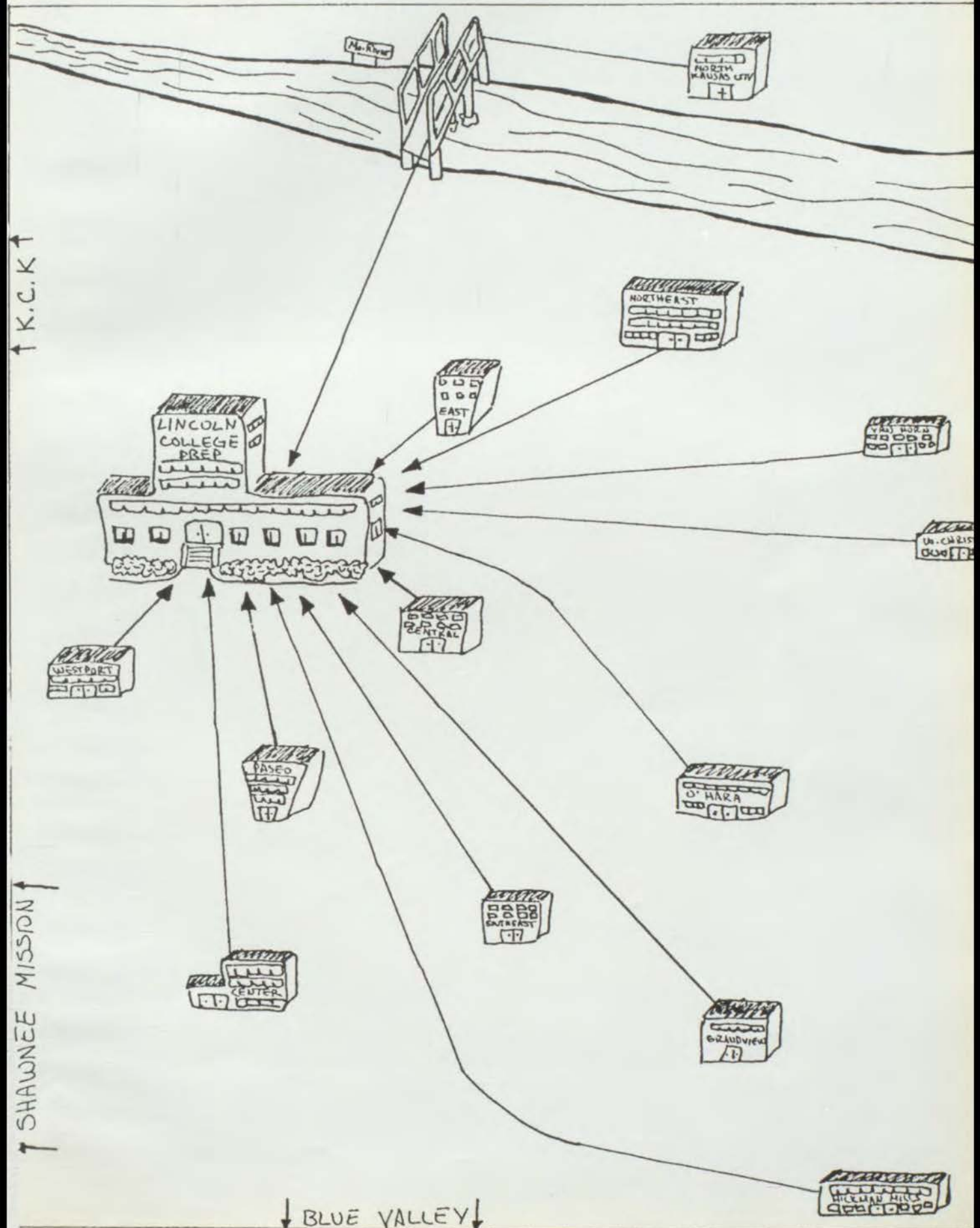

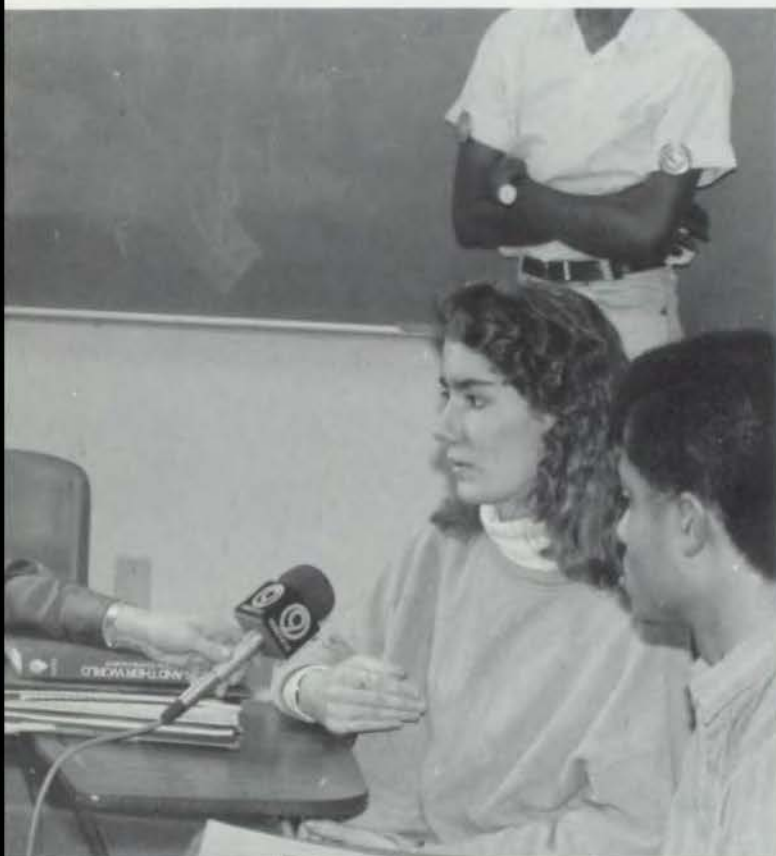
# LIVE FROM LINCOLN

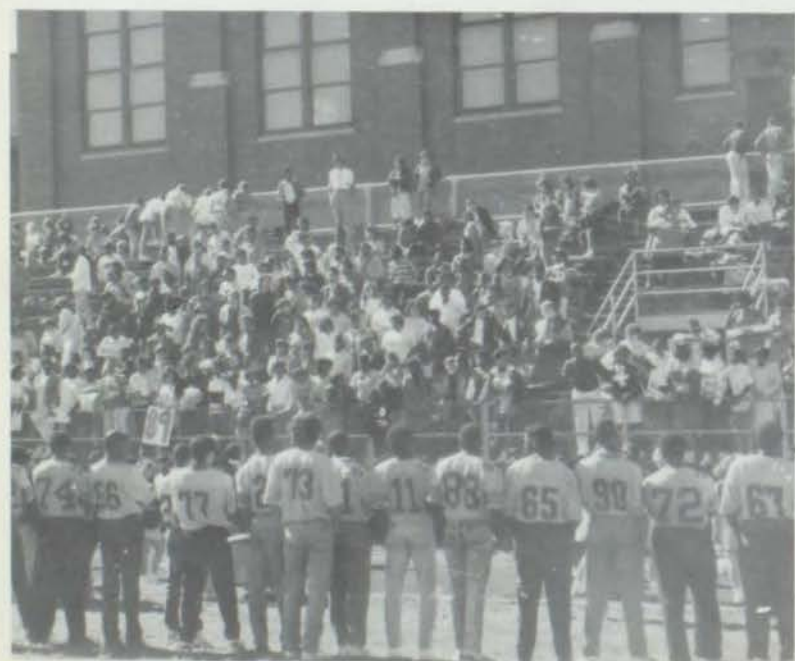

Despite all the changes that took place this year, Homecoming still turned out to be a great success.

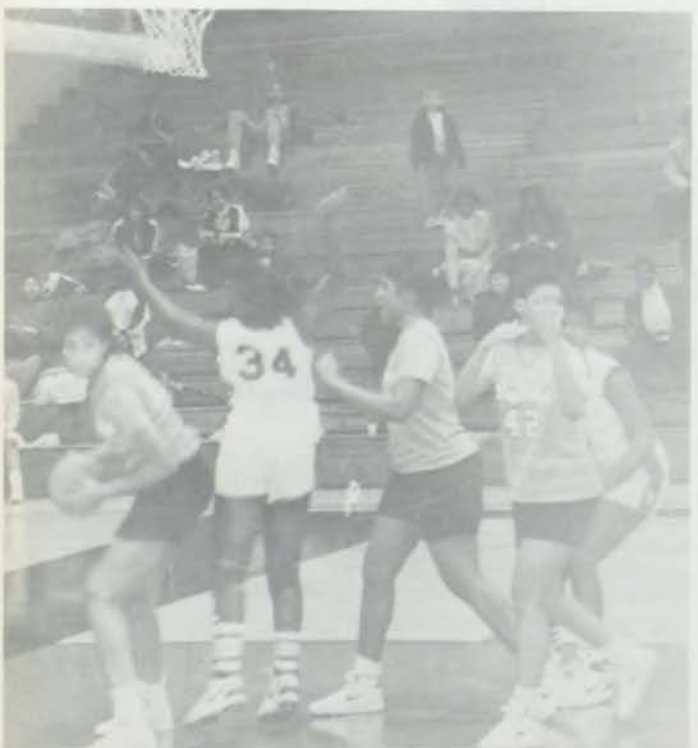
