in each one. Their opponents were tough, but the Injuns were tougher.

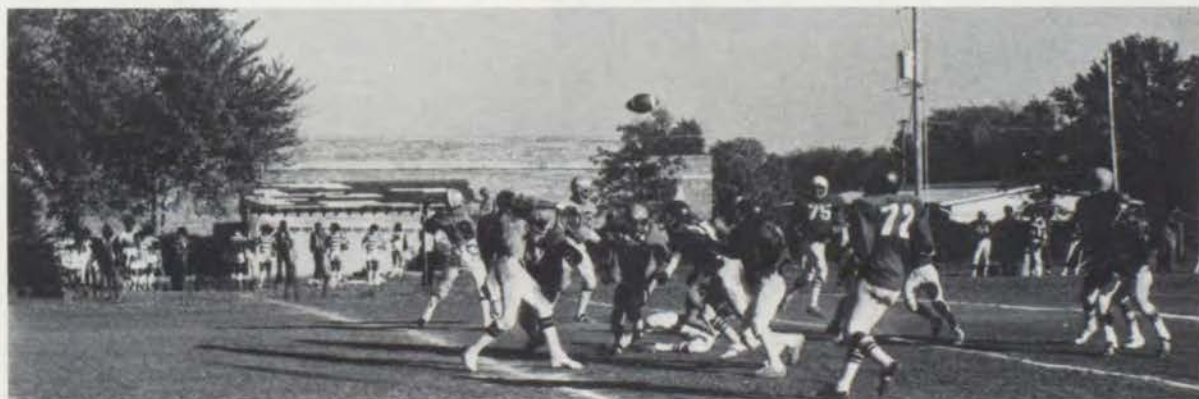


Freshmen
