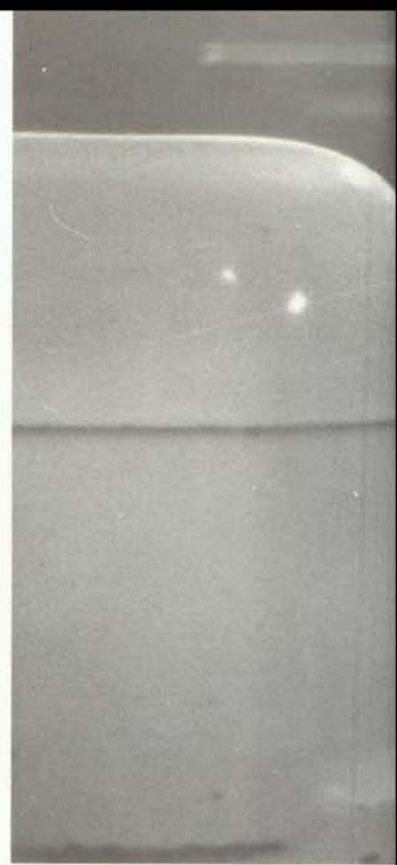


LIBRARY

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

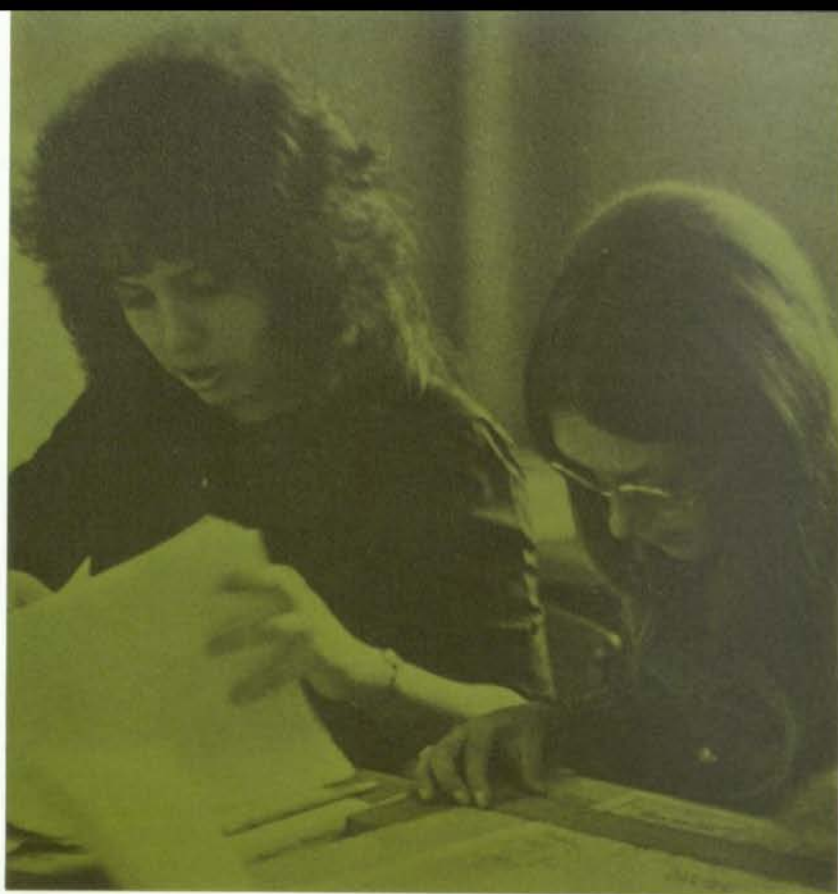

Courses of all levels of mathematics are offered to students at East. These classes range from general mathematics to advanced algebra and trigonometry.



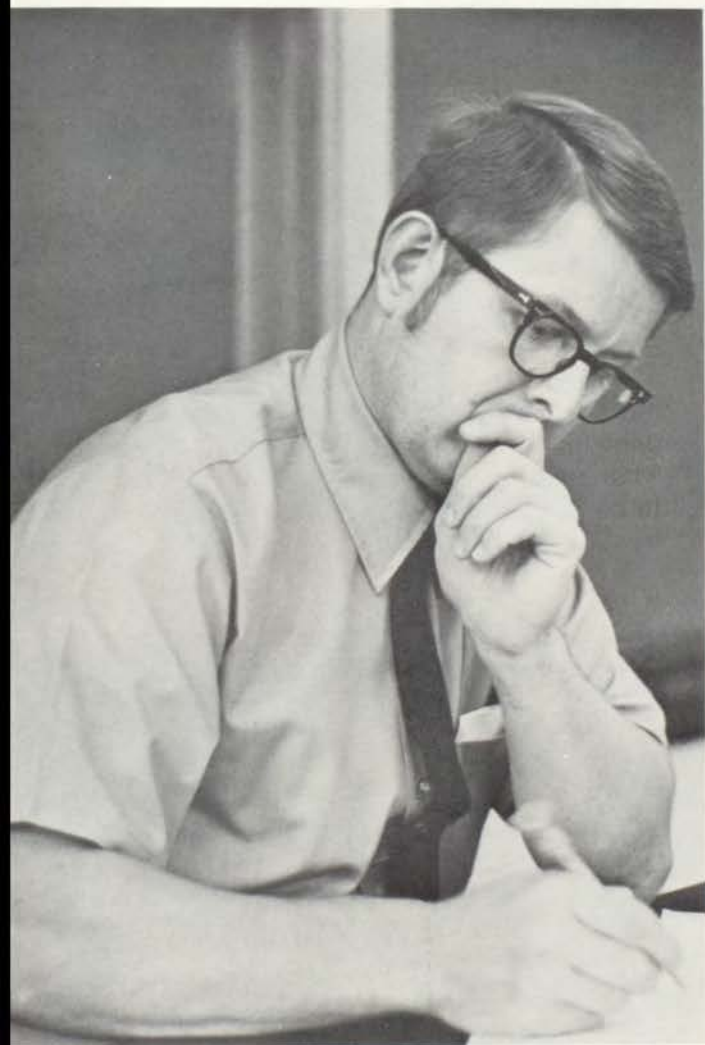

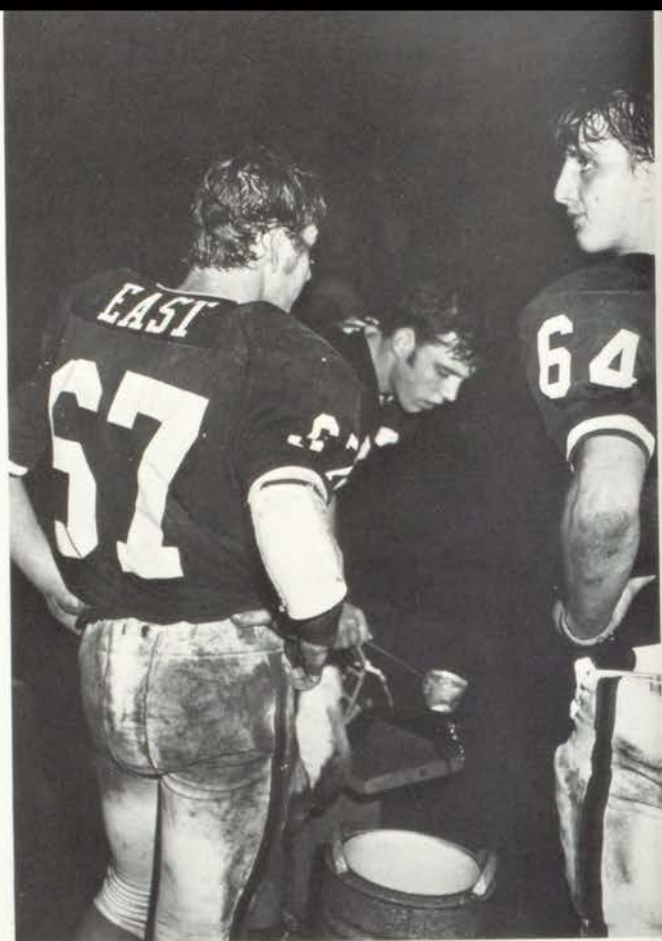




1. Happiness is a Bear victory. 2. The offense rests during a time out. 3. Floyd Yingling (47) attempts to stop a Westport ball carrier.

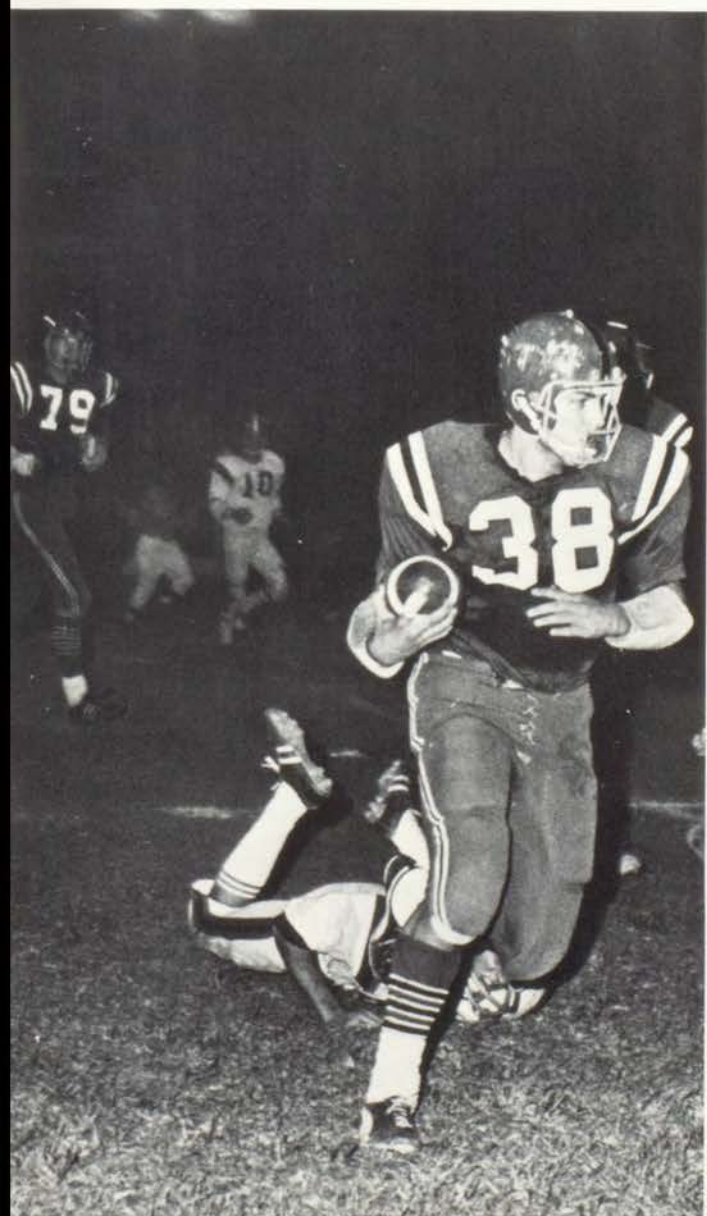

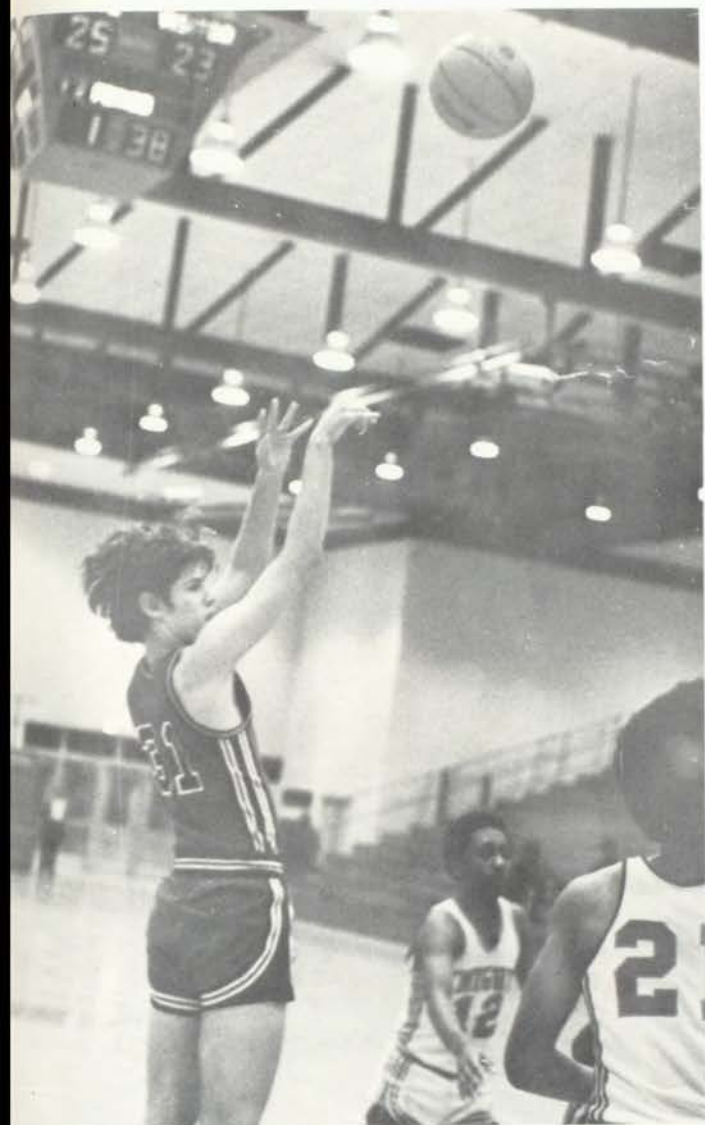

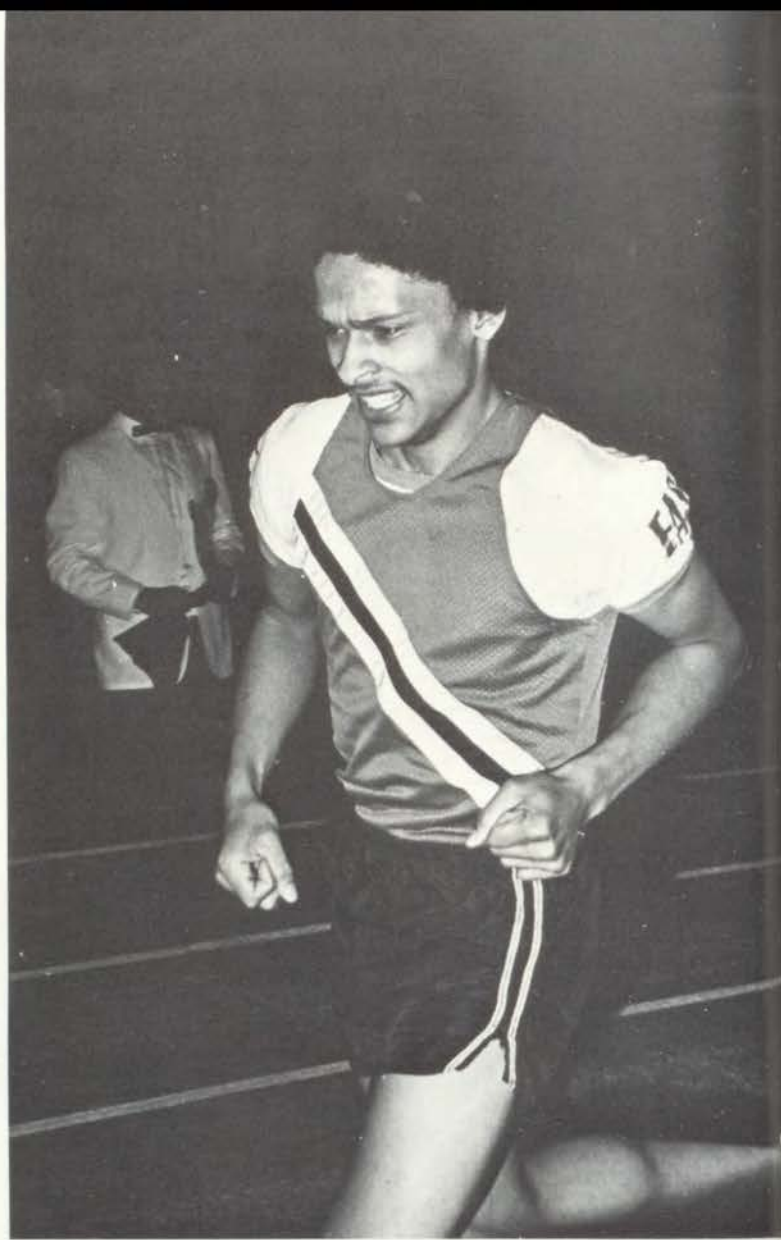
