SENIORS TAKE LEAVE

Our junior year was filled with new activities which were climaxed by the Junior-Senior prom held at the Little Theater. Dorsey Blake won second prize in the American Legion oratorical contest and several juniors won prizes in the annual Science Fair. Henry Lyons, James Dupree, Joseph Page, Franzetta Shirley, Rainey Kimes, Charles McTyer, and Dorsey Blake were inducted into the National Honor Society.

In the fall of 1963, one hundred and sixty-nine seniors reported for classes. They assumed quickly and easily the role of leadership. Senior year meant senior play, class day, Senior Dinner Dance at Park East Hotel, Baccalaureate Service at St. Stephen Baptist Church and graduation in the Music Hall on June 2. A number of seniors received valuable scholarships and awards to aid them in continuing their education.

And thus we leave the halls we love to haunt. We are taking away much more than we brought with us. And that, of course, is the way it should be.

Sgt. Blasingame was an able and effective instructor in military tactics and leadership. He leaves behind numerous awards, medals and trophies won by ROTC units which he trained.


