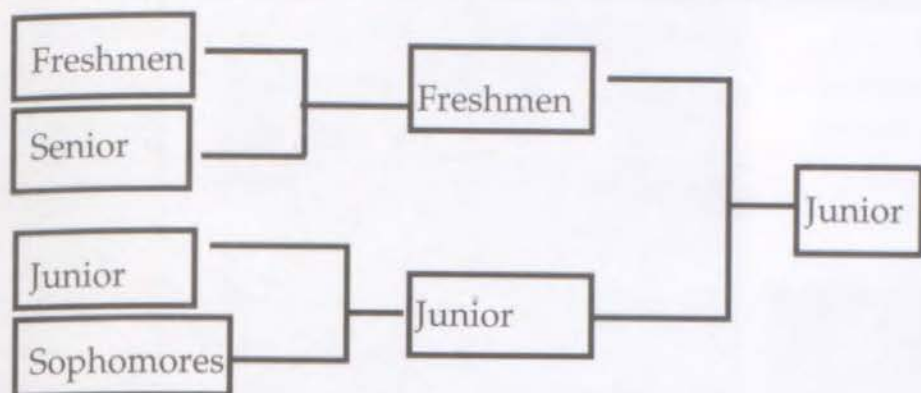
School Academic Assembly 2004

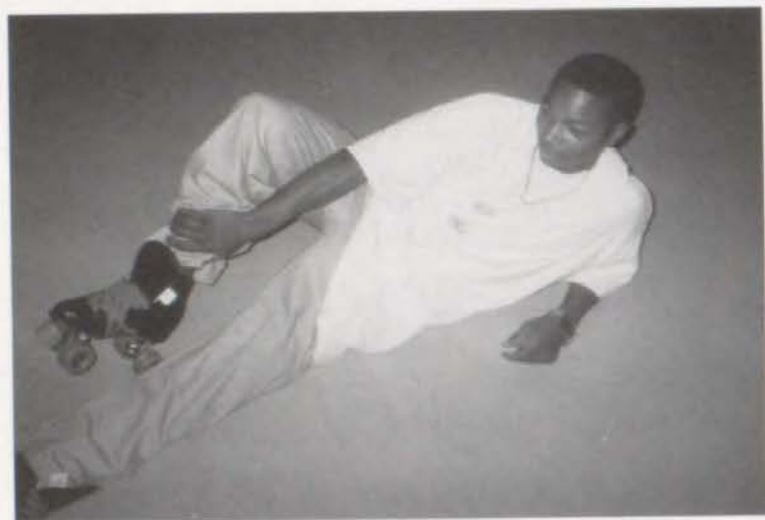
Northeast Class Sports Challenge 2004

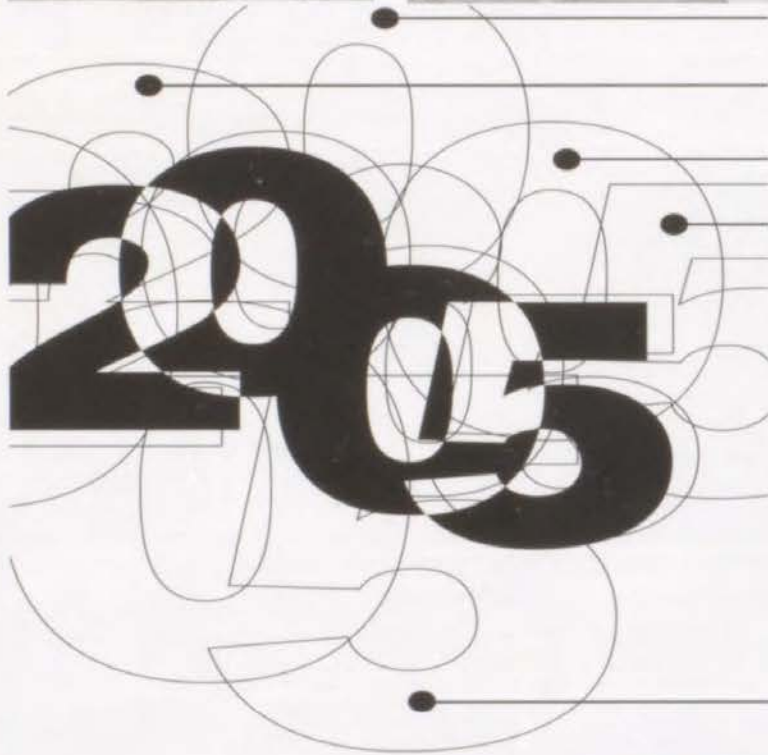
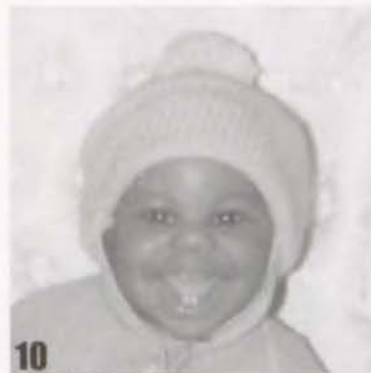

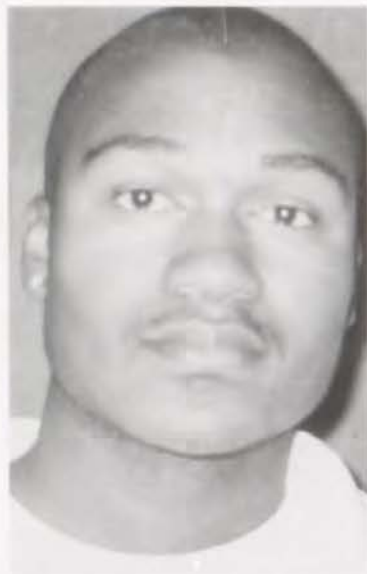
Senior Biographies
