





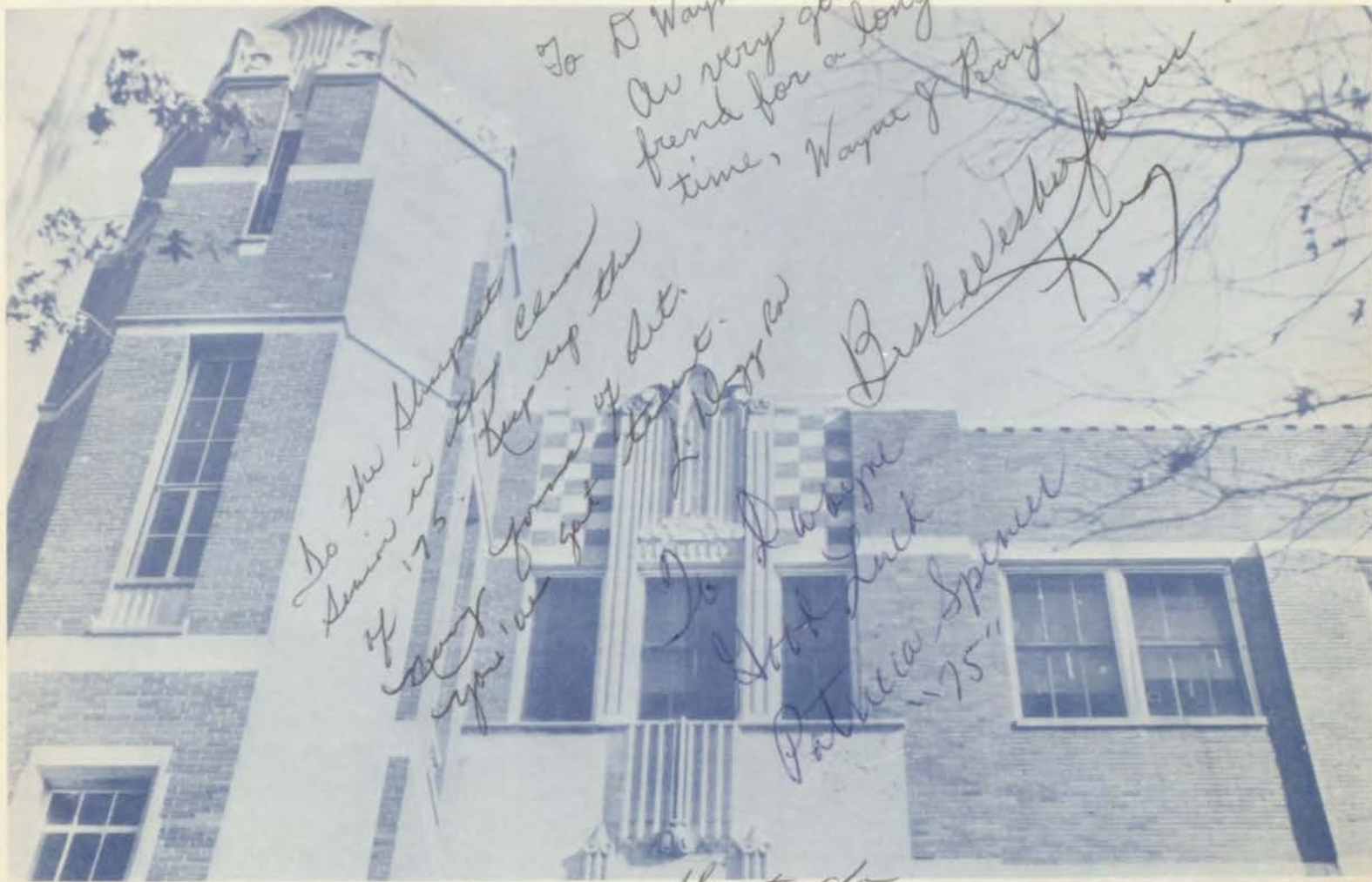

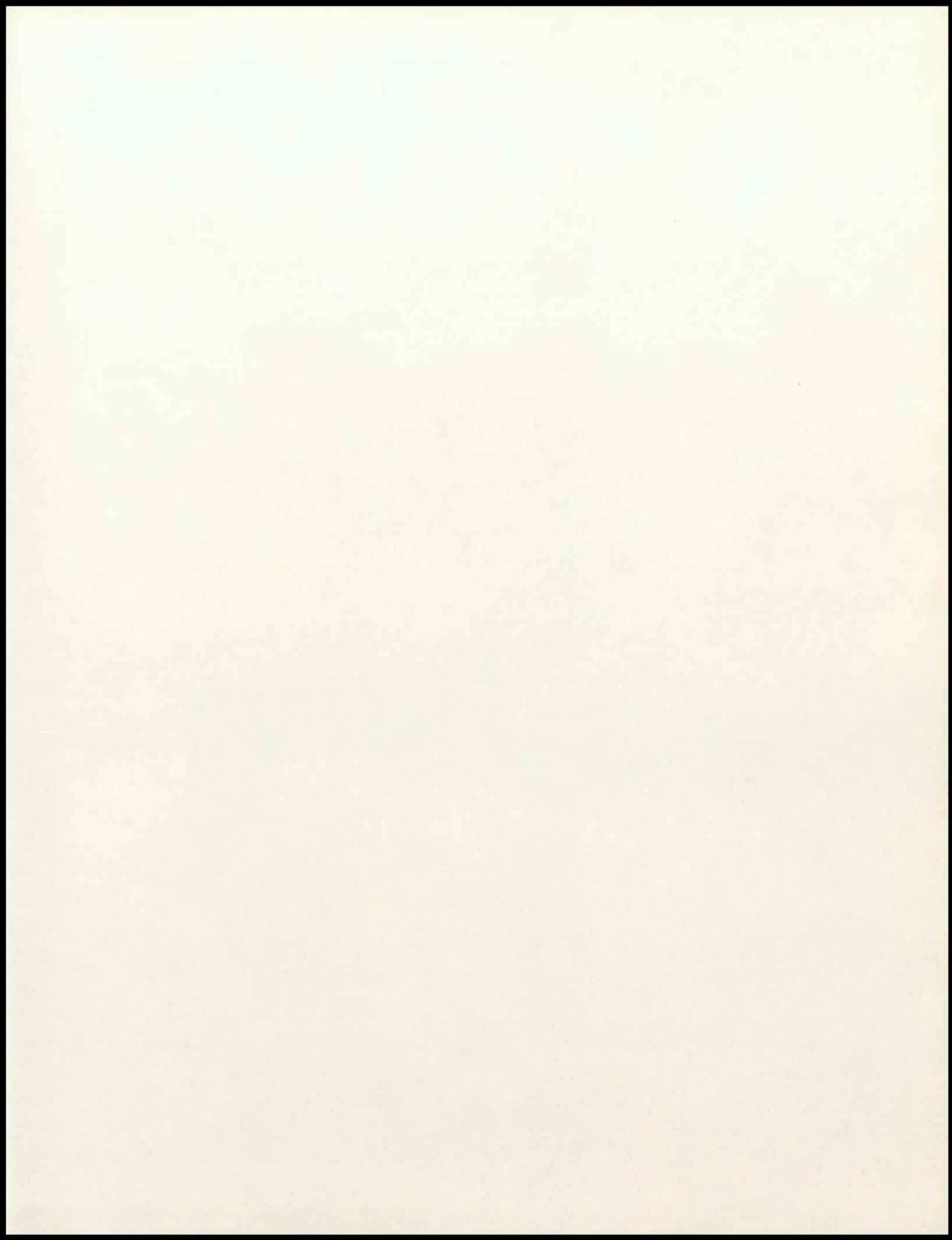

Through his tireless and unselfish efforts, the instrumental music department of Lincoln is one of the most outstanding in the area.

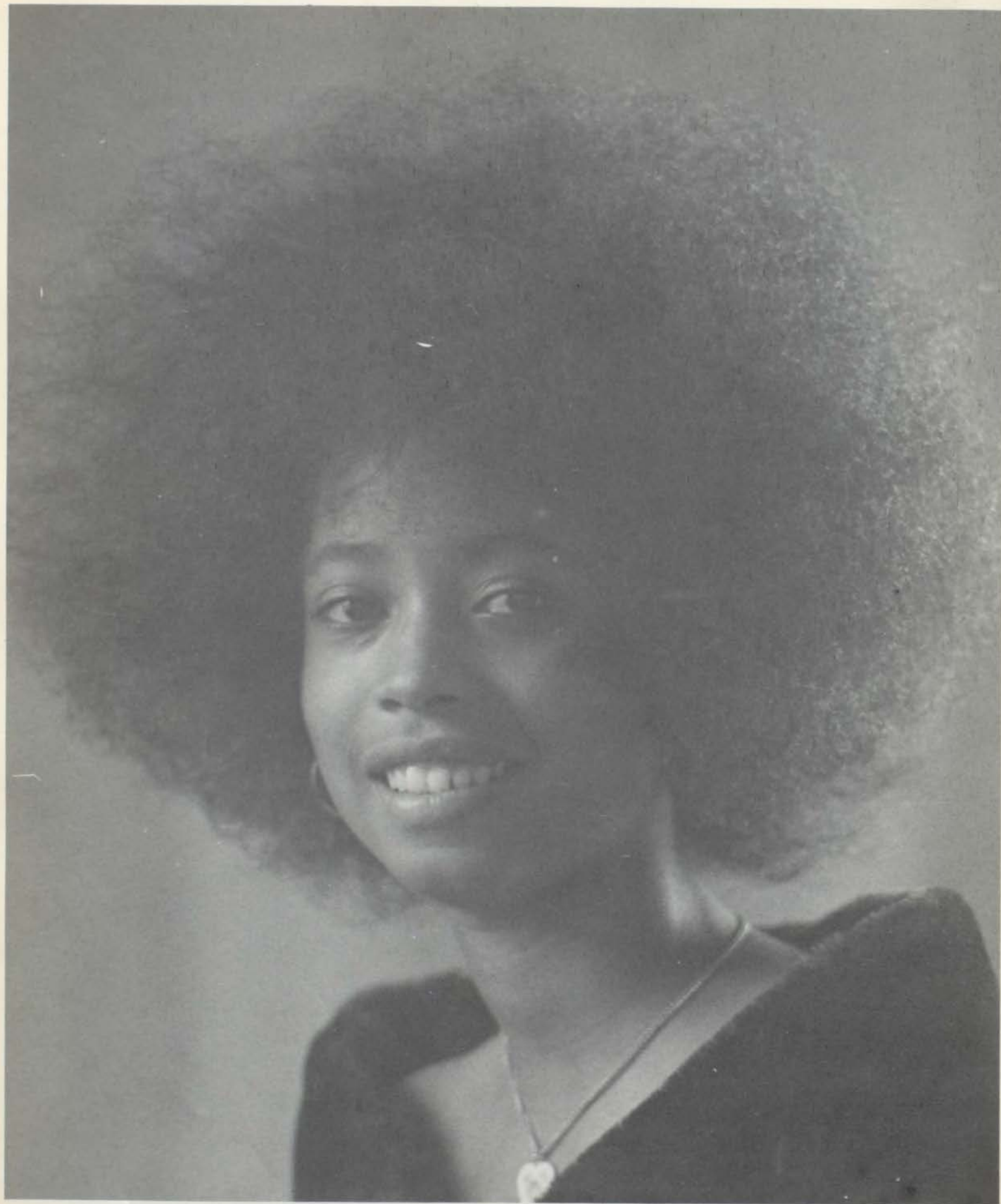

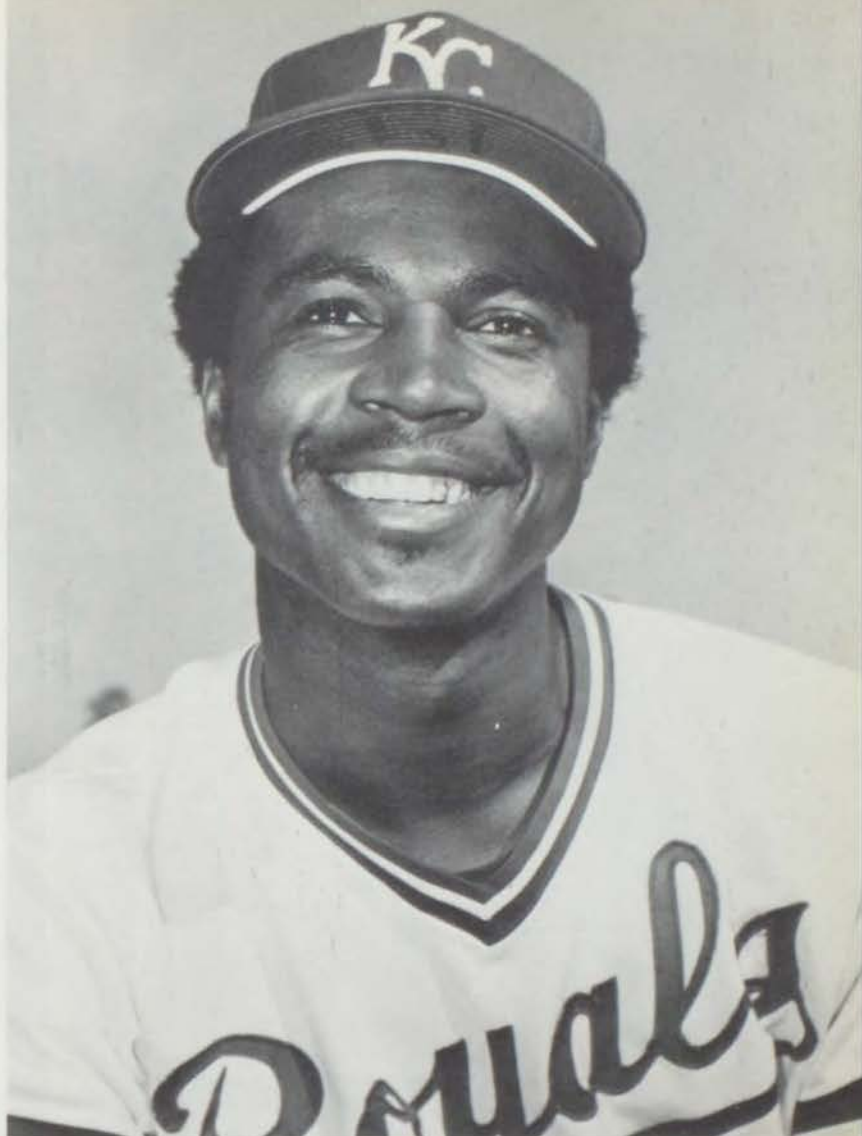


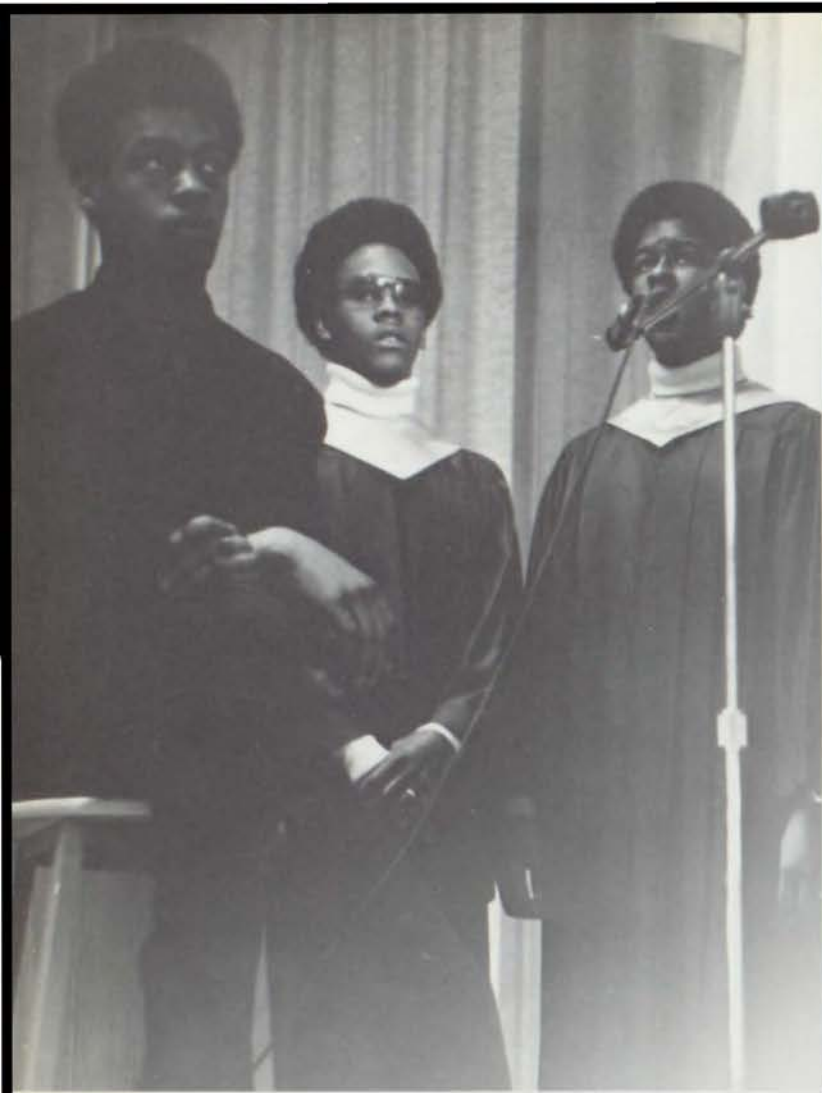
The Celebration Of Being Black
