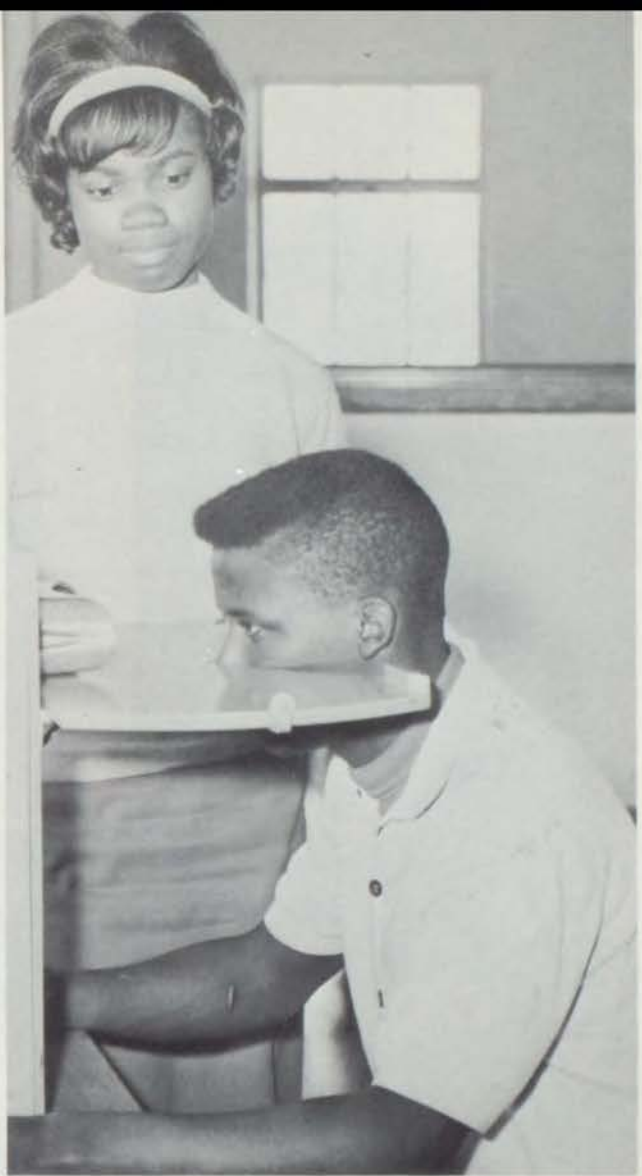

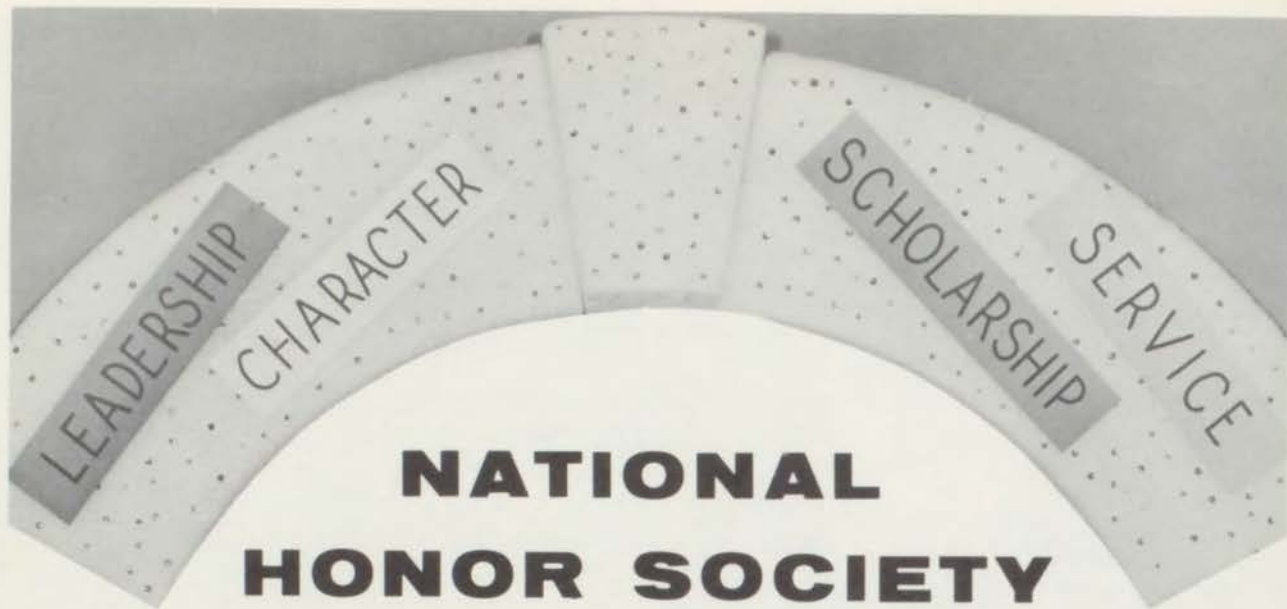
Annual projects sponsored by the Council
