It is fitting that in entering the main door of De La Salle one's attention should be drawn to the portrait of Colonel Per Ramee, PMS&T Emeritus. The portrait and its bronze plaque, dedicated last October in the Colonel's presence by the mayor of Kansas City, the Honorable H. Roe Bartle, is a lasting tribute to the colonel, who for fourteen years served De La Salle so faithfully as Professor of Military Science and Tactics.

On the opposite page is shown Cadet Colonel Jerry Allen with a junior, a sophomore, and a freshman cadet. To the freshmen, Colonel Ramee is a name heard frequently around school, the name of a man whom everyone holds in the utmost respect. However, to the sophomores, to the juniors more so, and especially to the seniors, Colonel Ramee is not just a name. Through one, two, or three years of personal contact with the colonel, these cadets have come to know Colonel Ramee as the embodiment of all things good in a soldier and in a man.
