The Blue Eagle team caught fire this year to rebound from last year's no-win season to end up just one game out of third place. With their ups and downs, the Kingbirds managed to wind up with the win column overbalancing the loss column by a 4-to-3 margin.

The Eagle squad, with two starters returned, but facing the best of competition in the league, battled its way to a fourth place, having three men in the honorable mention list. The three were Vic Wilson, Wyman Fair and Bill Van Gordon.

The squad started off with a fine showing on the home court by defeating De La Salle by a 56-28 score. Paced by Bill Van Gordon, Blue Eagle center, who dunked in 20 points, the team led 33-11 at the half and went in to hold the Cadets far down.

The following Friday the Eagles dropped a heartbreaker by a 49 to 48 score. After leading 16-4 at the end of the first quarter, the Eagles got cold and dropped their lead to 4 points at the half. The Glenn team found the range and peppered the hoop to close the gap. Hungry for a victory, the Eagles met Southeast the following week and handed them a 42-37 defeat. Coomes and Fair paced the Eagles with 13 and 14 points, respectively, as they pulled down their first victory of the season. The win put Central in the first division.

Taking the court against Northeast, the Eagles surprised them and, at the end of the first quarter, led 8-5. The Vikings woke up in the next period and pushed ahead on Adams' pivot shots. The next half Adams and Childs hit for Northeast and put them ahead. The Eagles' ability to hit disappeared and the score at the close of the game was 49-39, Northeast.

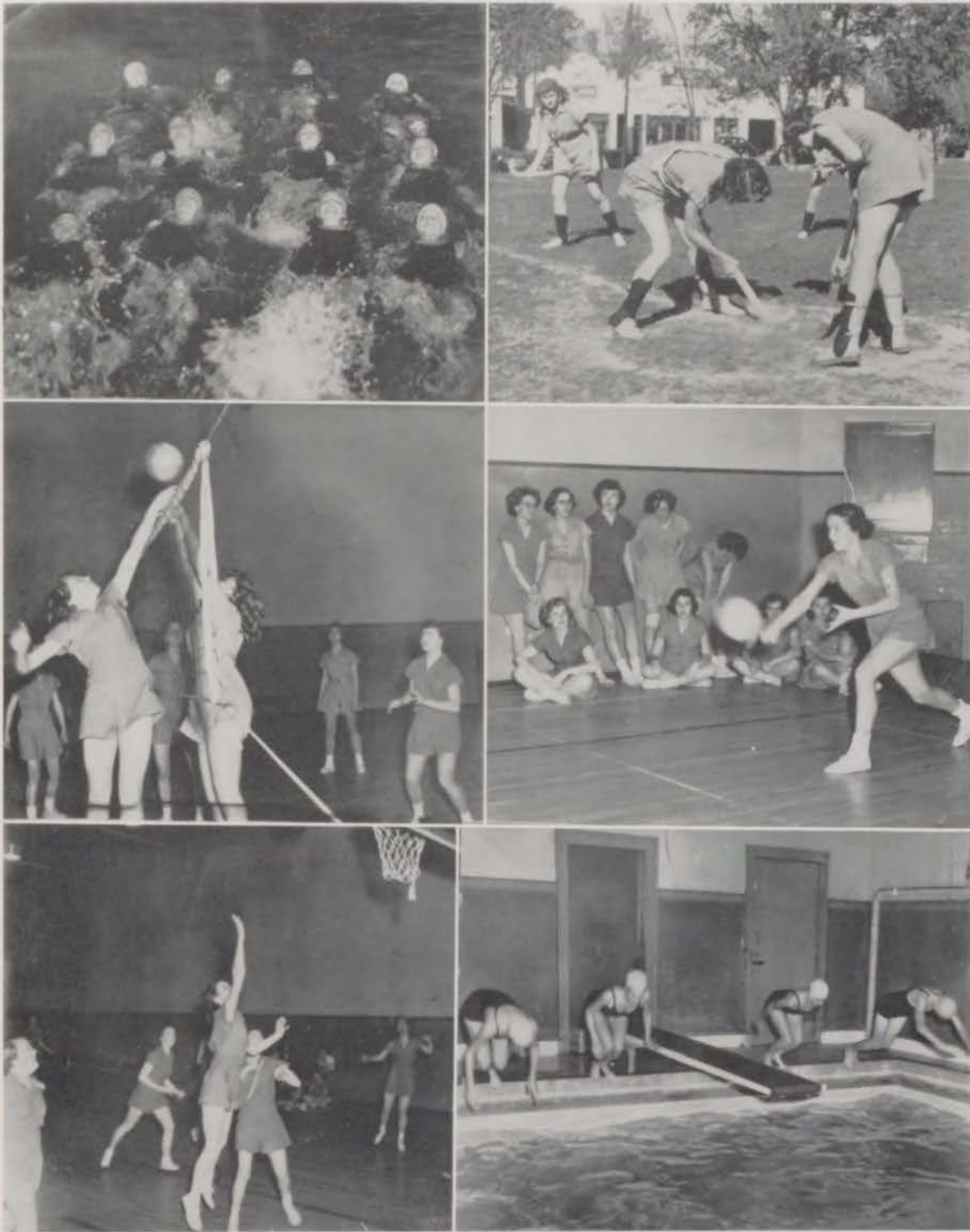

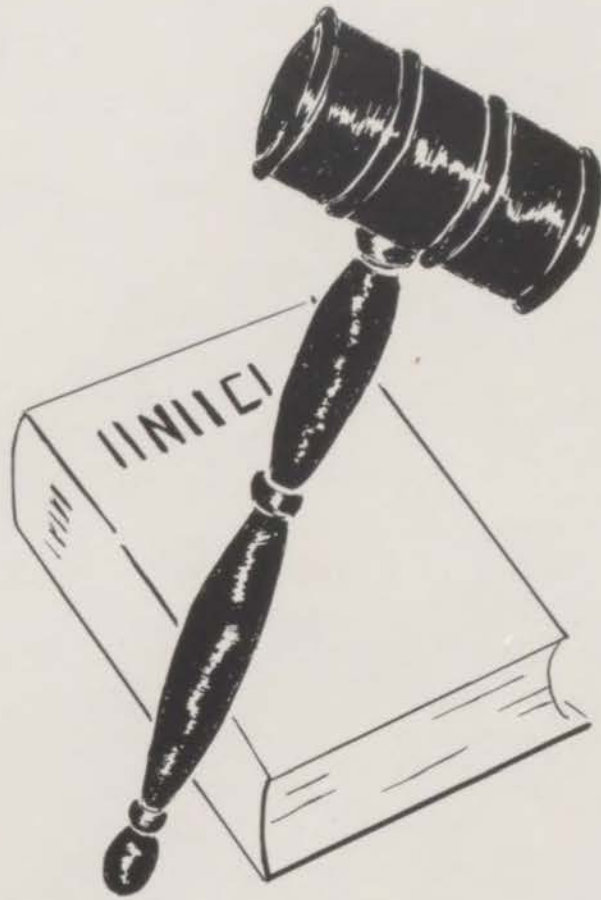

The Central R.O.T.C. Battalion began the year under the guidance of Capt. E. B. Robertson and Sgt. James W. The Regimental ball was held at the American Legion Hall, Linwood and Paseo. Central's candidate for queen was Michael Harder, escorted by Lt. Col. Marvin Friedman. She was chosen by the cadets from the Central candidates presented. The two runner-ups were Camille Ewald, escorted by Sgt. George Lanigan, and Carolyn Angle, escorted by Major Walter Brott. All agreed the ball was one of the nicest ever held.

During the past year, a new organization was formed in the unit called the Central R.O.T.C. Memorial Club. Its purpose was to furnish firing squads for military funerals. This group has served at over 60 funerals during the year.

After Federal inspection, the Central Battalion closed shop after a very successful year.

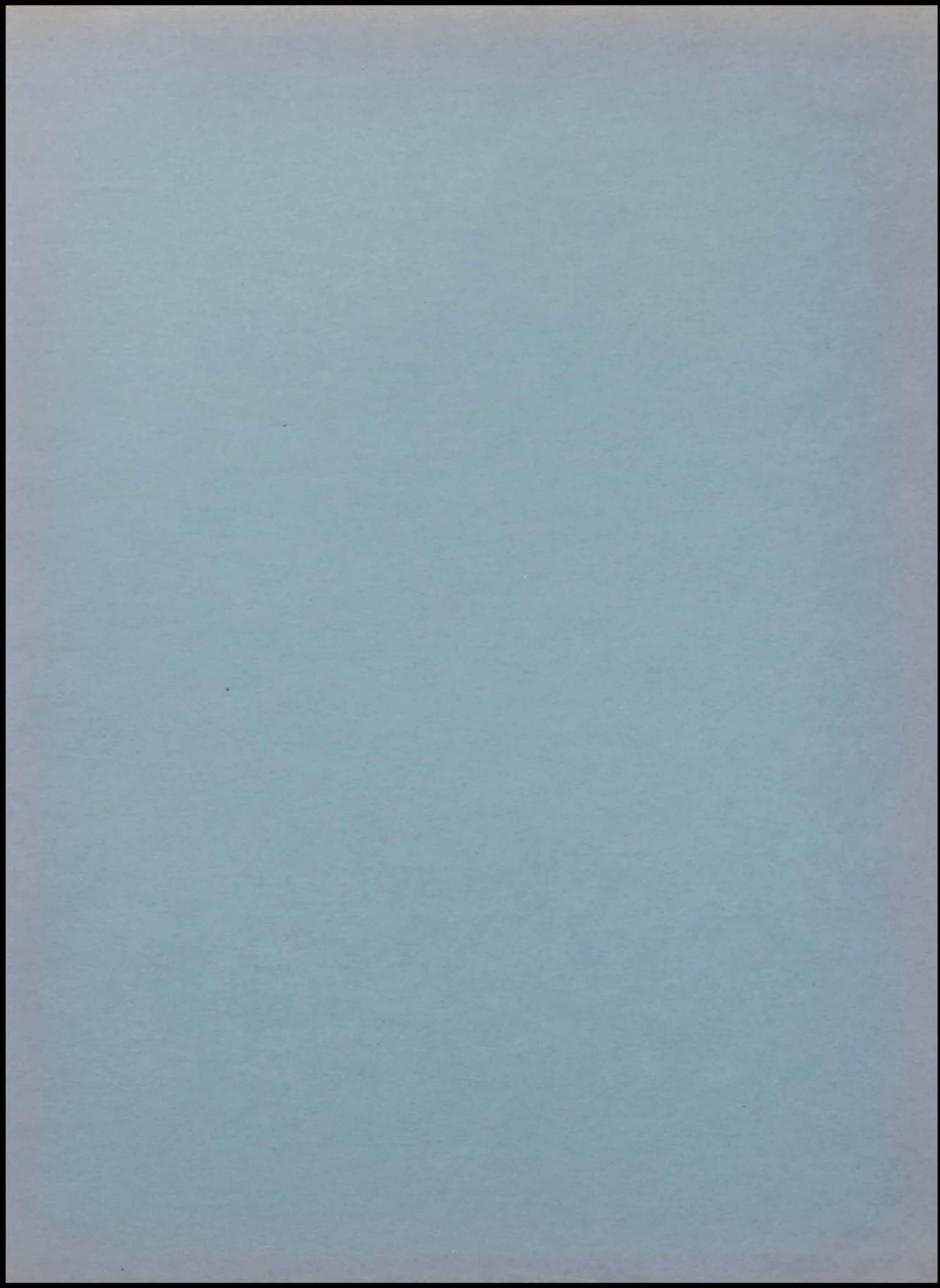

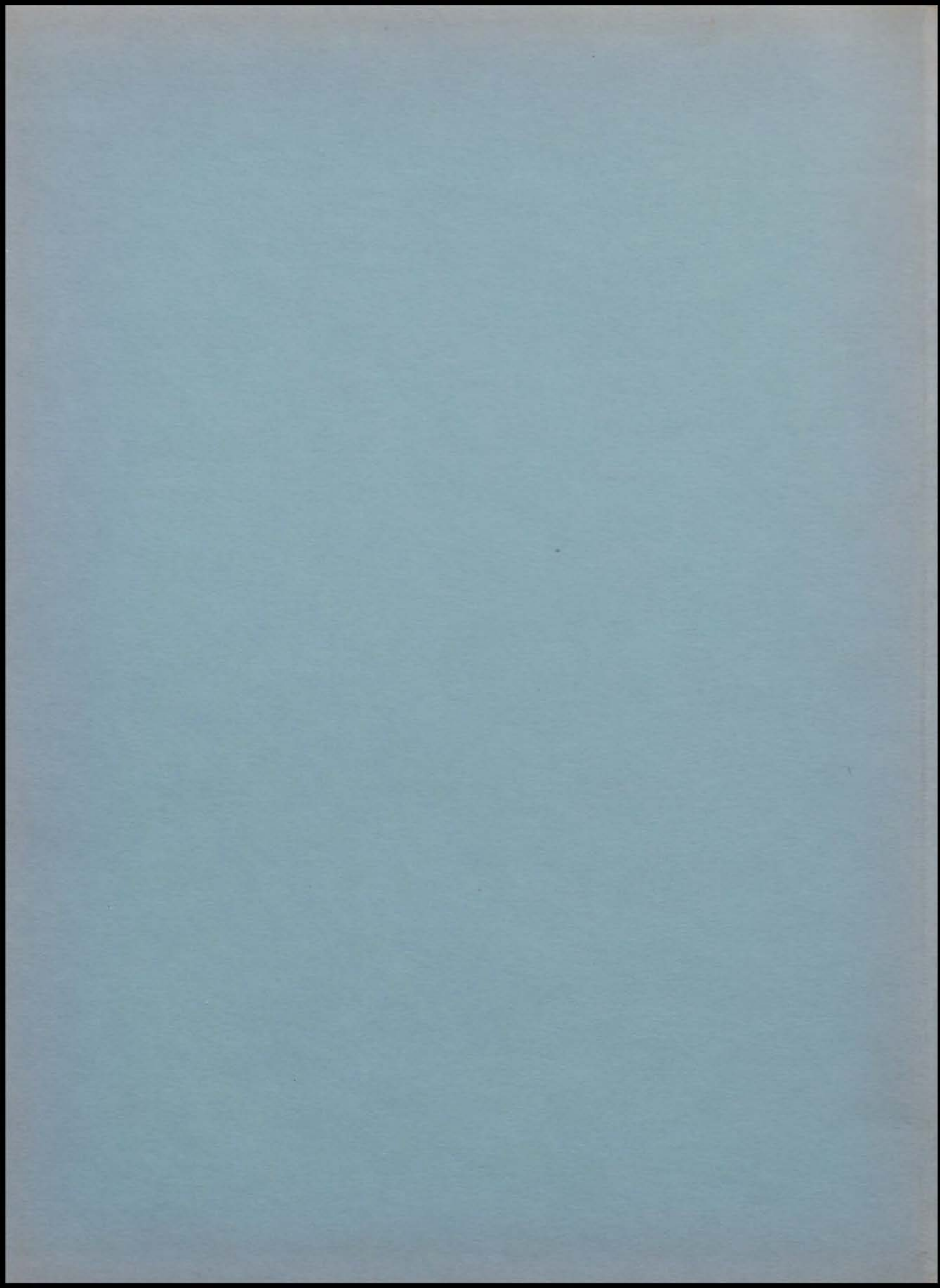

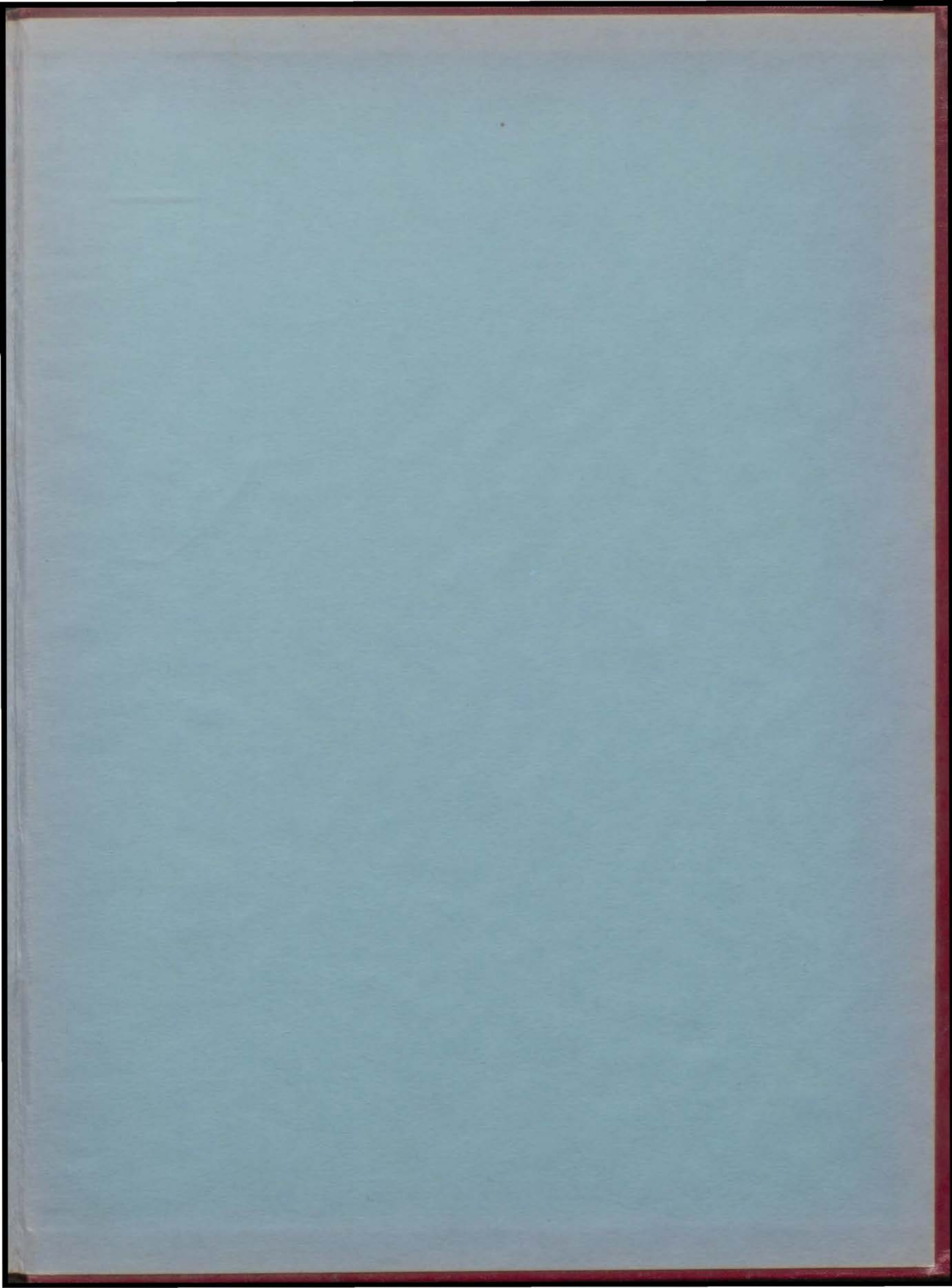
