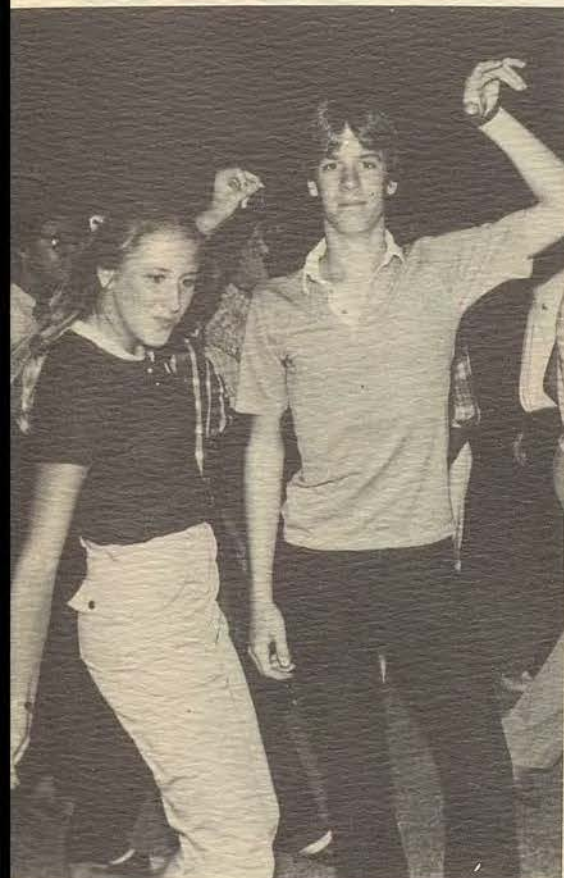


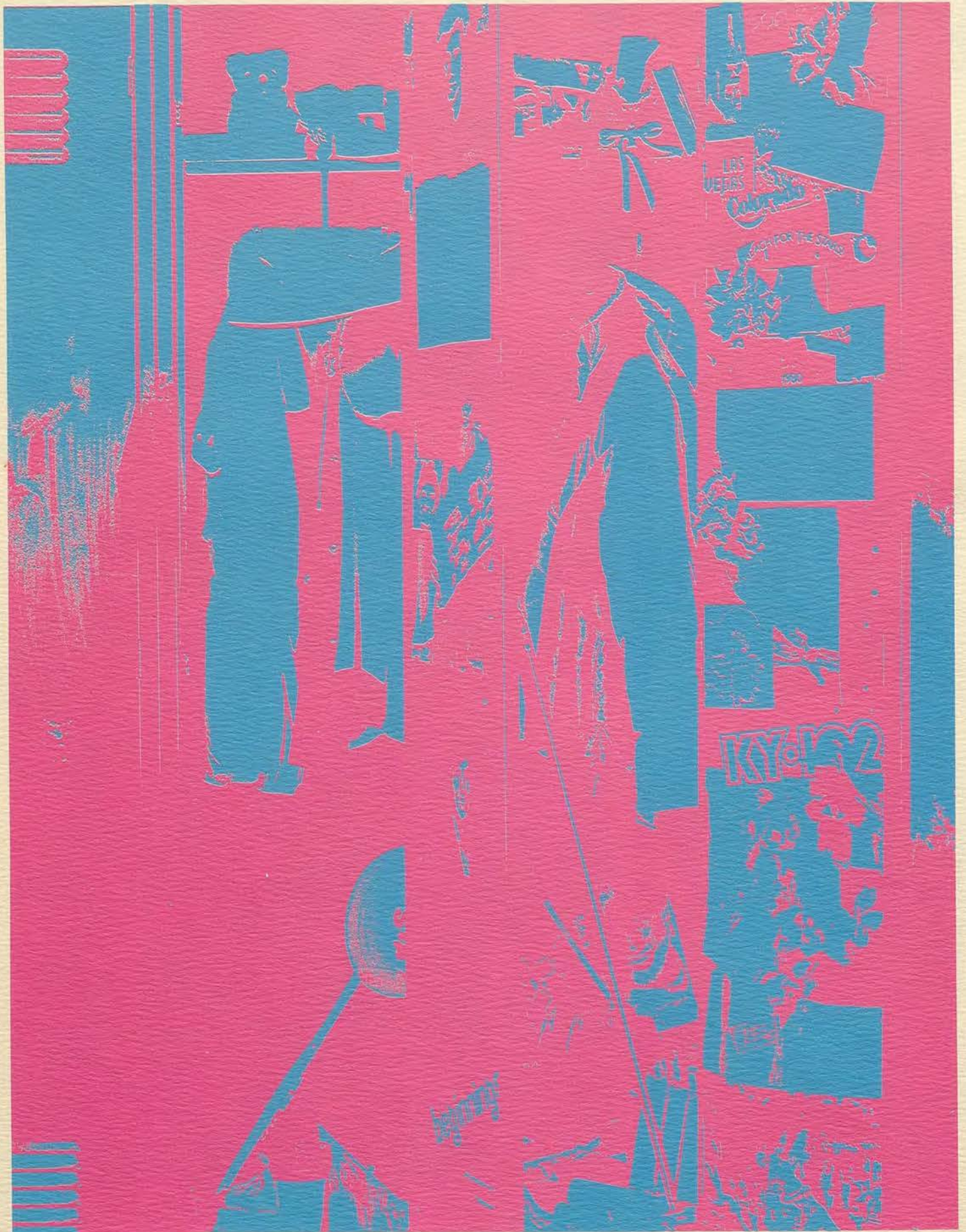


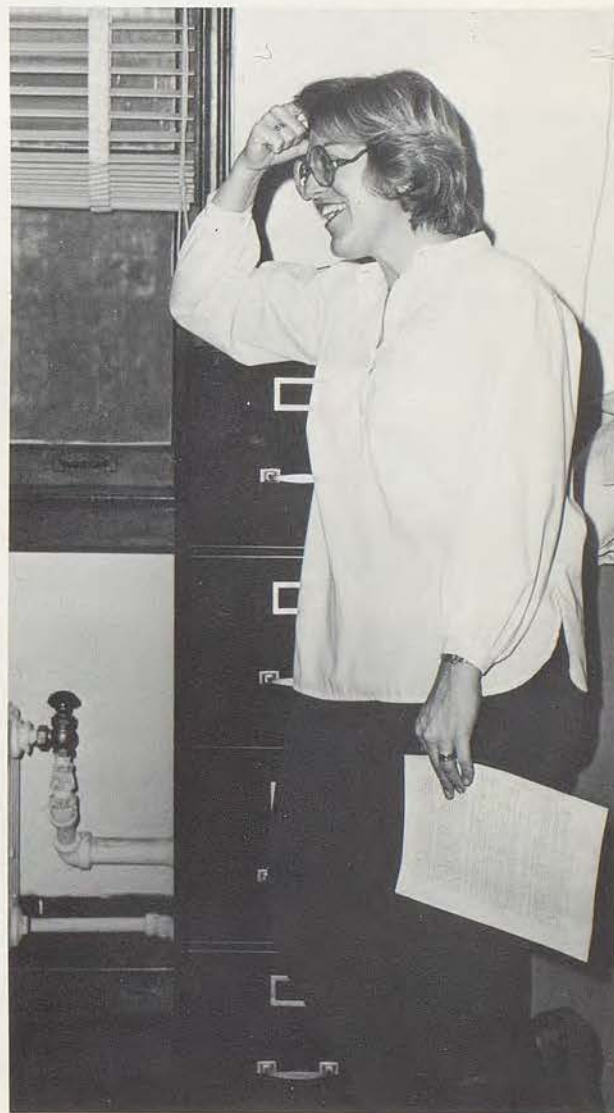
















TERESIAN '79

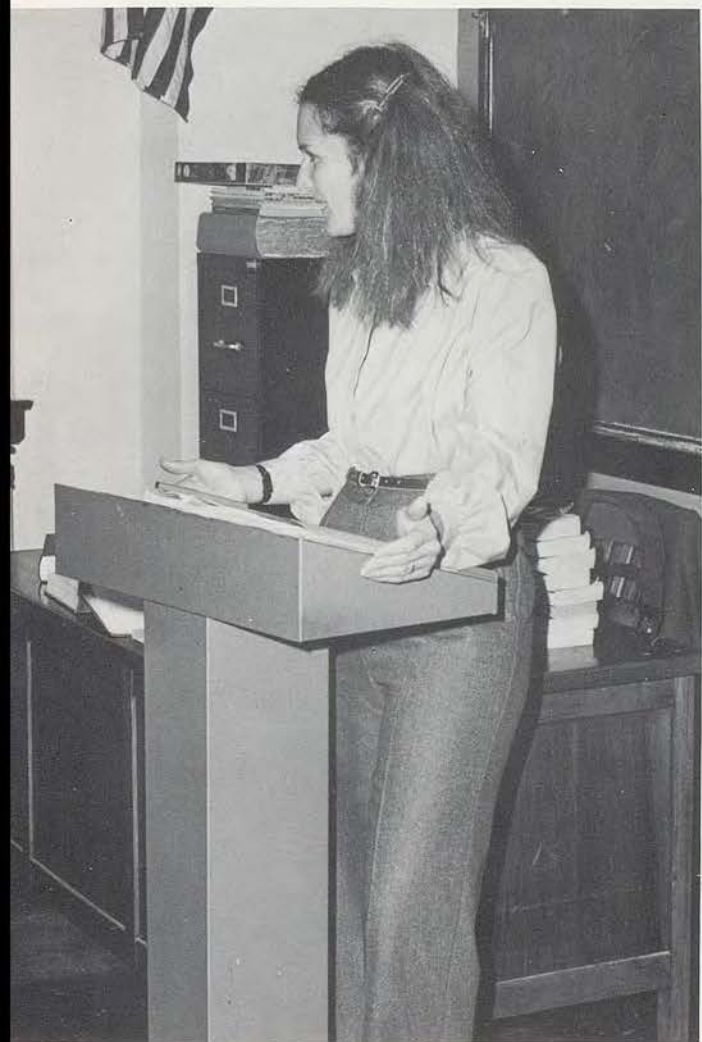
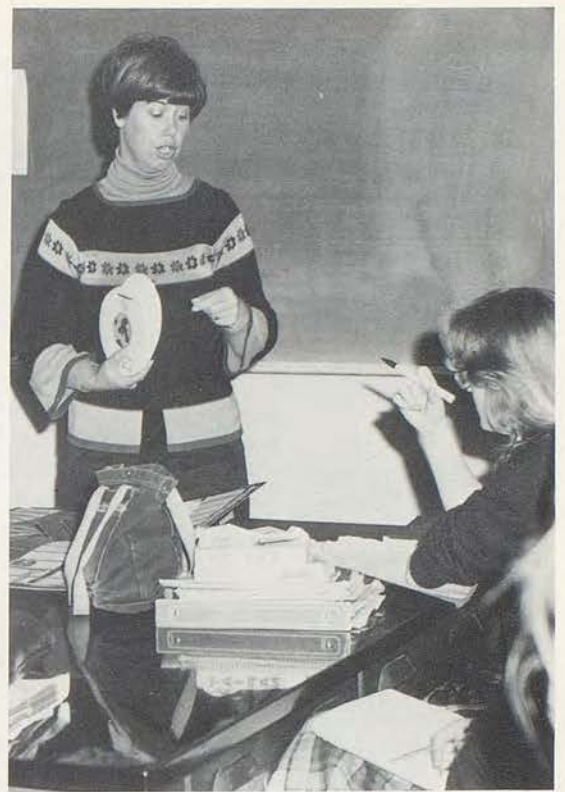






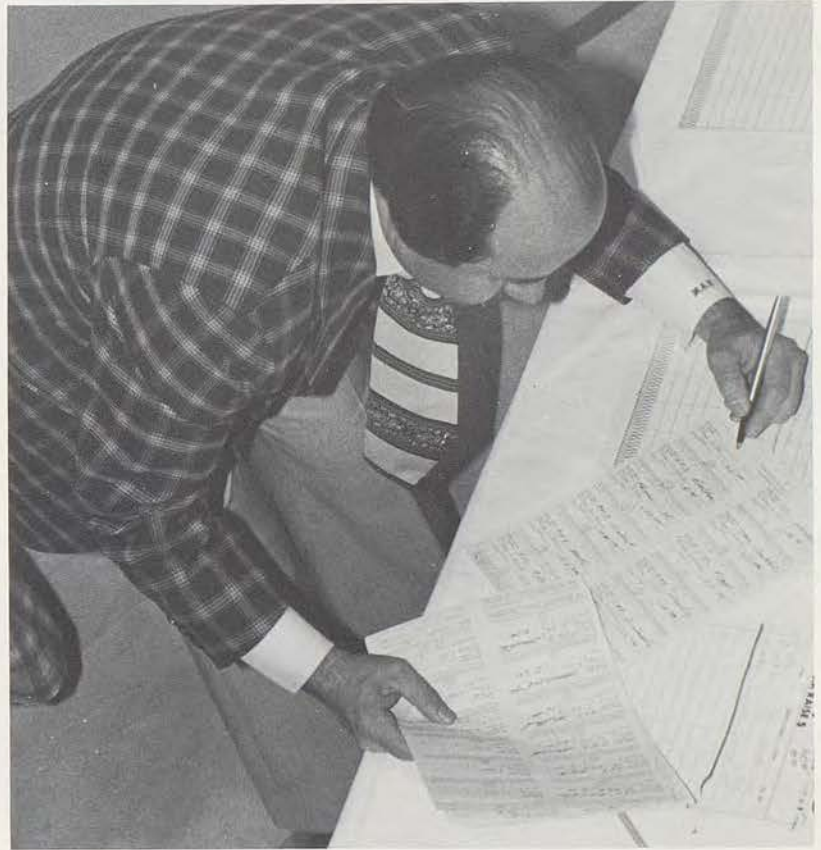








BASH AUCTION
