COOPERATIVE OCCUPATIONAL EDUCATION



High school seniors, 16 years of age or older, who have an occupational objective, may enroll for cooperative on-the-job training. The school coordinator attempts to find an employer who can provide a beginning job which offers real learning opportunities for the student.

The student devotes a minimum of fifteen hours per week, generally in the afternoon, on the job as a trainee worker. Additional hours may be arranged by the employer and coordinator.

The student-learner is rated by the employer and the school as to his progress on the job. Attendance, quality and quantity of work, attitude, interest in work, and ability to get along with others are factors in rating or grading. High school credit is granted on the basis of satisfactory progress by the student.

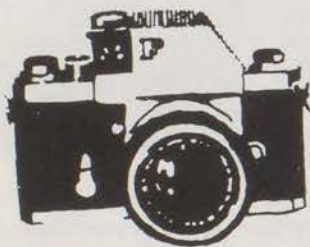
The student-learner is under the joint supervision of the employer and the school. In this arrangement the coordinator confers periodically with student's immediate supervisor concerning the student's progress on the job.

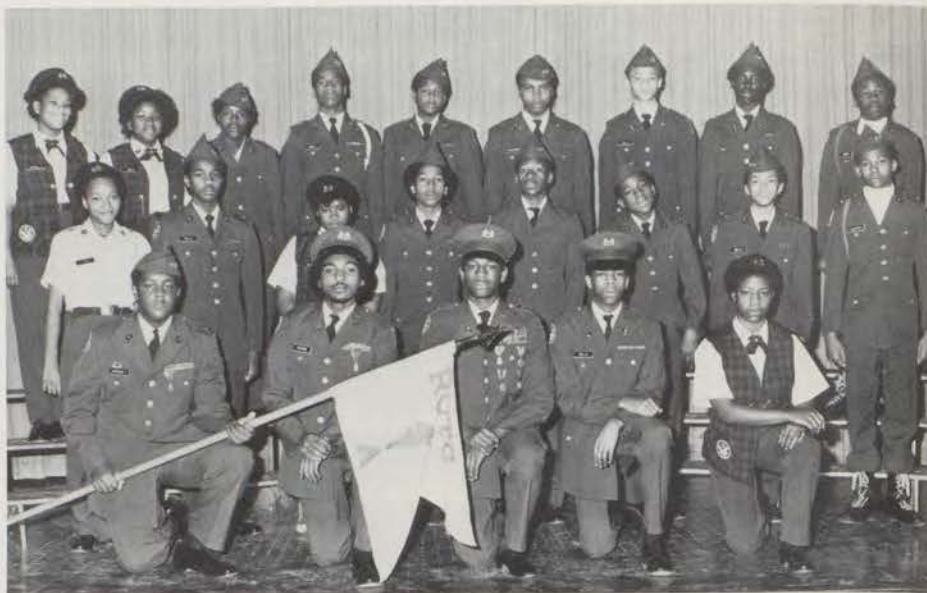

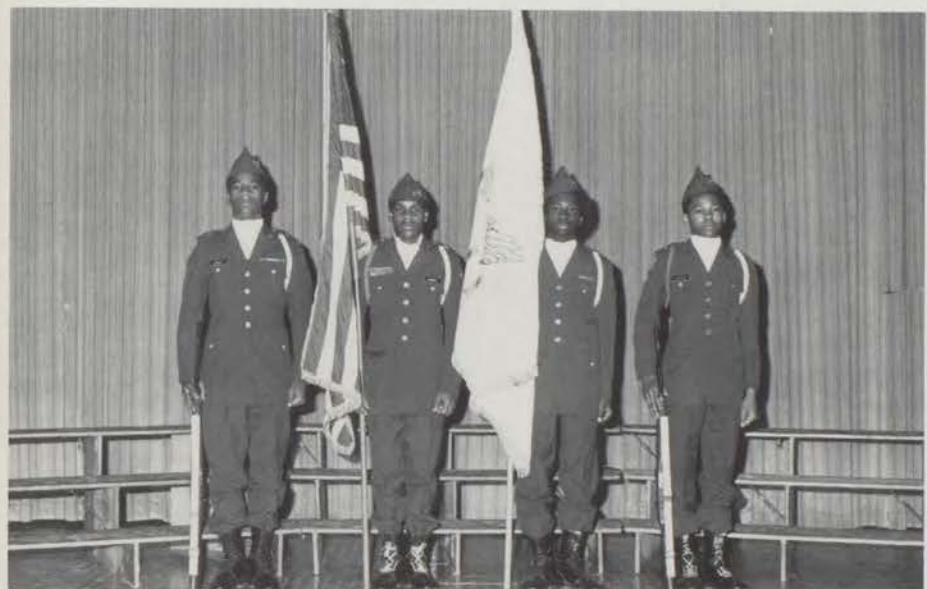

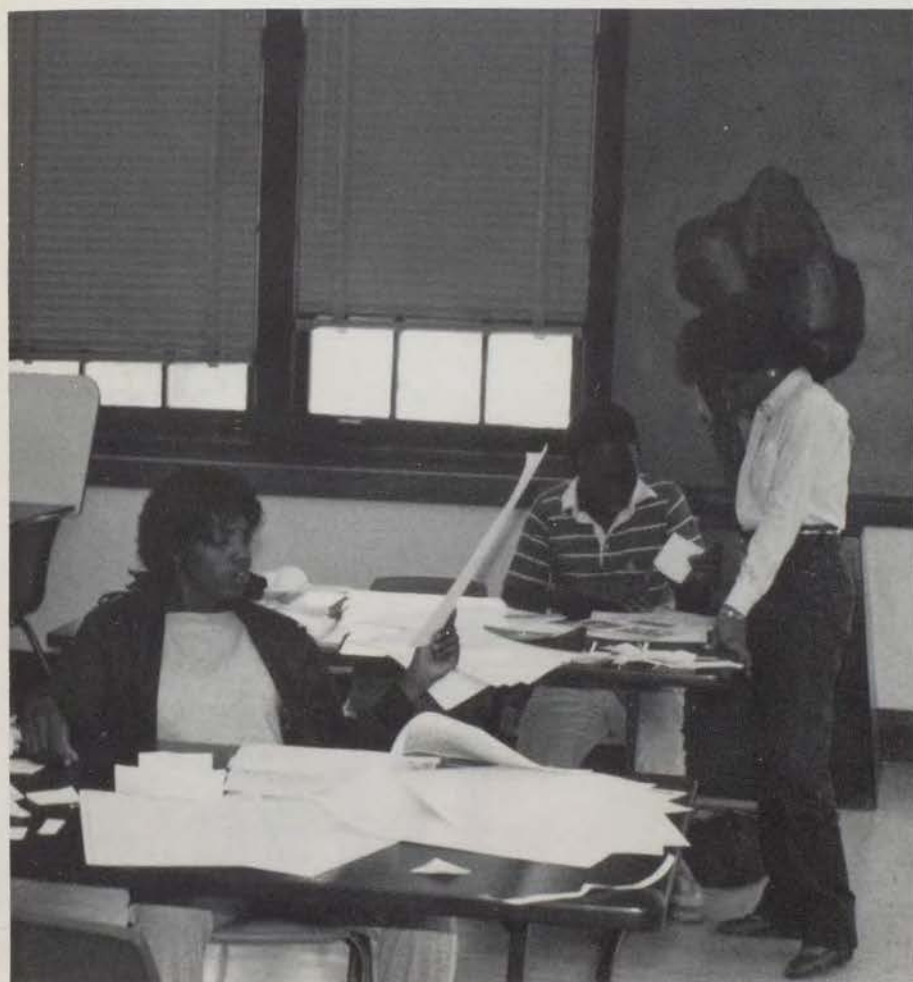
LUMINARY STAFF
