SCHOLASTIC HONOR SOCIETY

Carnation Day at Central is Honor Society Day, for the Honor students are distinguished not only by their neat grooming and expression of pride in accomplishment, but by the carnations pinned to their left shoulders; white for those with gold pins and pink for those with silver and bronze pins.

Any student who maintains the required number of scholastic points for two successive semesters is eligible for membership and may wear the bronze pin. After maintaining the required number of points for four semesters he may wear the silver pin, and after seven semesters, the coveted gold pin.

When points are figured, pupils who have entered Central from other Kansas City high schools are treated in the same manner as Centralites. Those entering from high schools outside the Kansas City District must wait one semester. If they maintain the required number of points during that semester, they are given full credit for the grades brought with them and are placed in the proper group in the society.
