If by any chance anyone of you come to Turkey, I would be delighted to see you and recall my past memories at Van Horn.

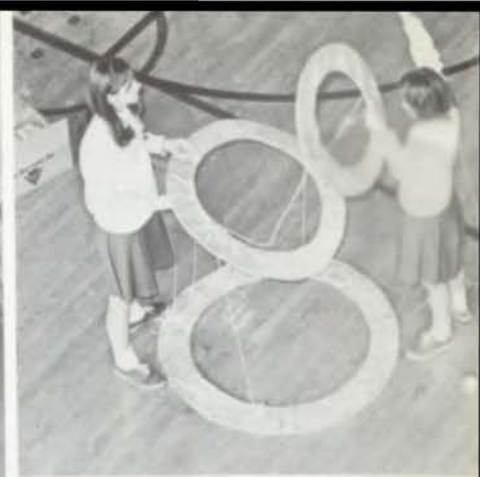
