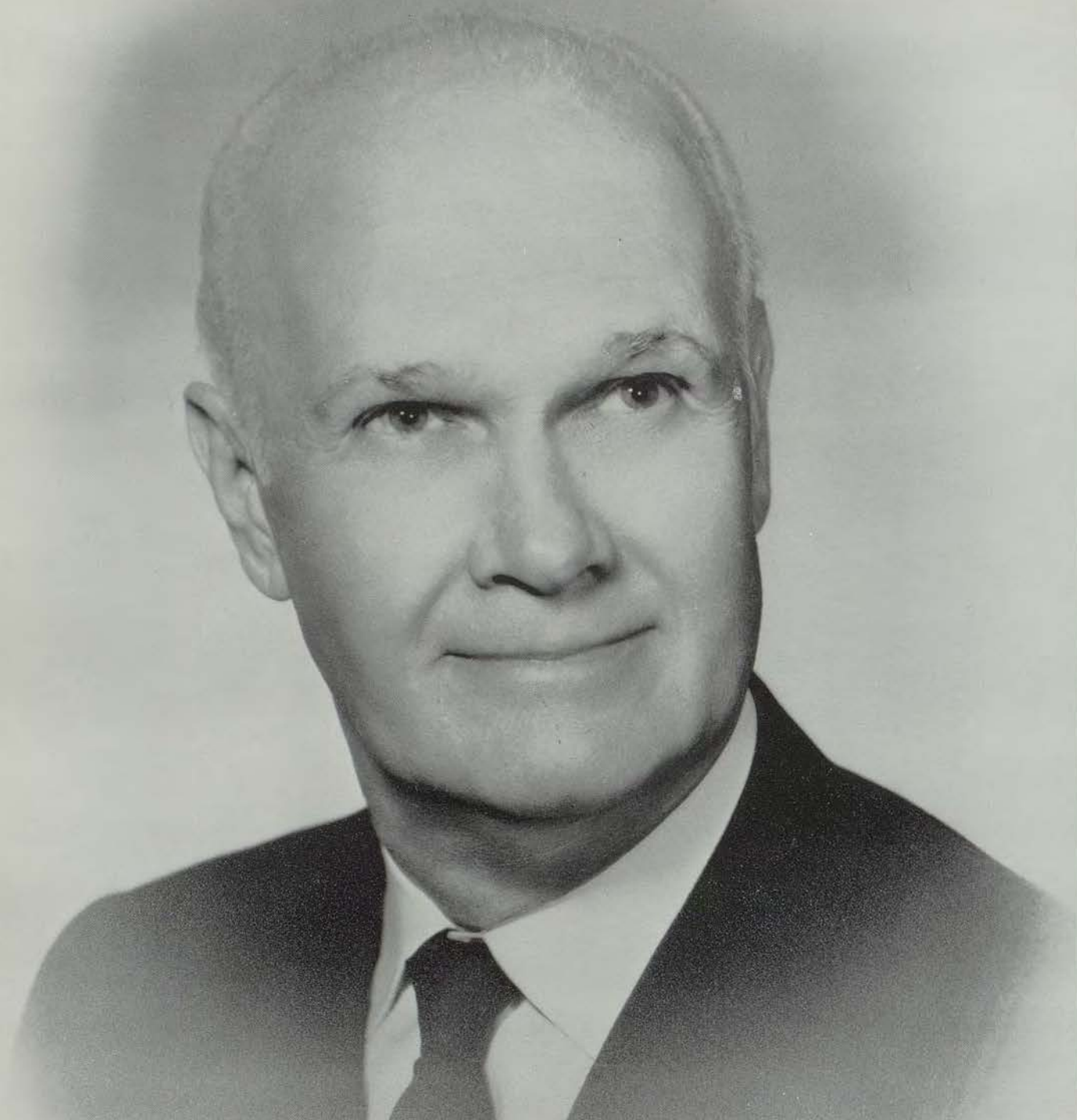




Castle

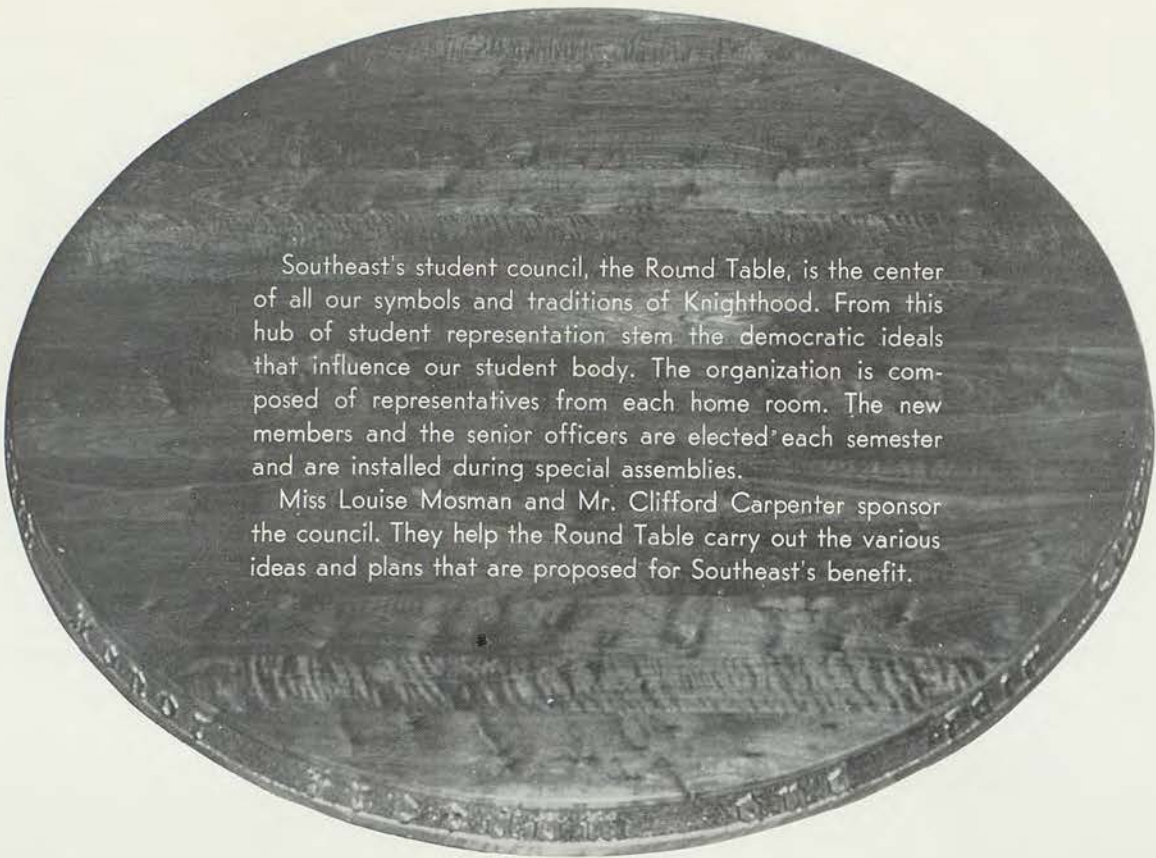




Councils
