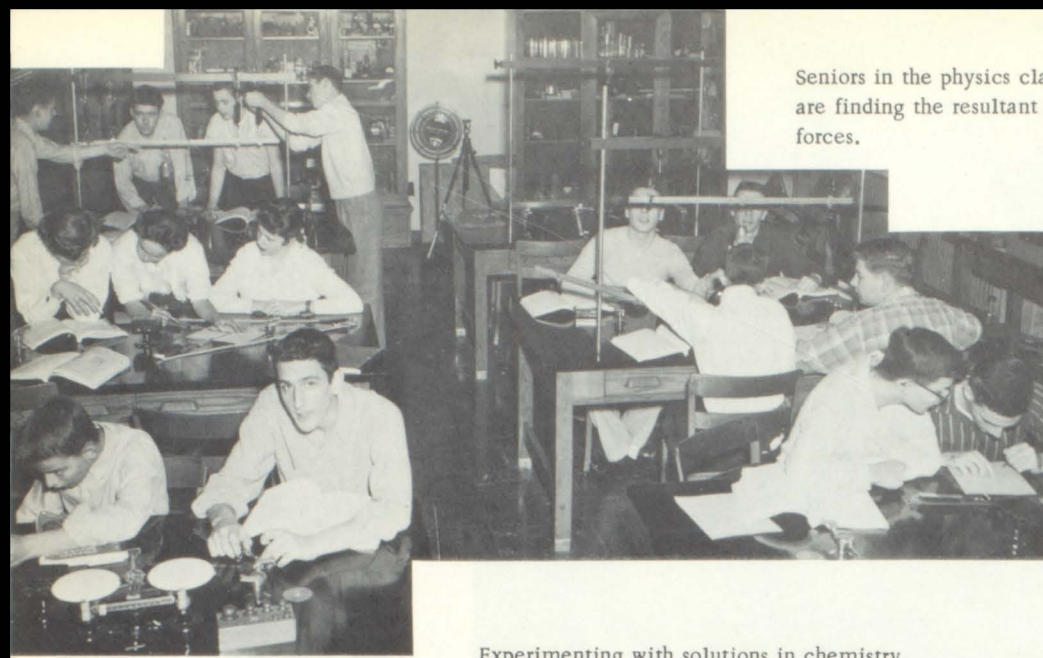

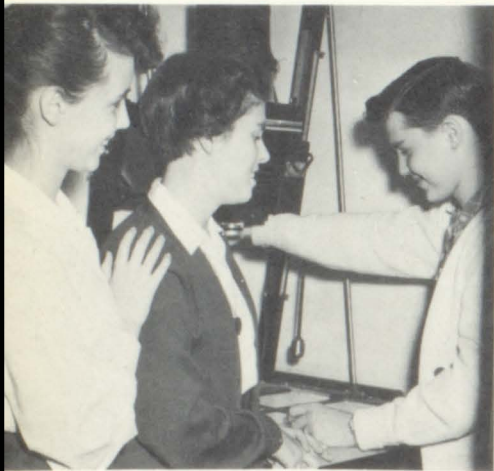

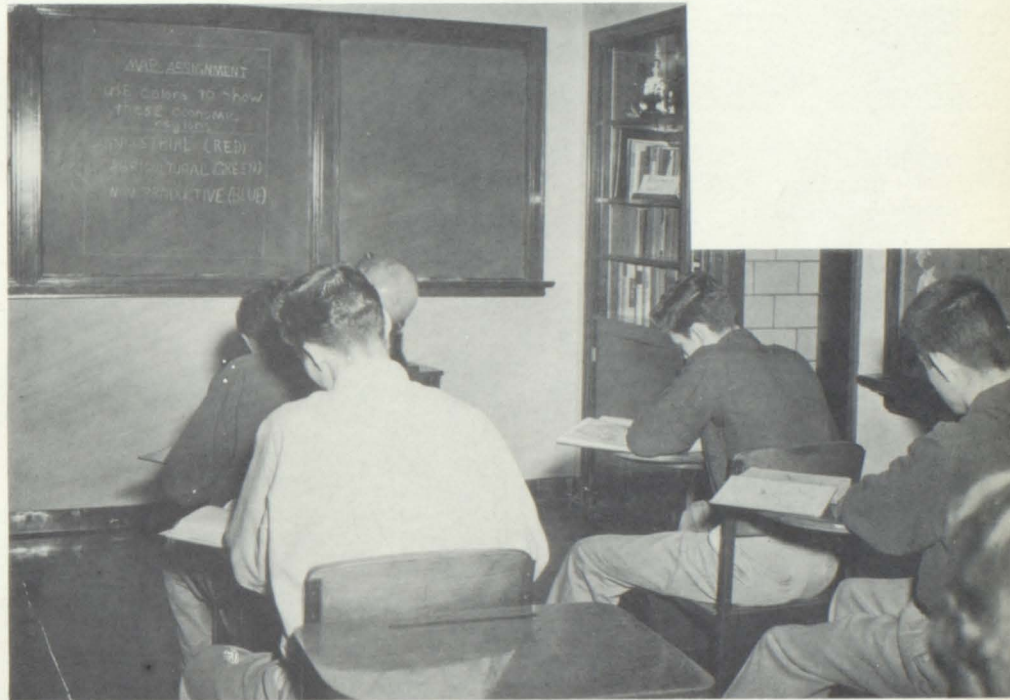

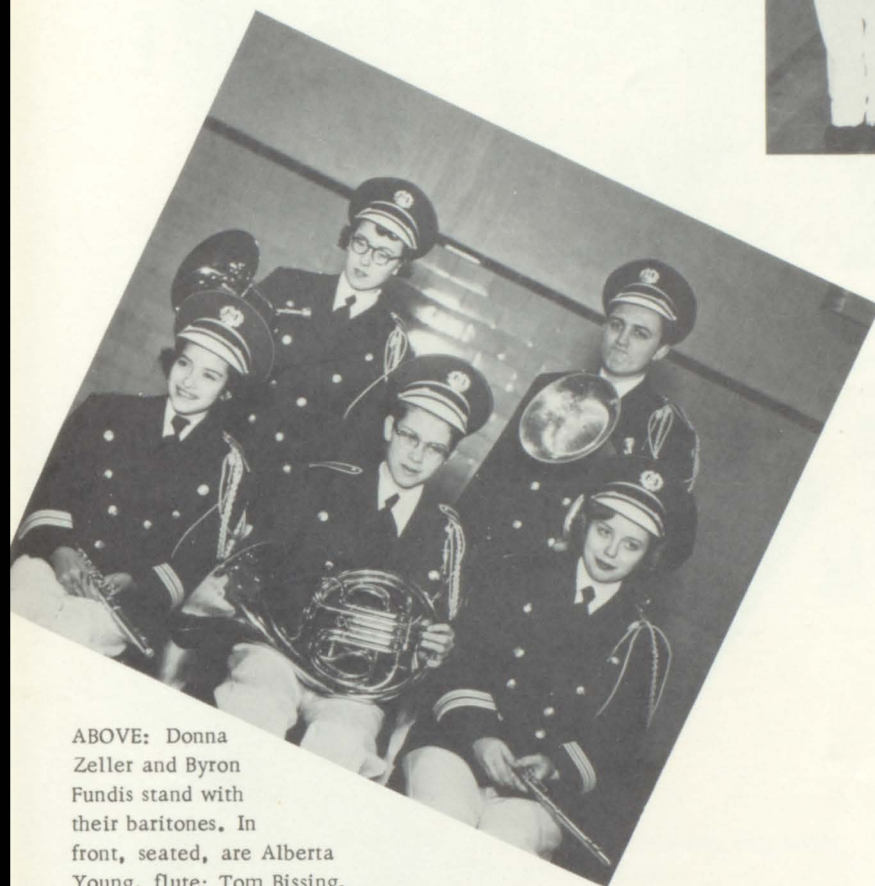

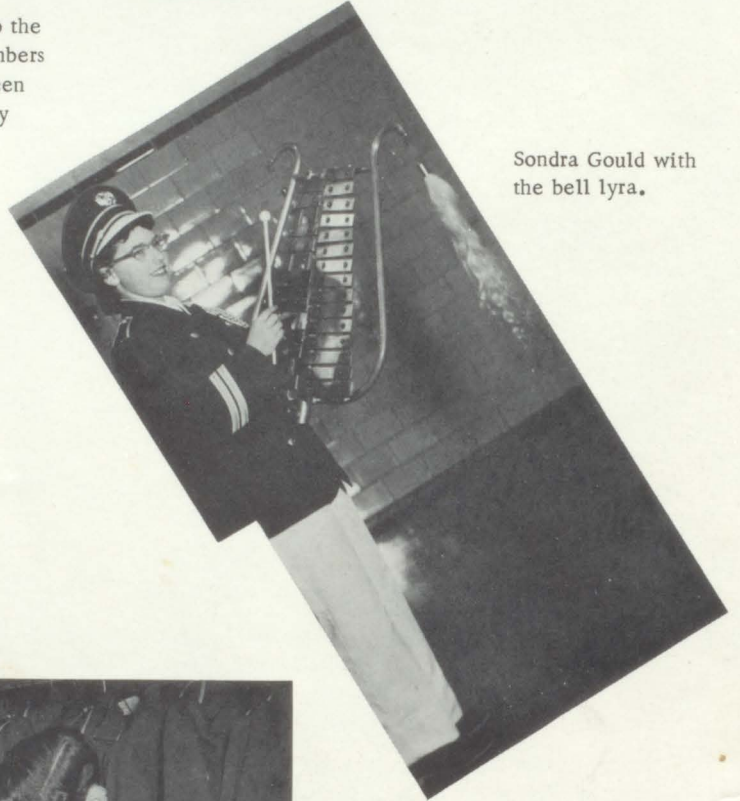

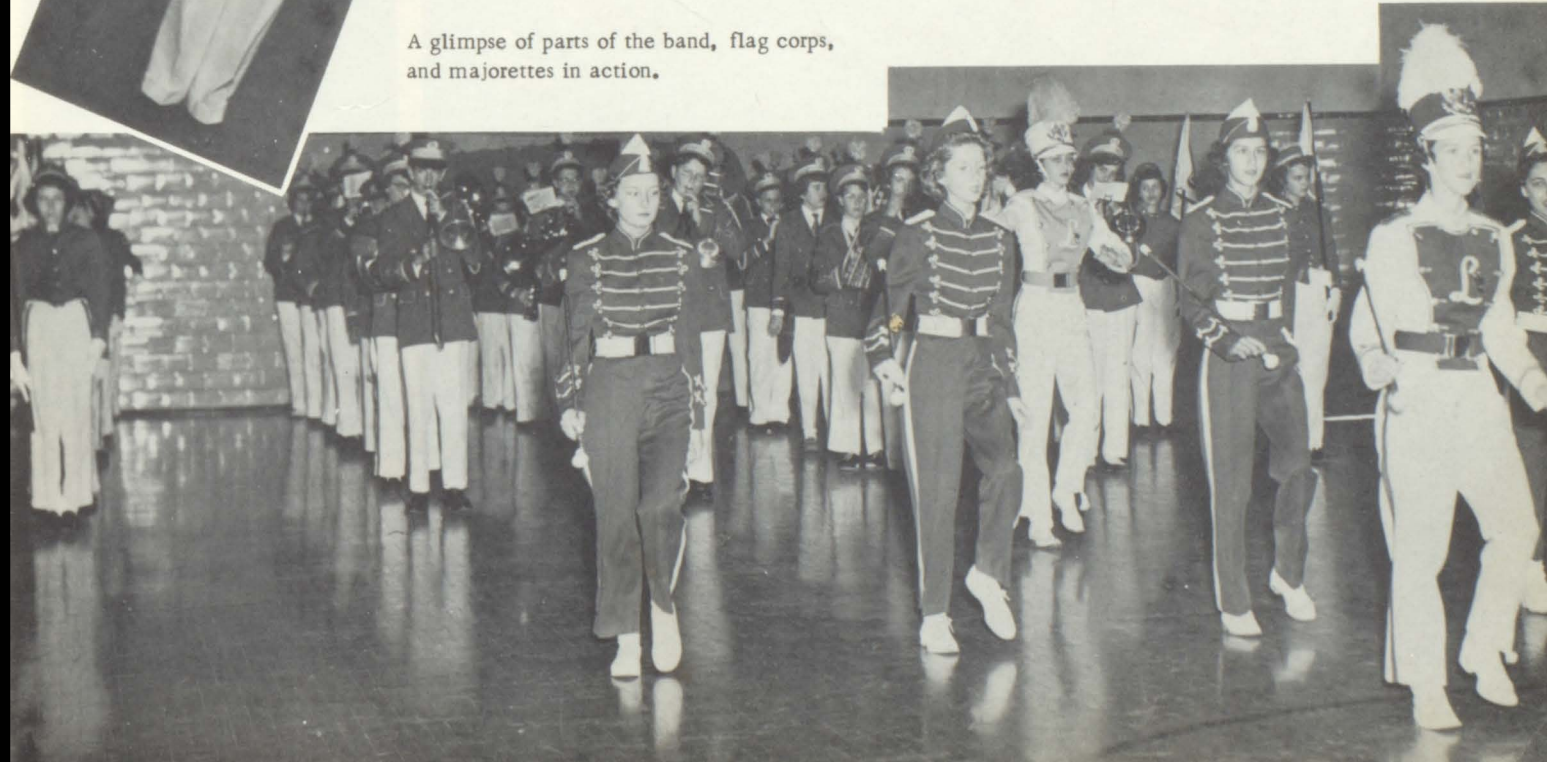

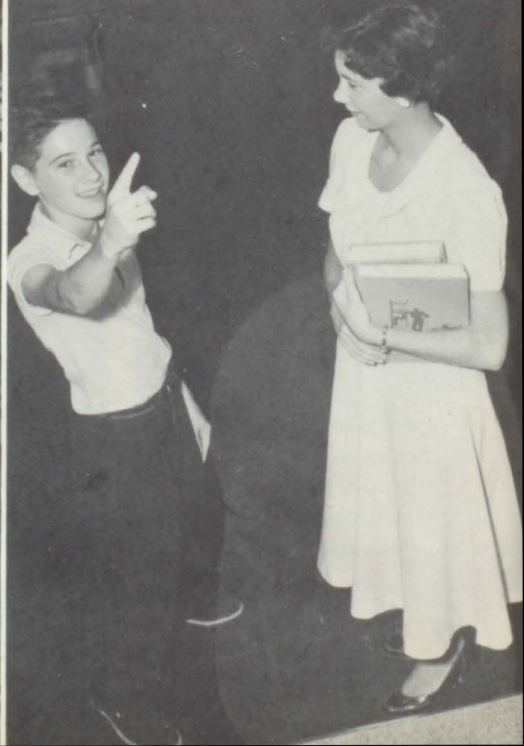

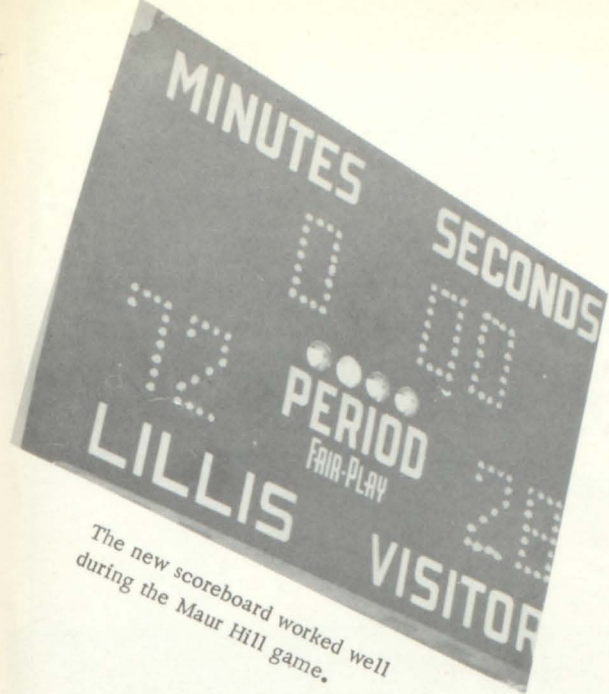
