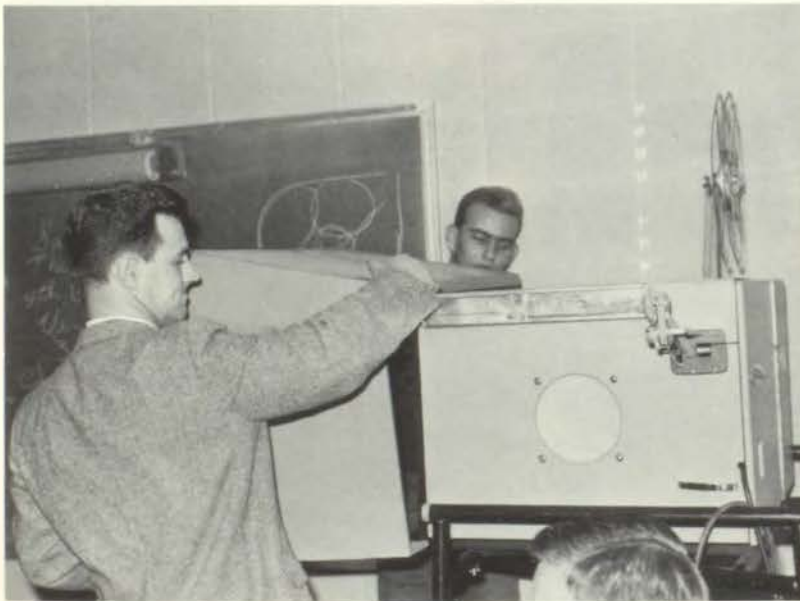

MATH DEPARTMENT EXPANDS

Ruskin's math department, after a year of transition, is now in full swing with the new programs recently begun. The up-to-date curricula, along with several young instructors, has given the department a fresh look.

Projects and research papers now add depth to the regular classroom study. Although the department has changed, the traditional intense concentration required in mathematics for many years is still necessary to the student planning a career in math.

Our mathematics department can be expected to grow further in the future.

Science

To keep in step with the rapid scientific advances of our time, Ruskin's science department is richly endowed with qualified teachers and excellent equipment. The biology classes have 30 microscopes which magnify up to 1000 times. These instruments enable them to see such things as cells, ameobae, and other small animals

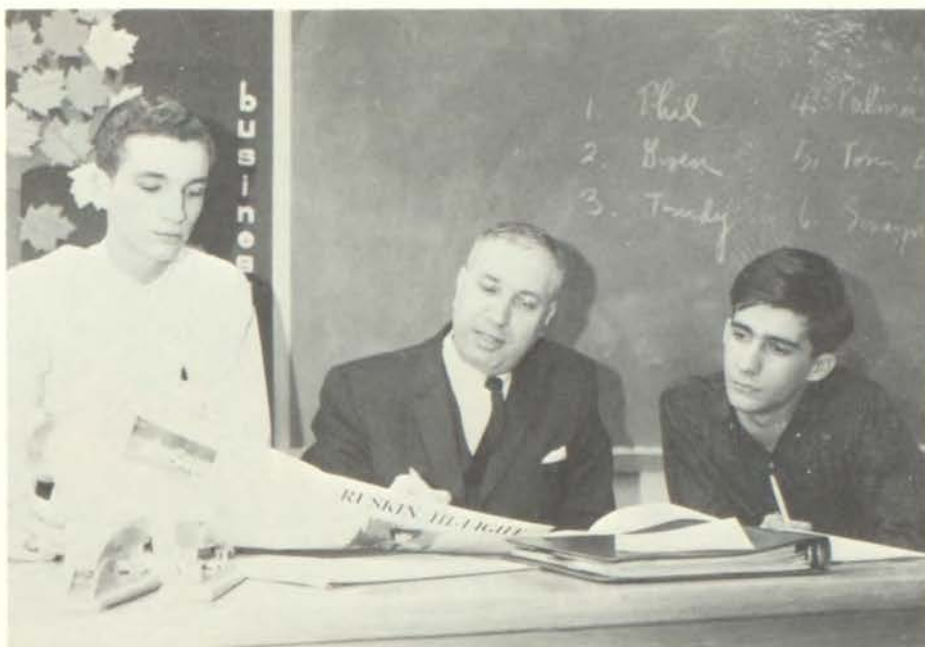

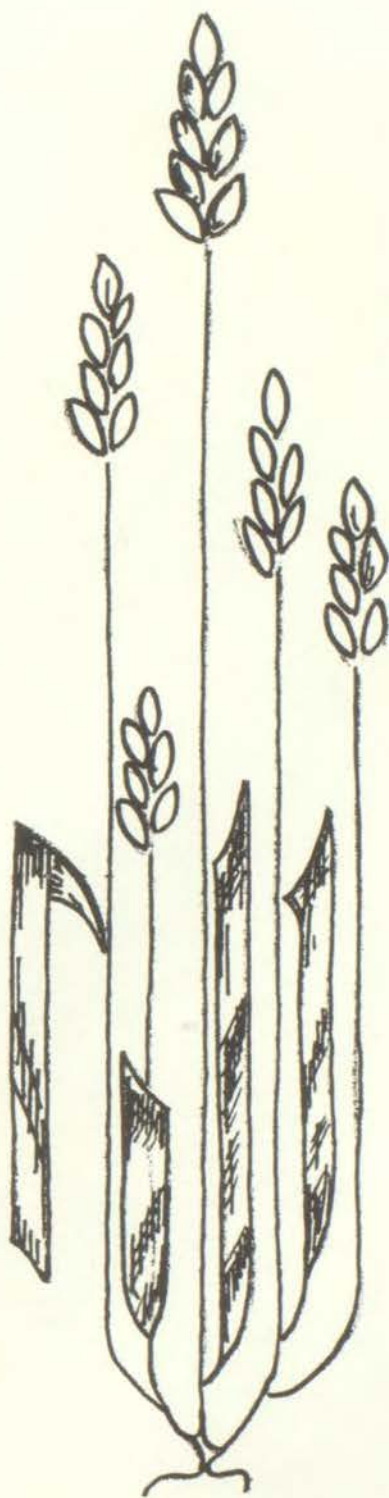
Chorus
