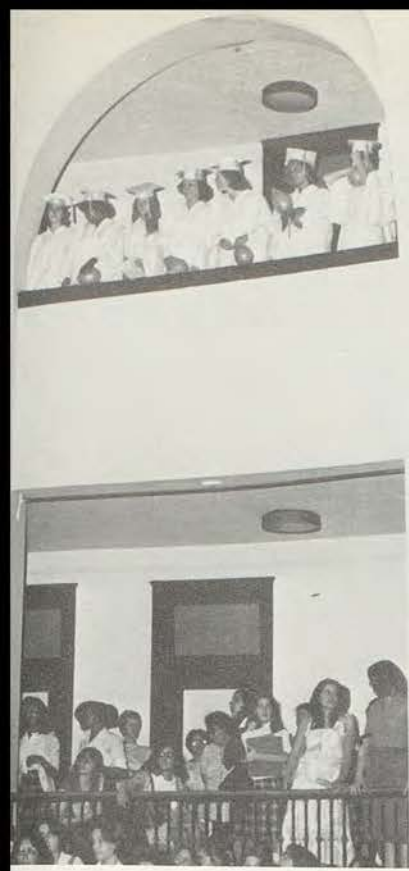


ACADEMY GIRL 1978
