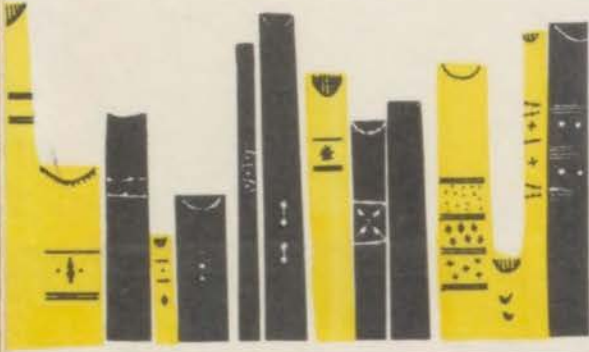

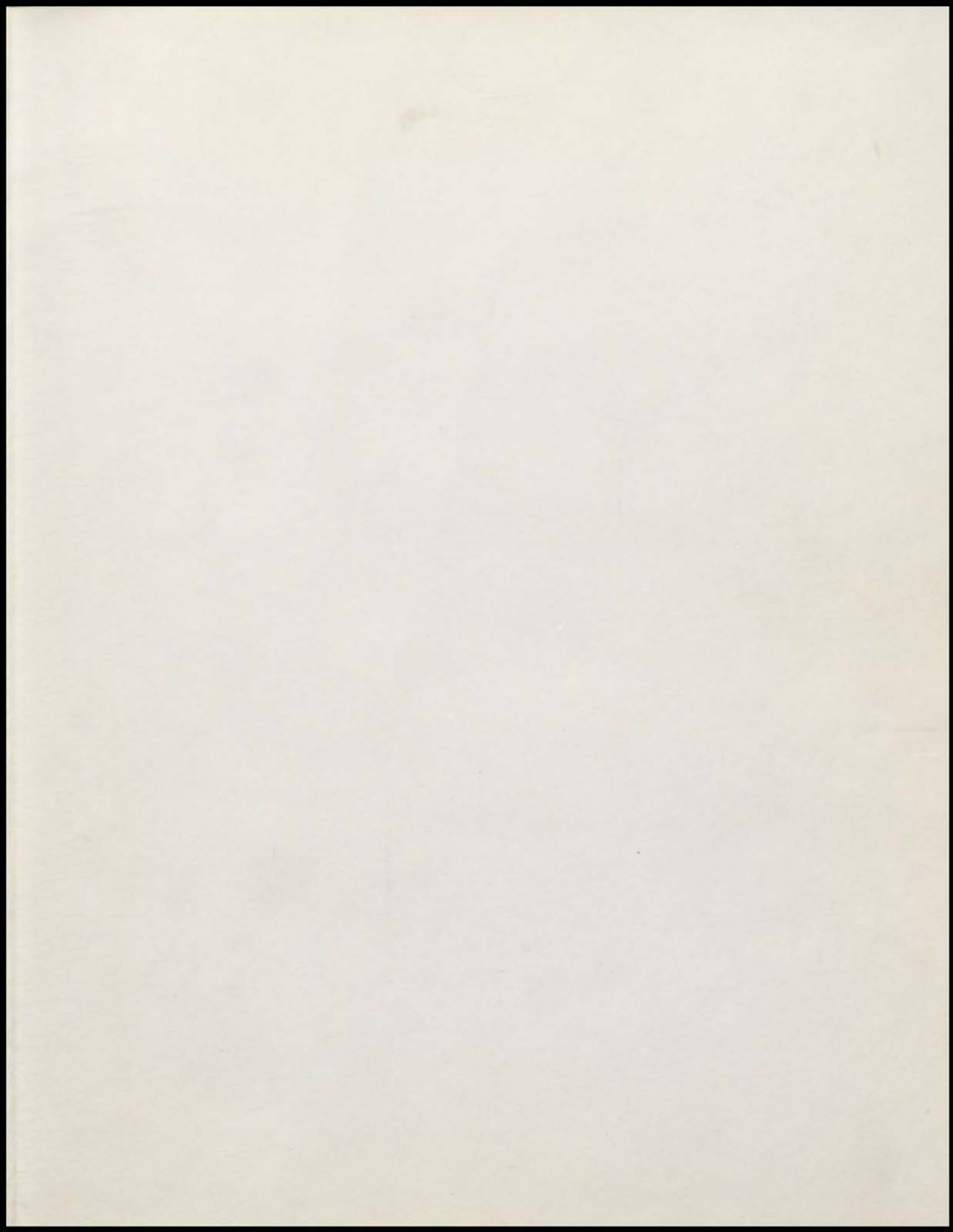

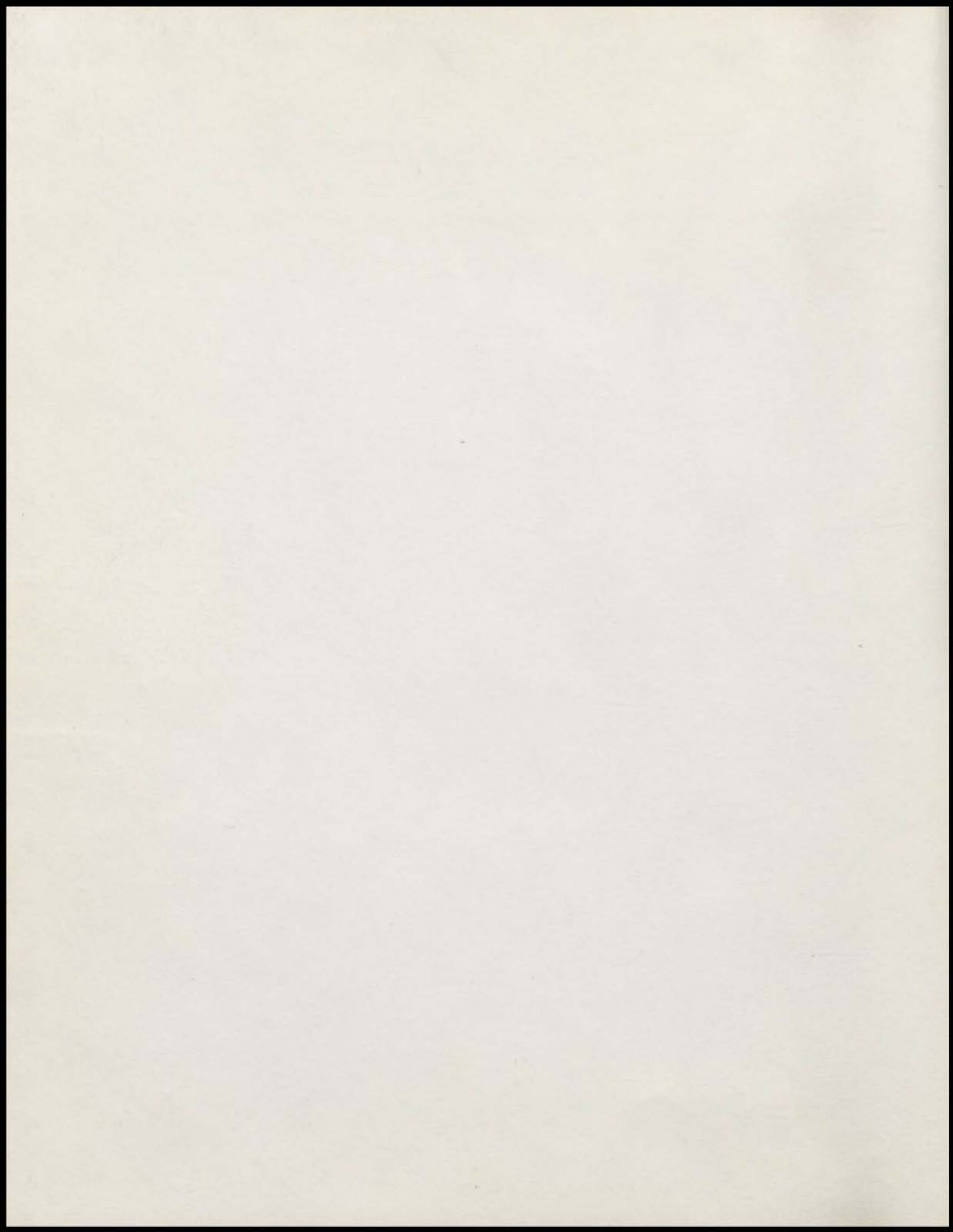

The class of 1964, through this *Centralian*, hope to recall old memories in a musical tone and create a desire among the student body for greater success and a tuneful collection of memories in the future.



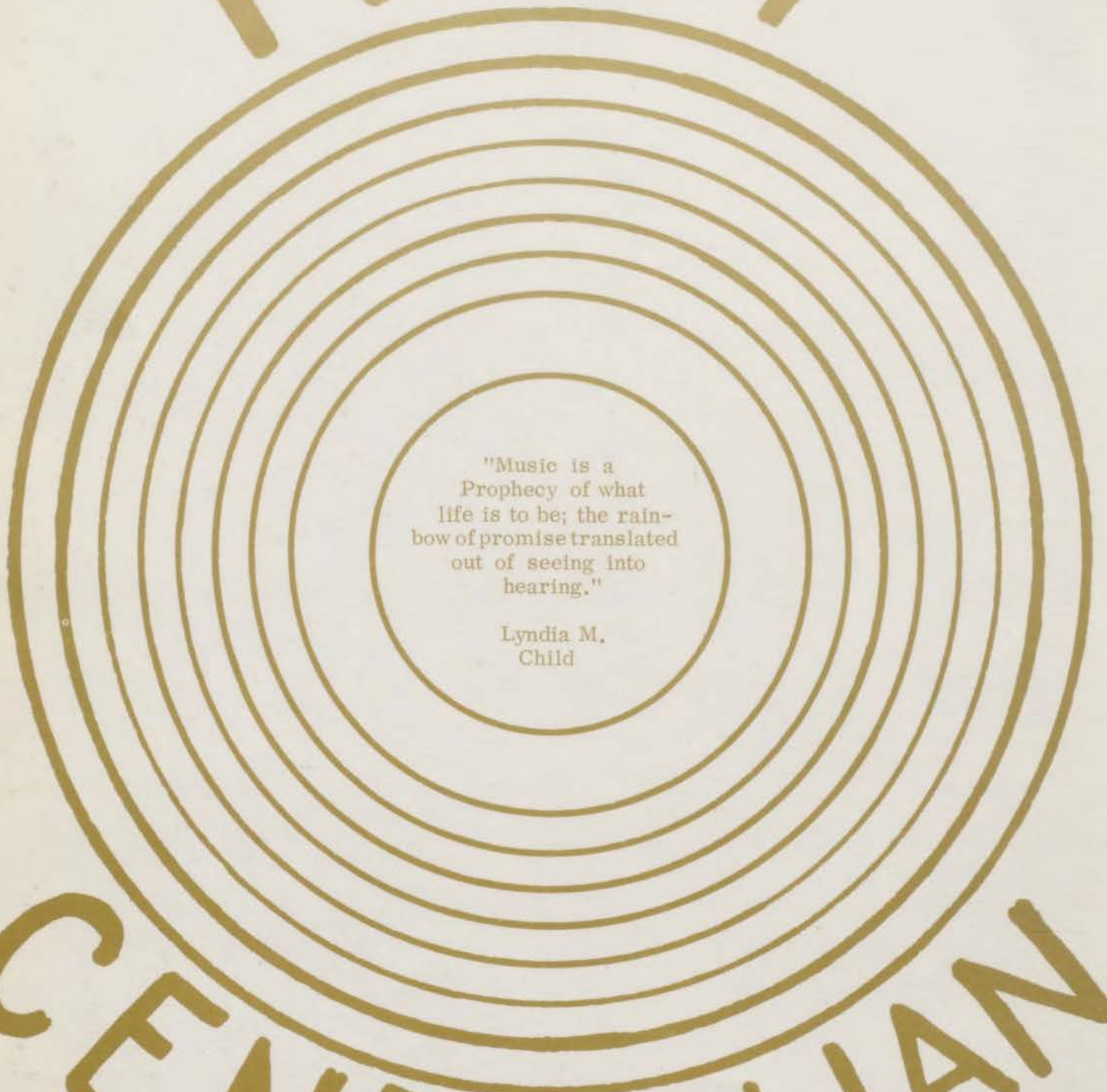

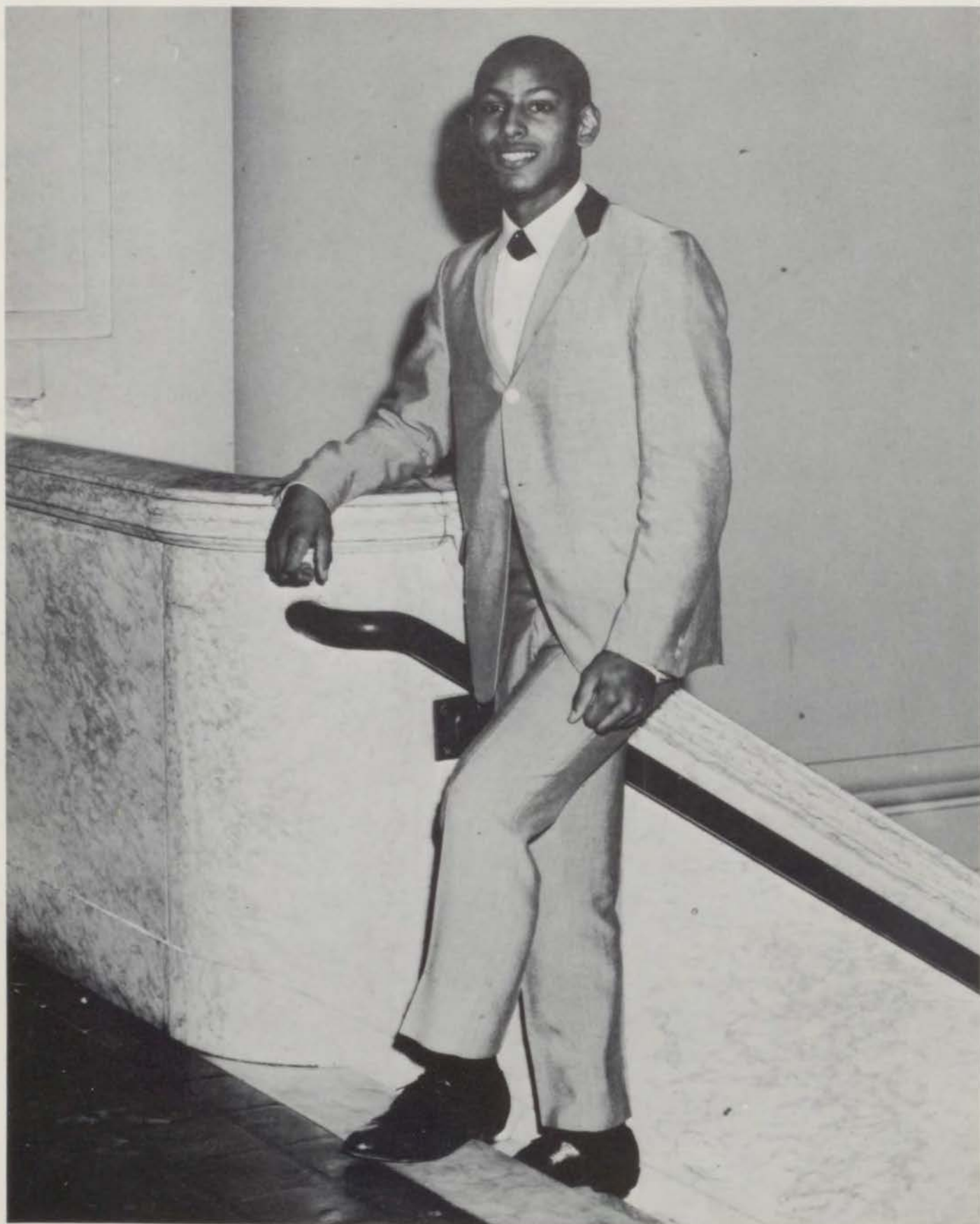
