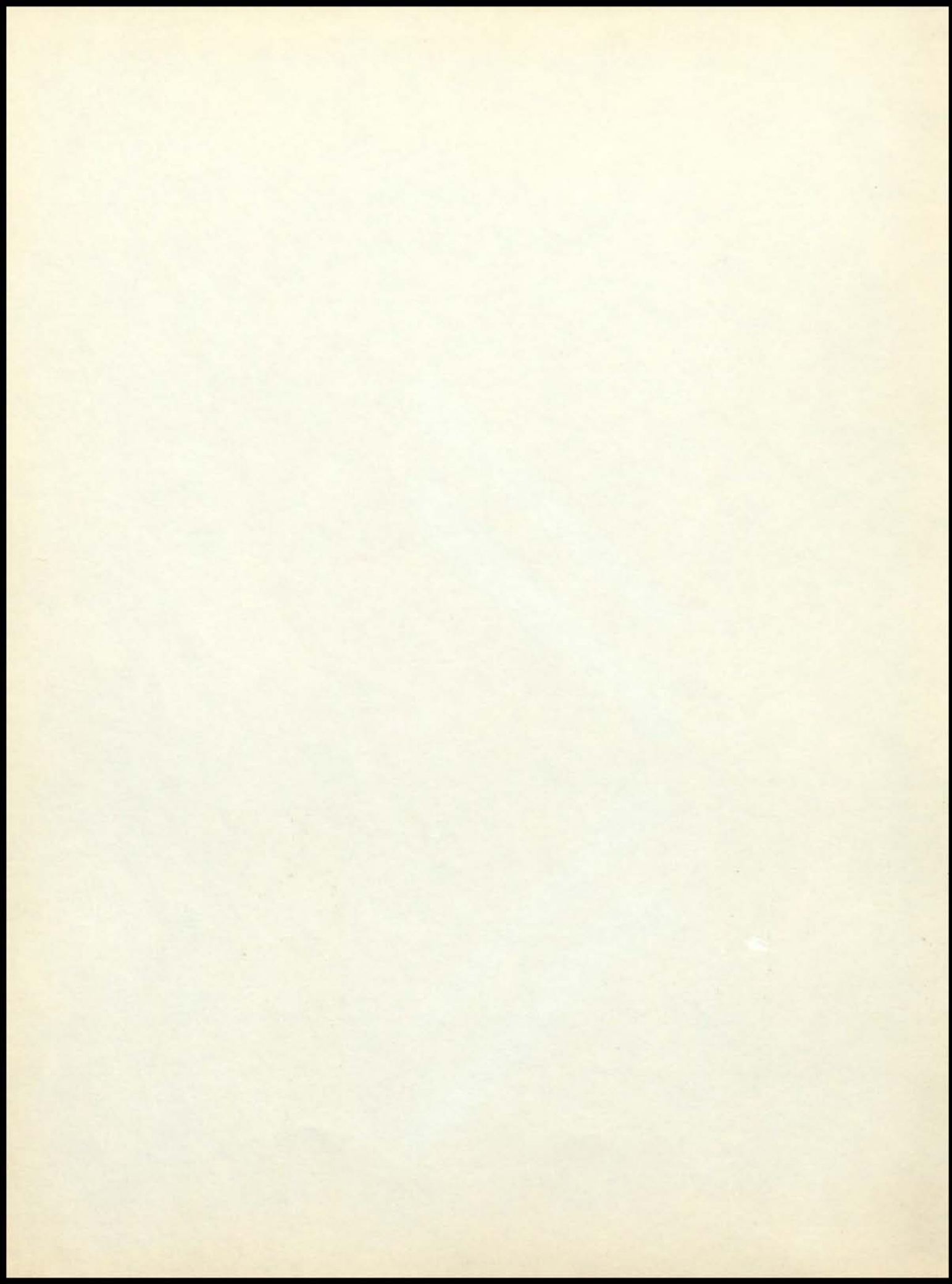




NOREASTER
