Dr. Chavez is the counselor for the Life and Language SLC.



Participants were greeted at the door and led into the ballroom. About two hundred Northeasters and their guests danced the night away.





#### Northeast Lulac 2004





Students receive awards for their academic performances, honor roll, perfect attendence, and National Honor Society at the end of the year.






Teams of students from each class competed in a mini-tournament to prove who truely has the best class. The junior class prevailed by beating the sophomores and the freshmen.

## Sophomore & Junior Skating Party



#### Senior Biographies



To the lower-classmen, don't lose your focus along the way and work hard to achieve what you want, but always remember the C/O '05 is better!!




