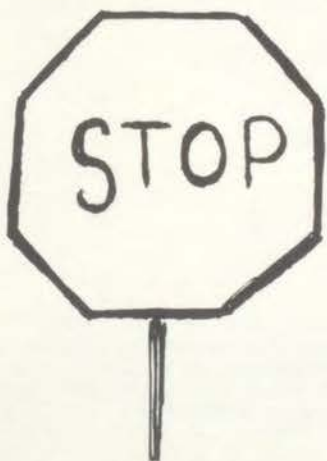
## Y-TEENS
