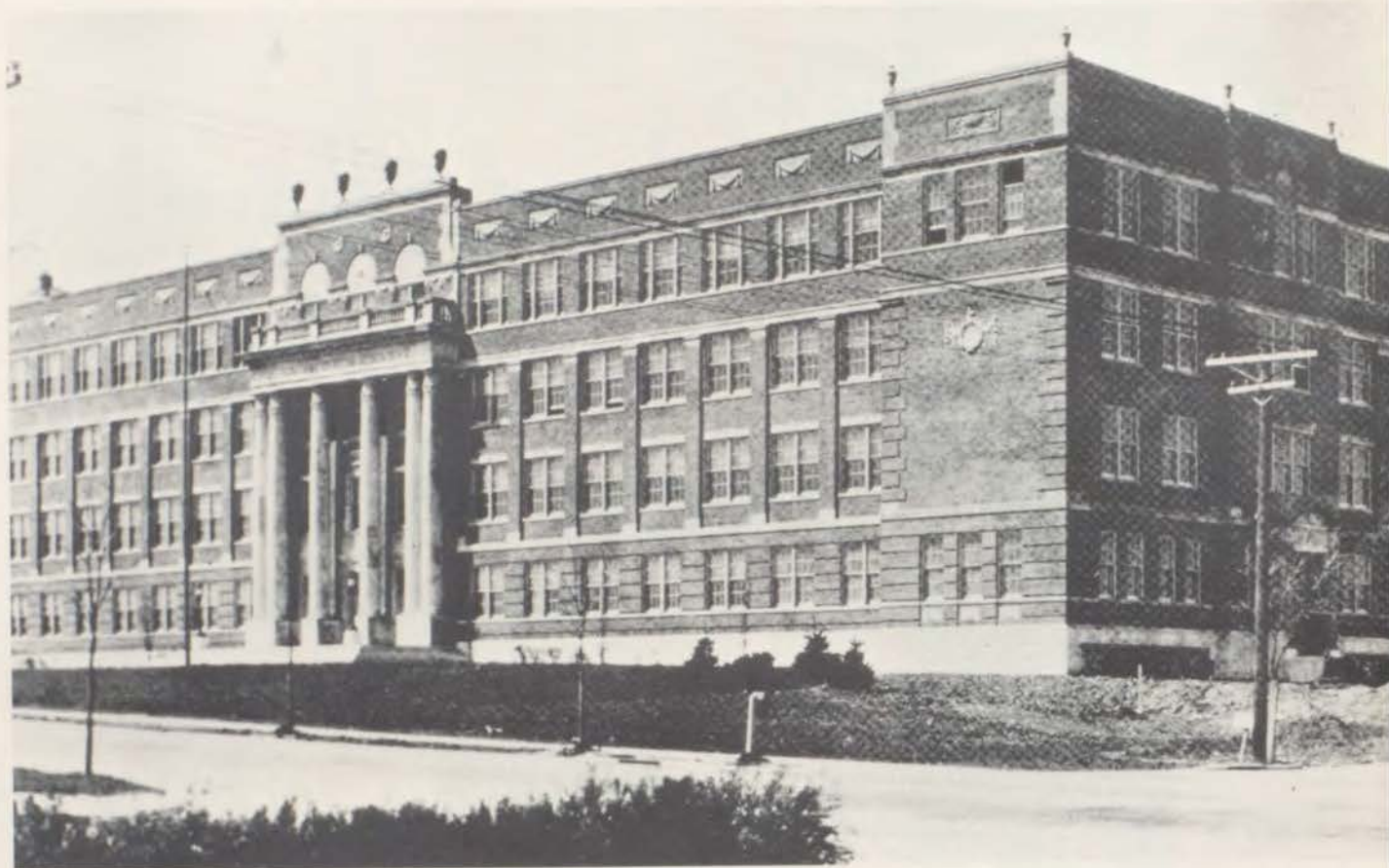




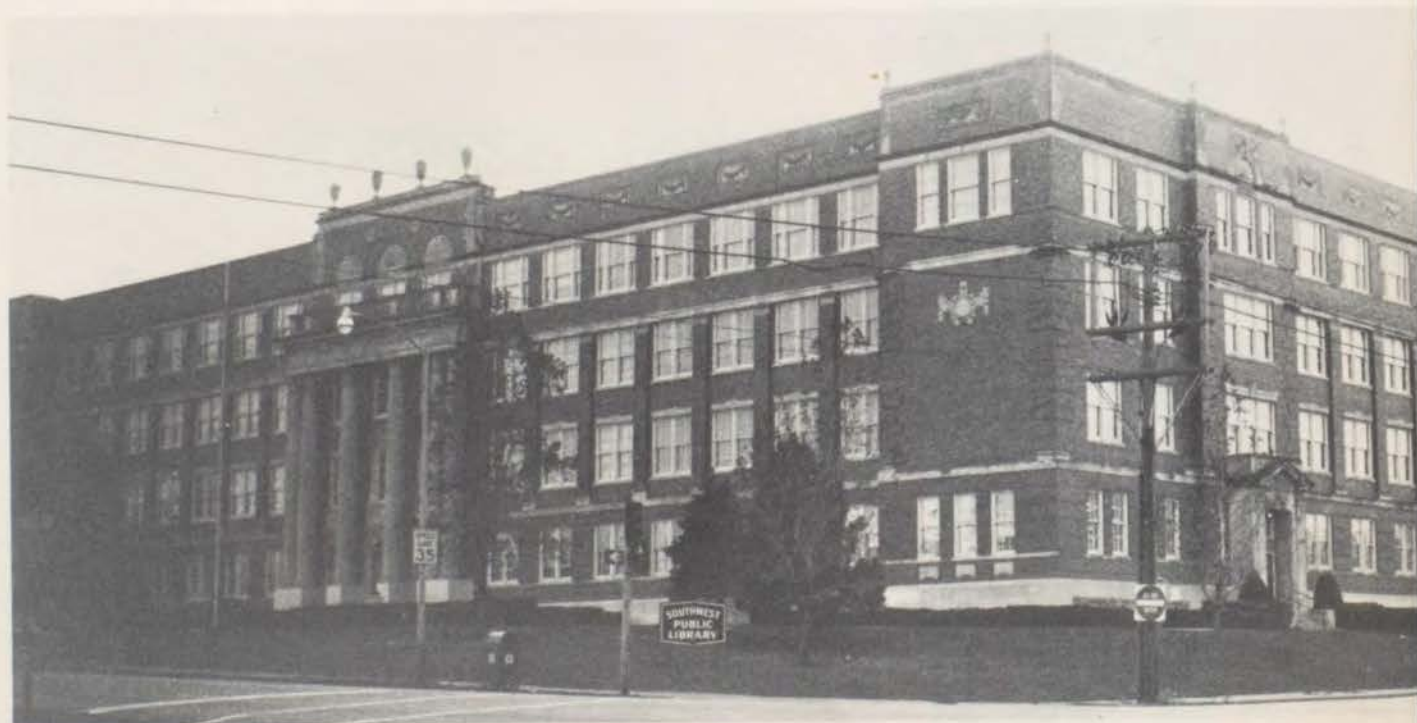

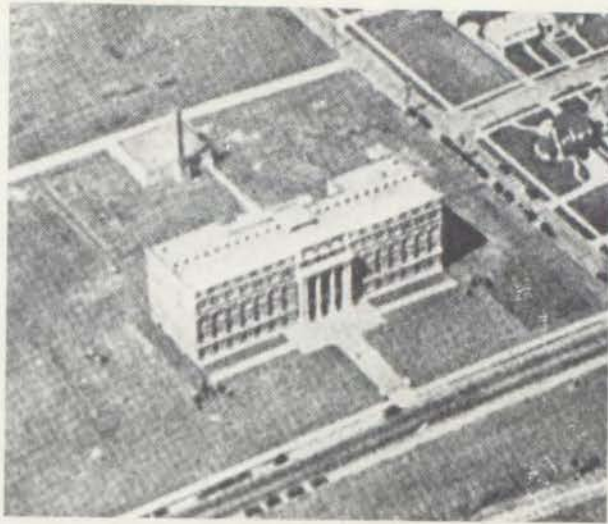

Above building just being completed by Sharp Bros. Construction Co., 604 Orear-Leslie Bldg. Charles A. Smith, Architect. 1927.



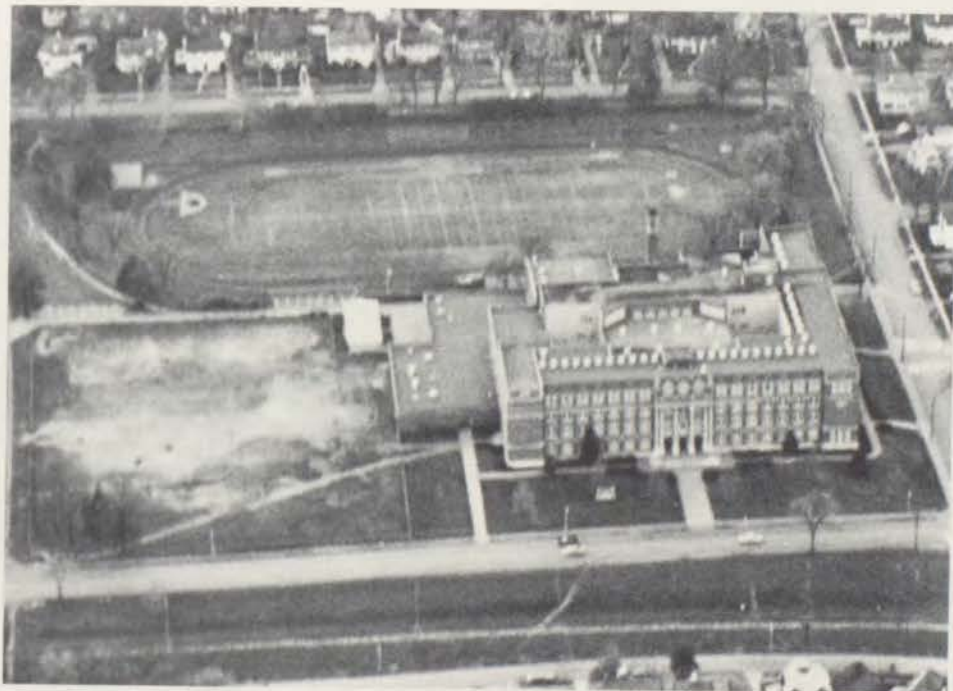

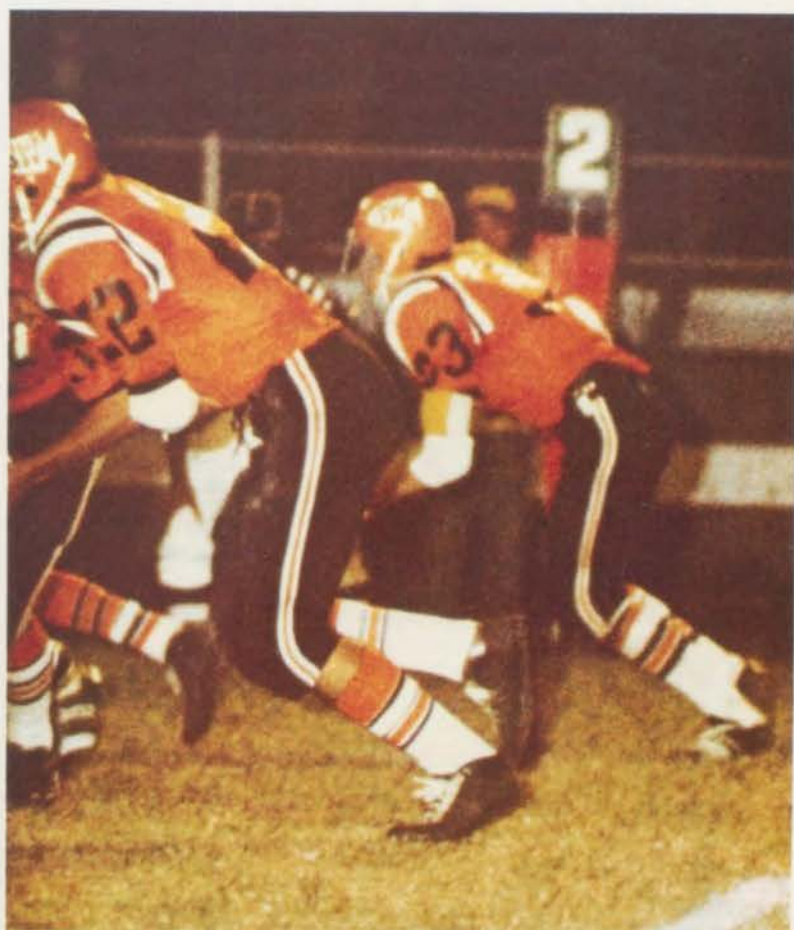

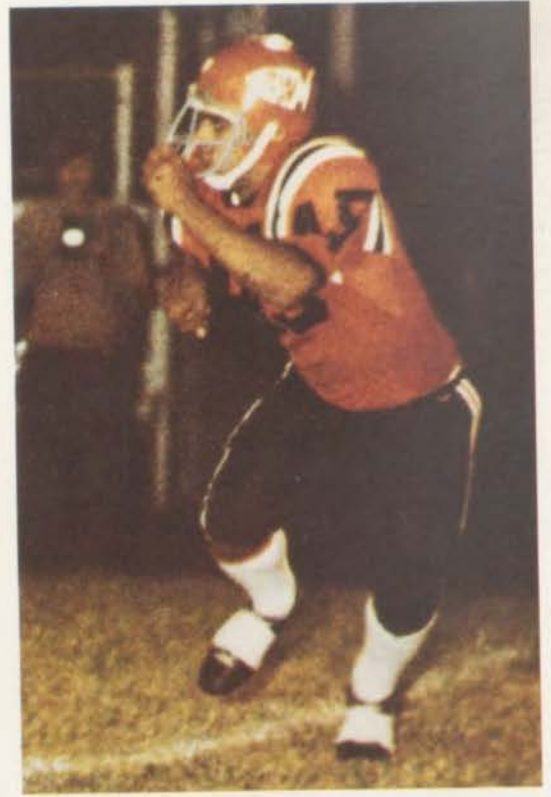

This game also showed Southwest's amazing ability to come from behind. One highlight of a 57-3 win over Westport was a school record 71-yard punt by Larry Humbird, who gave the Indians excellent kicking all season. After losing to Central and Rockhurst, Southwest came from behind in the second half to defeat Van Horn, 12-7. The climax to an action-filled season came in the fourth quarter of the Southeast game when Southwest blocked an extra-point attempt to preserve a 14-13 victory and regain the Southside Trophy.

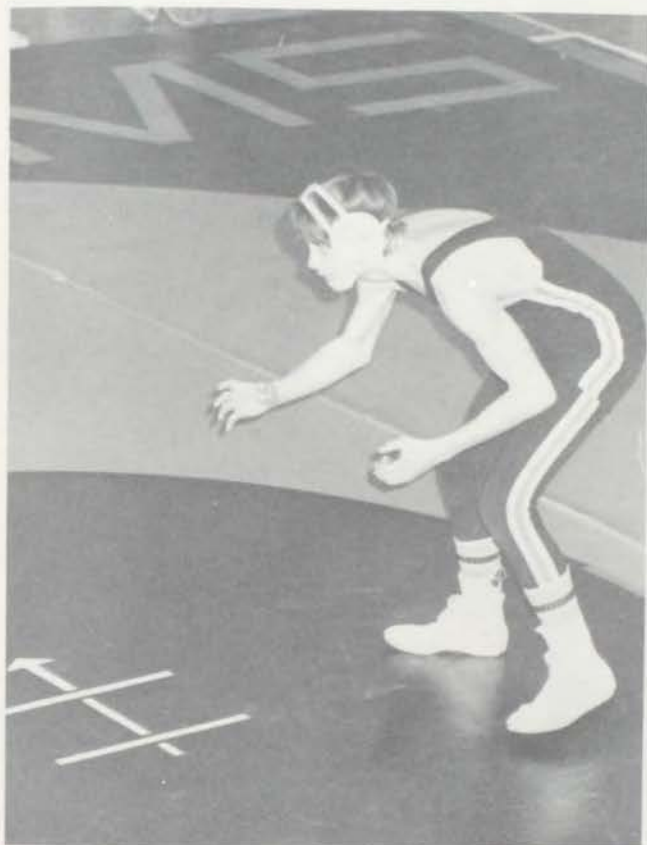

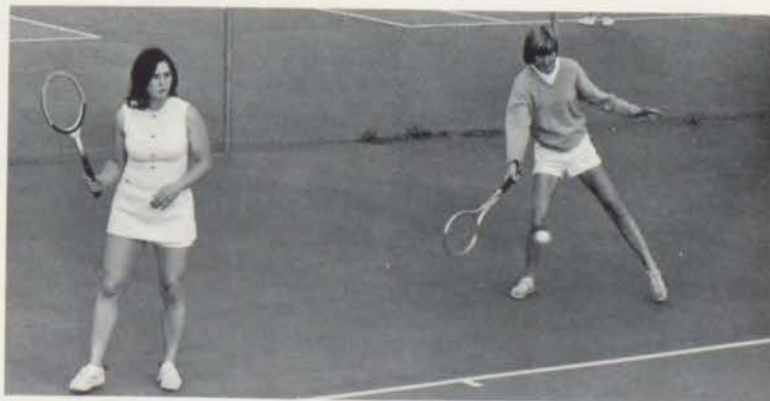
