

Football is a game of endurance and consistency. A team with these attributes can play a conservative game and still beat a team of daring offense with spectacular performance. This is exactly what the Southwest varsity team did this year. Coming as no surprise they brought home the Interscholastic League title for the fourth consecutive year, the seventh championship in the last nine years. The 1971 team was small in number and stature, but big in natural talent and ability. Coach Robinson shaped these talents to make an effective, well-rounded squad.

William Robinson, a modest man who avoids superlatives, has lot to be proud of. In his sixteen seasons at Southwest, he ha established a tradition of building winning teams that has carrie, over into the junior varsity and freshman teams. Coach Robinson engineers traditional plays-sweeps, short passes, draw plays-thaalways seem to work. Simplicity is the key.

The varsity coaching staff was short one man this year, buCl Coach Robinson's fine assistant, Sam Breckenridge, was ready to meet the challenge. Fiery but good-natured, Coach Breckenridge provided the fans with as much entertainment as the team as have strutted along the sideline, throwing comments and instructions to the players on the bench and on the field. His advice converted Coach Robinson's "simple" plays into substantial ground gainer.

The football opener with Rockhurst was a frustrating beginning for such a fine season. Junior quarterback Pete Cipolla had an impressive debut on the varsity squad as he threw 17-yarder to Tom Hulsey for the first score of the game, then look it in himself on an 8-yard jaunt for Southwest's second ouchdown. However, the extra point attempt failed, and Rockhurst's two touchdowns put them ahead 14-13. The econd contest was an encouraging upset over North Kansas City. Although North Kansas City gained a 13-8 lead in the third guarter, tackle John Jaszczak pounced on two key fumbles which set up Southwest scores. The Southwest defense held firm, and the final score was 22-13. Next, the Indians raveled to Excelsior Springs for a rainy, muddy 8-7 loss. Southwest took a 7-0 lead with a Cipolla-to-Dave Nichols pass, which was set up by a long punt return by Walt Kosman. Excelsior came back and scored a touchdown, then surprised he Indians with a two point conversion to the right side. The ollowing week, in their first league game, the squad blasted the Van Horn Falcons 29-0. Cipolla scored with a quarterback sneak on Southwest's first offensive drive of the night. The running of Jon Sloan, Jim Svoboda, and Tom Hulsey contributed to the lext two touchdowns. Rusty Harris took the quarterback position late in the game and hit Steve Sitler for the final score of the night. In the fifth game of the season with the Bishop Miege Stags, Southwest capitalized on their opponent's eight urnovers. The first Southwest score came as Nichols interceped a Miege pass and sprinted to the goal line. Cipolla connected with Larry Birt just before the half to put Southwest in front




12-0. Again Rusty Harris entered the game and threw a touchdown pass to Walt Kosman. After other scoring, the final tally as 30-0. Next, the Tribe moved on to meet Central. The defense proved its endurance by holding Central to one score. Two touchdowns by Kosman and one by Cipolla brought the final score to 22-8. The next battle was a low spot in the league play. Cipolla hit Don Sloan for Southwest's only score of the night. Manual thrilled its fans with a long bomb late in the fourth quarter to tie the score 6-6. The Homecoming game was a nail-biter as Southwest edged Southeast 15-14. The Knights grabbed a 14-0 lead by the end of the first half, but the Indians emerged from the locker room undaunted. Our tremendous defense shut out the Knights in the second half and scored a touchdown on a blocked Southeast punt. Tom Hulsey scored the last touchdown. The excitement came when Rusty Harris pulled the ball away on the extra point kick and hit Nichols in the end zone for two extra points. The ninth game was a crushing victory over Lincoln, 49-6. Kosman scored twice, and Sloan scored three times. The squad prepared for the final championship game with Paseo. The Indians blanked Paseo 34-0 with three scores by Hulsey.

Individual talent was plentiful in the 1971 squad. Chip Newell and Frank Storm earned All-Metro honors, and Tom Hulsey went on to capture linebacker position in the All-State team.

Channeled by Coaches Robinson and Breckenridge into a team effort, the individual skills of the varsity players brought the Interscholastic League title to Southwest again this year.



The Southwest Cross Country team participated in two dual meets, one triangular, and three invitationals. On September 10, the team defeated Van Horn 15-46, and a week later they defeated Rockhurst 19-41. The Raytown South Invitational was held at Swope Park, September 25, with Southwest finishing tenth as a team. The following week the team placed seventh in the Ruskin Invitational held at the same course. The Warrensburg Mules Festival was run on the Pyrtle Springs golf course with Southwest finishing second to Sedalia Smith-Cotton. Southwest won the Interscholastic League Triangular at Swope Park on October 22. The score was Southwest 18, East 46, Van Horn 74. The district meet was held at Longview Community College on Saturday, October 30. The team placed sixth in the meet, but Mark Bowman's first place individual finish earned him a trip to Columbia to participate in the state meet.

Representing Southwest, Mark earned a 14th place medal, competing against 201 boys from all over the state of Missouri. He lowered the Southwest Cross Country two-mile record to 10:01.


#### Homecoming 1971





During the first week of school, the ROTC cadets are assigned various leadership positions according to their abilities. Then they begin working on their drills. Through these drills they achieve coordination, leadership, teamwork, and a sense of unity. Also at the beginning of the school year they emphasize their extra curricular activities. The activities include the rifle team, the drill team, and the color guard. These activities further the cadets' sense of unity and they give them a goal to strive for. The goal all schools try to strive for is the Kansas City Star Award. This award indicates the best performing school in the city.

The ROTC courses of instruction are designed to touch most of the phases of military life. During the cadets' first year they are introduced to topics such as military courtesy and organization, American Military History, hygiene and first aid, knowledge of various weapons, and marksmanship. During the second year of training, the cadets are enrolled in military tactics, leadership, map reading, markmanship, weapons, and drilling. The third year course teaches most of the same topics as are taught in the second year course, but at an advanced level. Other subjects taught during the third year include new developments of armed services, service opportunity, and military teaching. During the fourth year the cadet studies psychology of leadership, advanced leadership, tactics, and new developments of the Armed Forces.

The ROTC units desire to arm their cadets with the best equipment for a future occupation.

In March, each ROTC department in every school holds its annual unit readiness inspection, conducted by Lt. Col. Robert C. Adams, director of the Army instruction of the Kansas City Public High Schools. The purpose of this inspection is to see that each and every unit is prepared for the Annual Federal Inspection. The Federal Inspection is when a team of Army Officers inspect the facilities of each unit. The end of the school year brings Field Day activities. All ROTC cadets in every Kansas City Public School go to the parade grounds of Southeast Public High School, in which competition in drill activities takes place. Awards are given to the best deserving drilling platoons or the best drilling companies.
