The Nike (winged victory) statuette is a special award in recognition of the special achievements and contributions Debbie has made to Northeast High School.

Debbie Hertzog has compiled a truly outstanding record in track and field athletics during her stay here at Northeast.

The organized girls' track program at Northeast has just finished its fourth season led by Coach Wuanita Small. Debbie Hertzog had much to do with putting Northeast on the track map. Many people know of our school through this fine athlete.

She has competed unselfishly and successfully for team points, rather than specialize on events of her own choosing, in the high jump, long jump, triple jump, hurdles, 60,100,220,440, 880, mile, all the relays, and cross country, and scored well in every event. Debbie won 13 medals her senior year and accumulated 33 through her career at Northeast.

She is former School Record Holder in the 440 and still holds school records in the 220, 880, mile, long jump, and triple jump. In addition, she ran legs on school record relays of 440, and 880 yards, the 880 medley, and distance medley.

Outdoor Mules Relays: 4 school records and a meet record in the 880 with the 3rd fastest time in the state of Missouri for 1977

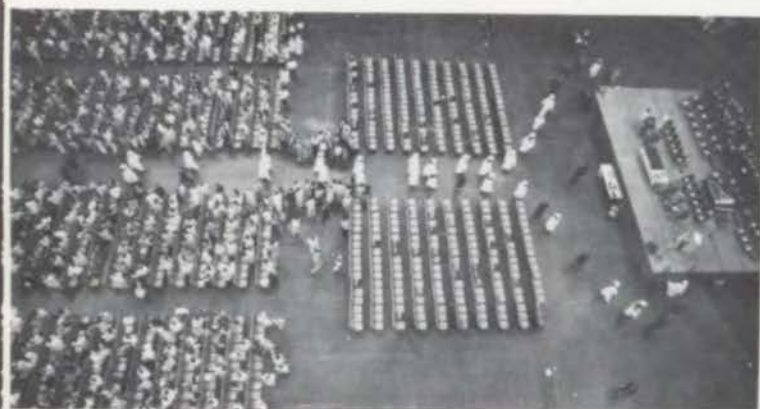
