














Senior Class Officers

By observing and participating in the life of Van Horn, my family and the American society, my mind has grown to one of broadness. At least, I'm less stubborn about my Europeans than when I left Norway. You have failed to Americanize me, but you have made me love you by your broad smiles and strong beliefs. I have gained more from this year than I ever thought I would. I have found an active social life by which I have acquired a new prospective of life, the American people and their vast democracy. All this I could not have gained without your acceptance of me as an individual and not as a stranger. My thoughts about you change from week to week as I get to know more and more people and I have found that we are all alike. We are all human-beings with the same feelings and beliefs in what is right, even if our different political or social opinions have led to some 'hot" discussions.

Before I came I was impressed by statistics, skyscrapers, washing machines and so forth. Now I realize

the only way to know a country is to know the people who make it work. Even more by your hospitality, I'm struck by your wonderful informality and willingness to help. You have all made me at home in your country, of which you can be proud. I remember your smiles and kindness the first days at school when my confused "self" was in a bewilderment. You are all living in the heart of America and your people whose hearts have warmth, openness, and giving. You have also enabled me to give—to give of myself and my beloved country. By words, thought and givings, we have got to understand each other.

Your school spirit has impressed me, even if I hated the football games with its screaming, pushing and popcorn. How uncultural!! Later I came to accept it as an American way of expressing jay and to fool each other. You have taught me all your crazy dances and ridiculous "slang" expressions and I da have appreciation, even if my Norwegian teachers will be shocked. My dear friends, it is for your eagerness, lave and informality I will remember you—not for your skyscrapers or red sportscars.

My teachers have largely contributed to my happy and rich experiences by their patience and helpfulness. The first time you said to me "Hi, hon" and I will never forget it. Independence, Van Horn and my family will always be my "image" of America. My school is of course the best one even if we lose all the games and my family and town are the most lovable and fabulous. My happiness and gratitude toward my family is beyond expressions. They have helped me in all my doings and opened their hearts and homes of love to me. You have all aroused my admiration and love and will always be a part of my thoughts and feelings. We have got to understand each other and I strongly believe that understanding is the only way to survival in our world of today.
