




Like all years, some things were pleasent, and some things were not. On the down side was the implementation of a new tardy policy, stating that one tardy meant automatic detention from the teacher in question.










# Varsity Wins Final Game











Cameras clicked, embraces were exchanged, people danced. A myriad of post prom parties took place after the formal affair, each one less formal than the previous event.








## Doug Bolden New Track Coach




