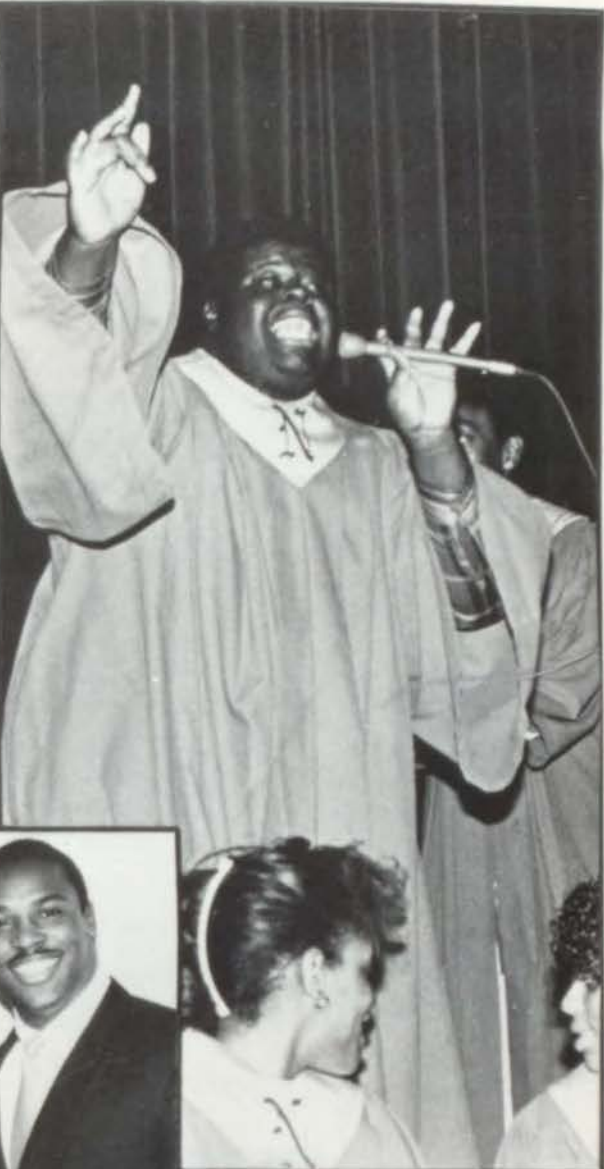
ASSEMBLIES
