Both middle and high school students have made it work by existing in the same school. In some ways it makes the high school students mature more than normal knowing we have younger students in the building.



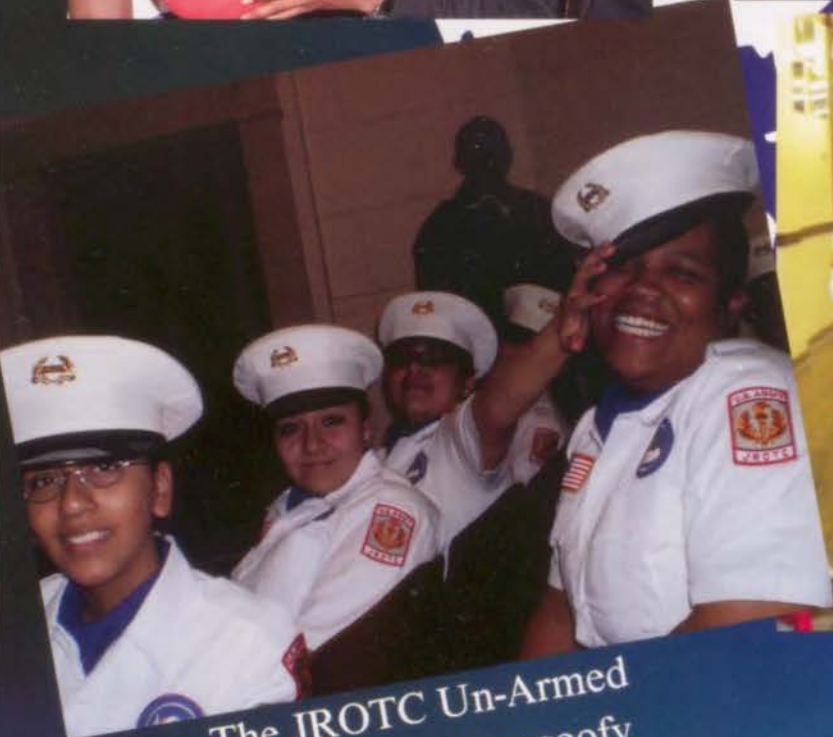

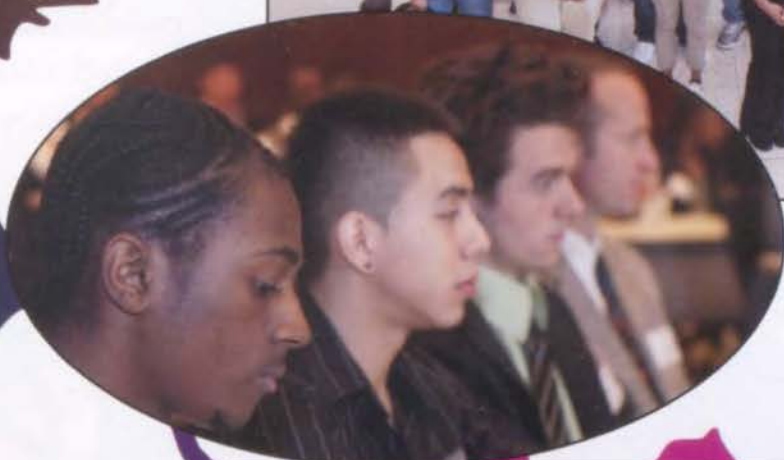

This volleyball season was our rebuilding season. We had two players from the previous season, and the rest were new comers. People who understand sports know court, so to put a group of strangers together is a hard task.

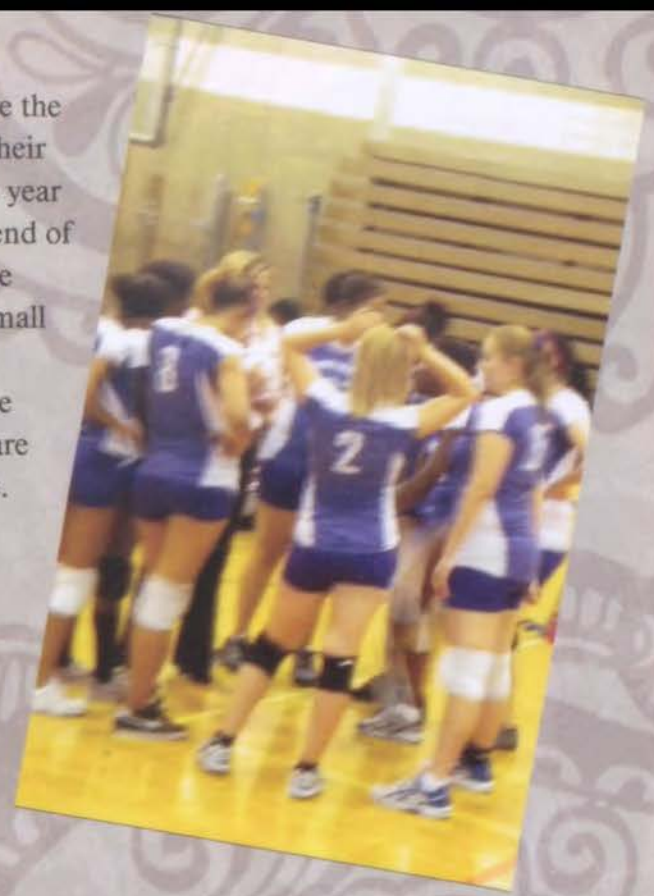
