











Van Horn started out in 1955, bringing you the school of Red and Gray. It started then, it's here to stay











In 1963, the following year, the Senior class gave us a statue of our Falcon, the school symbol




















I am assigned the responsibilities of discipline at Van Horn. It is my duty to work with those students who get into difficulties with their teachers or other students at school.
