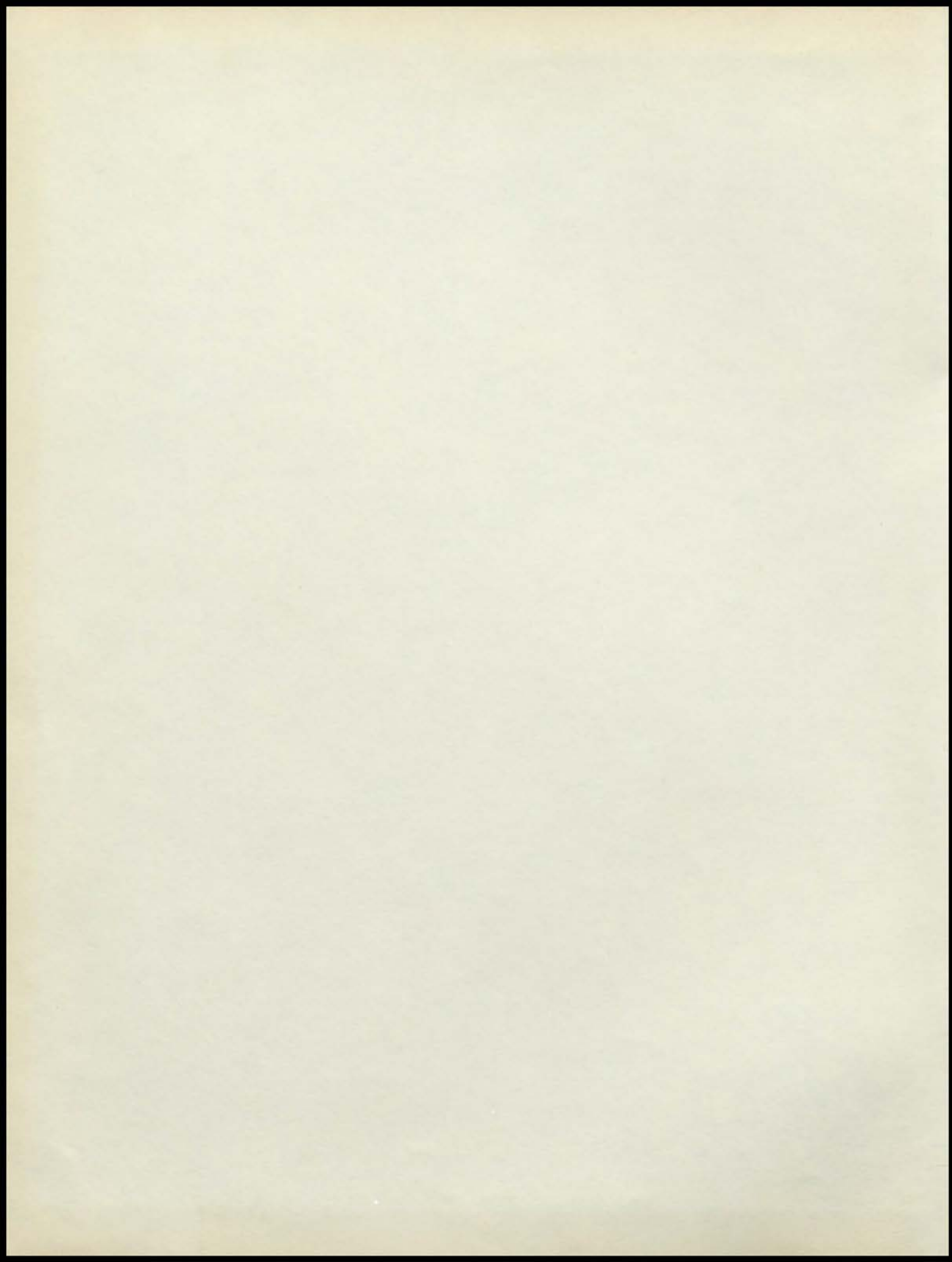

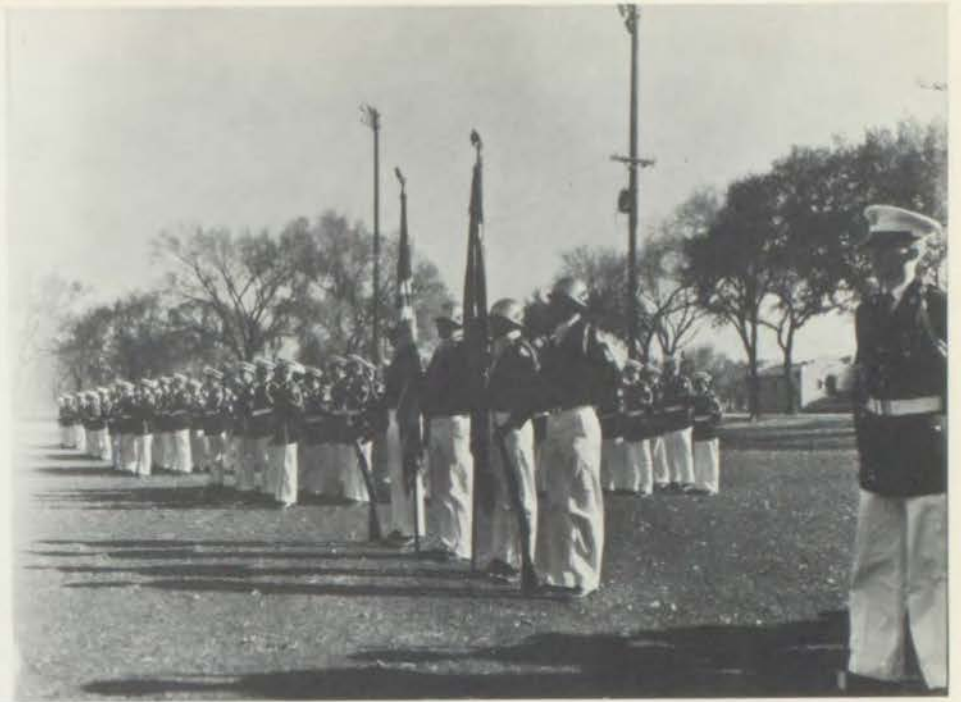

## RAYTOWN TAKES ADVANTAGE OF CADET SICKNESS

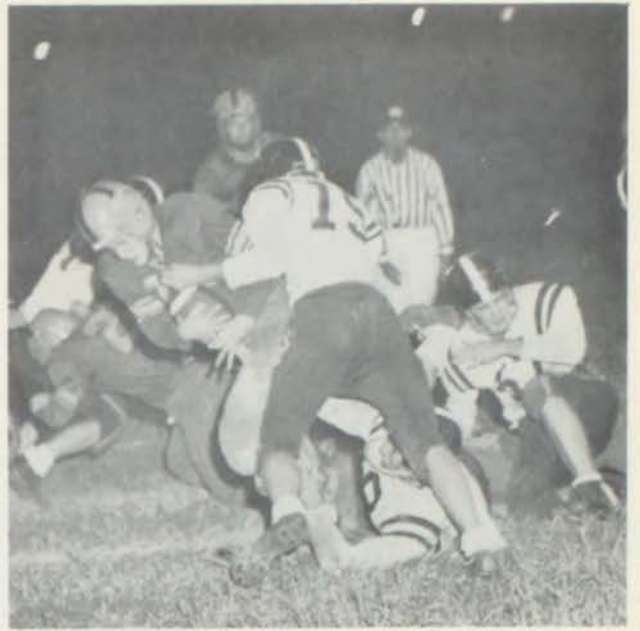

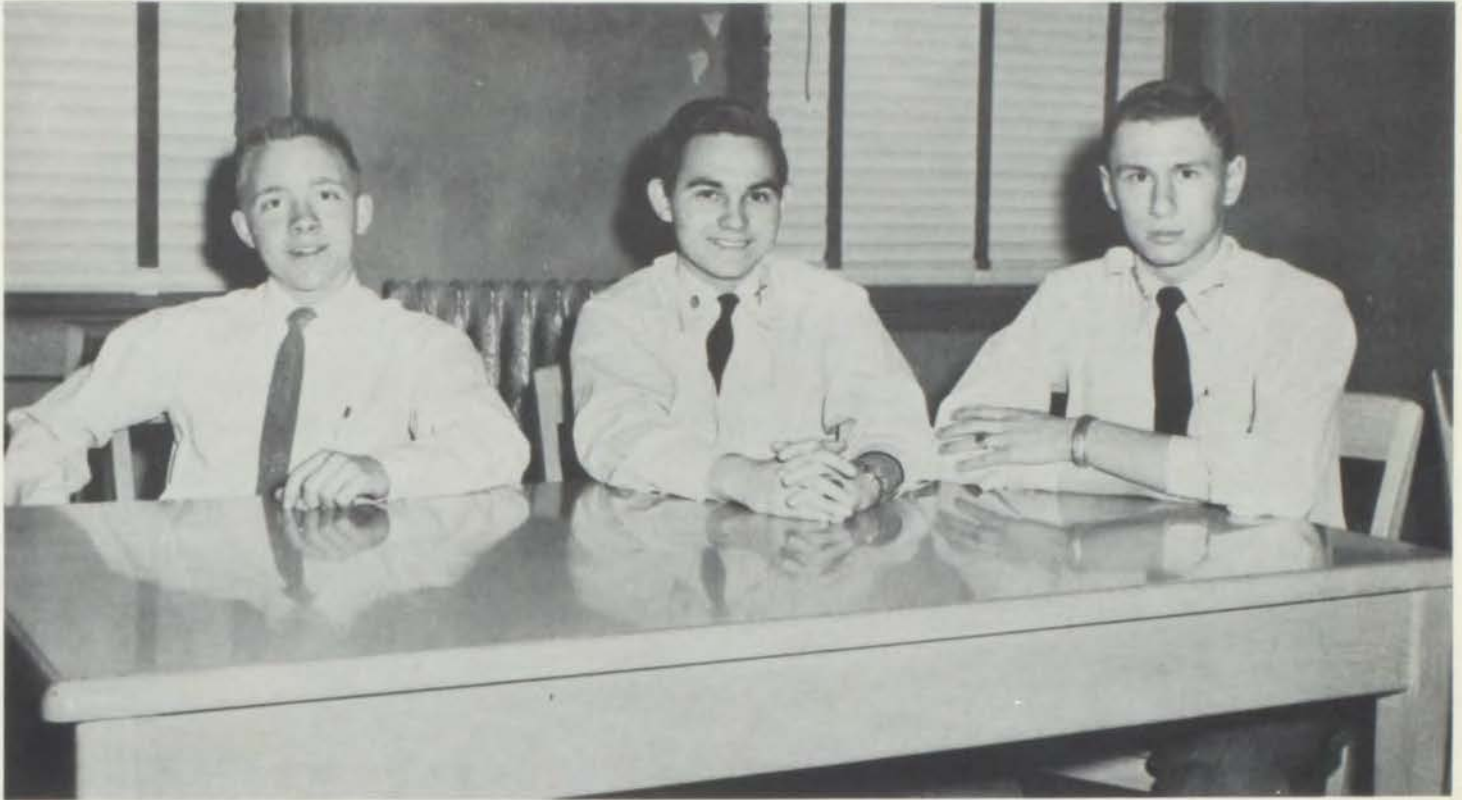

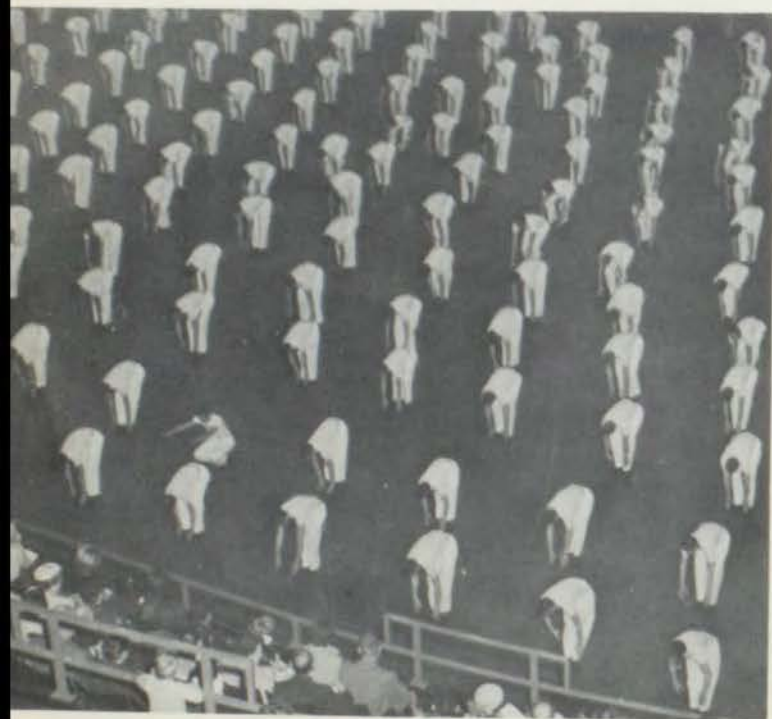
