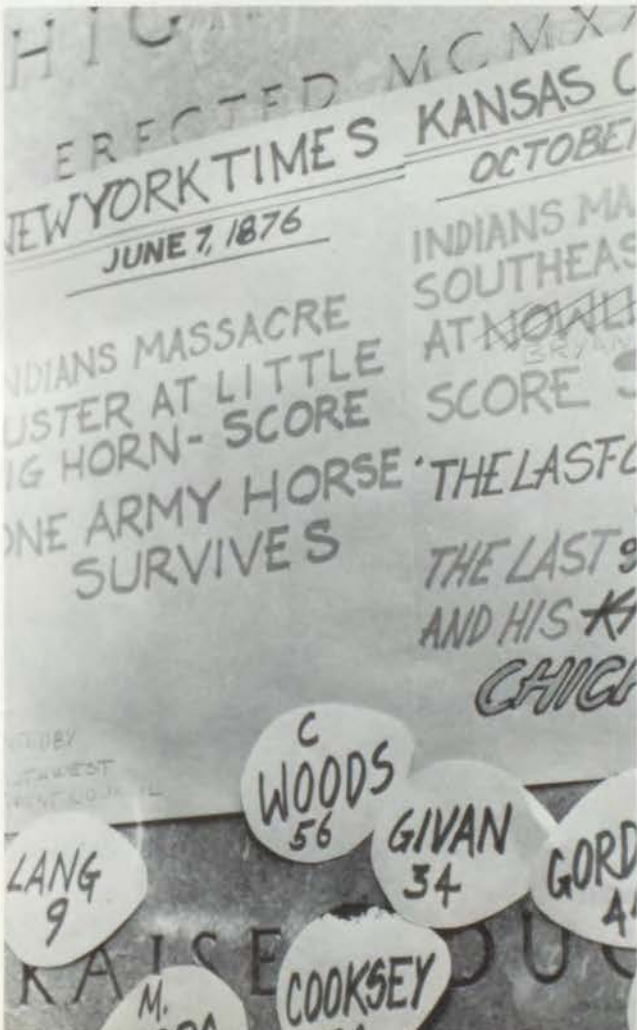


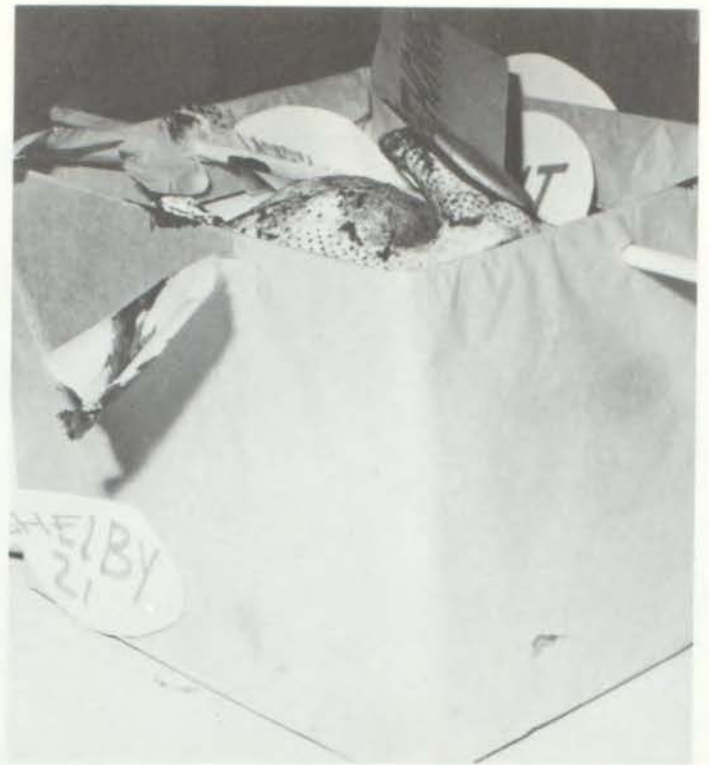
URBAN LEAGUE CAREER FAIR

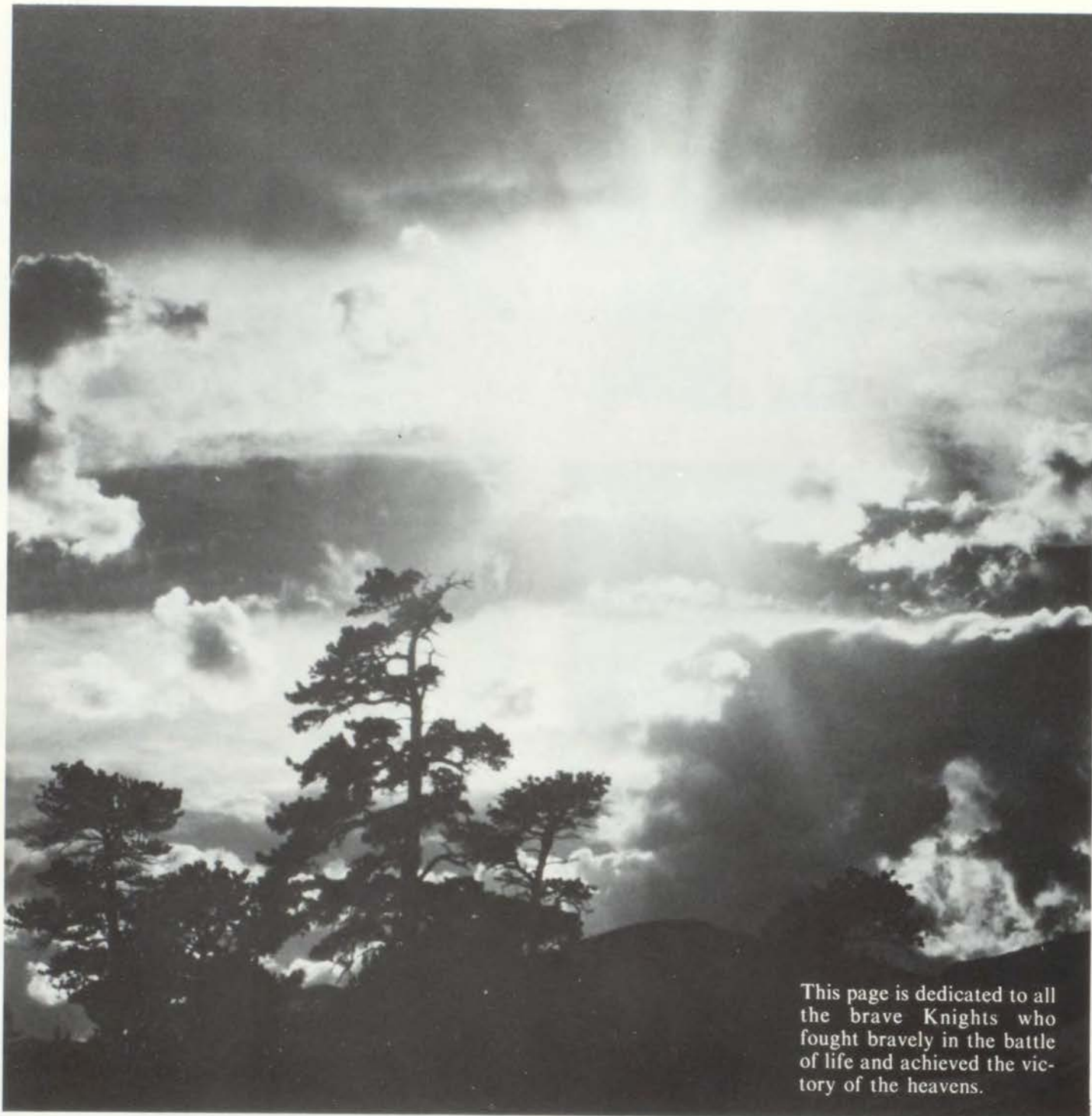
