Van Horn started out in 1955, bringing you the school of Red and Gray. It started then, it's here to stay

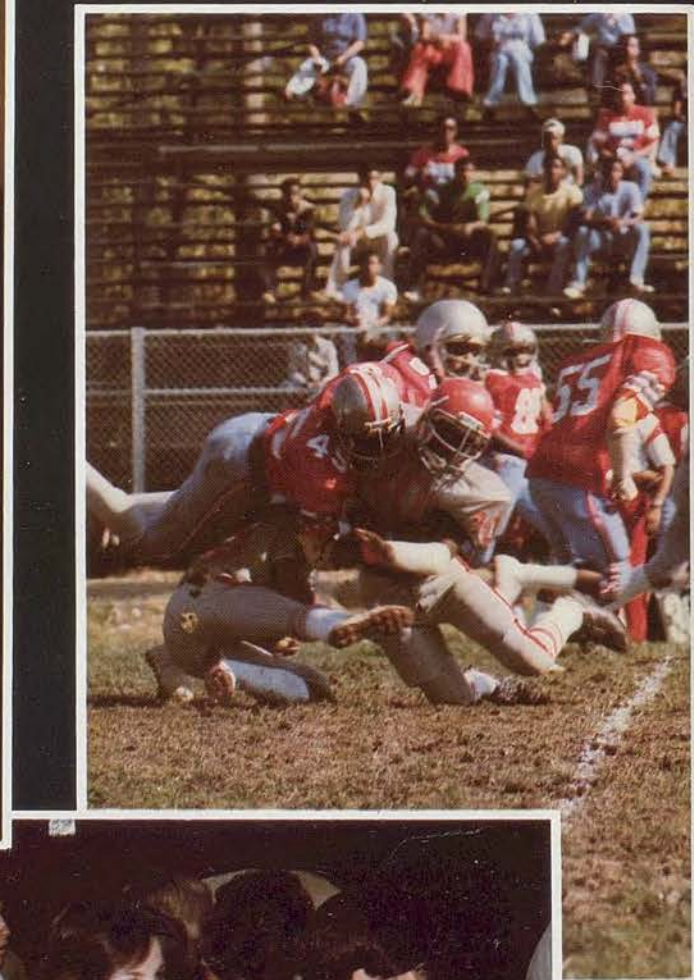

We are indebted to the Editor and the staff that made this publication possible. Thank you.

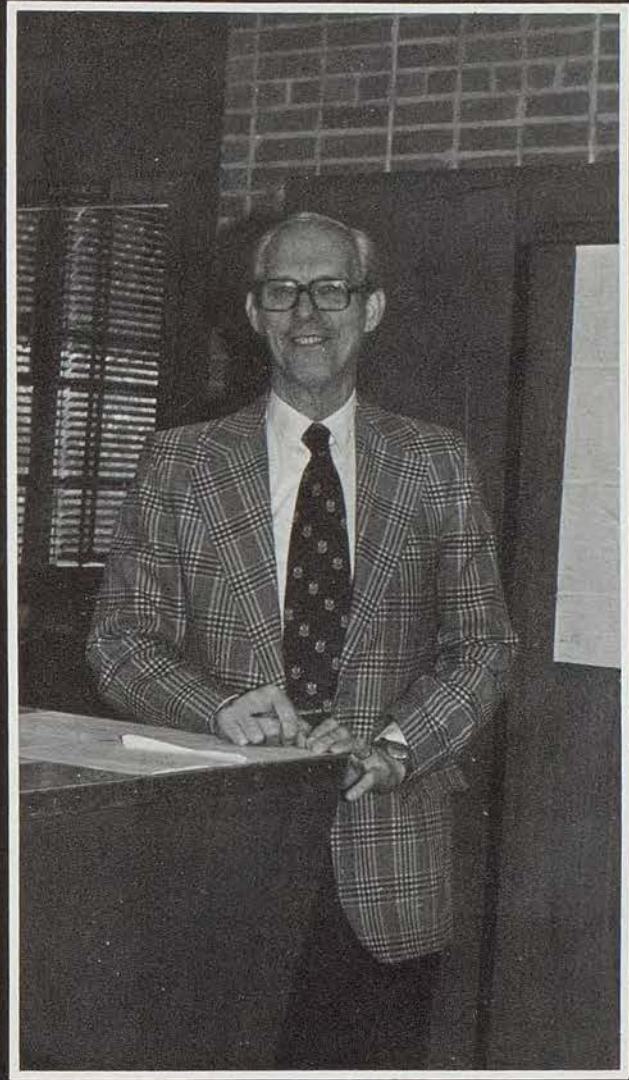

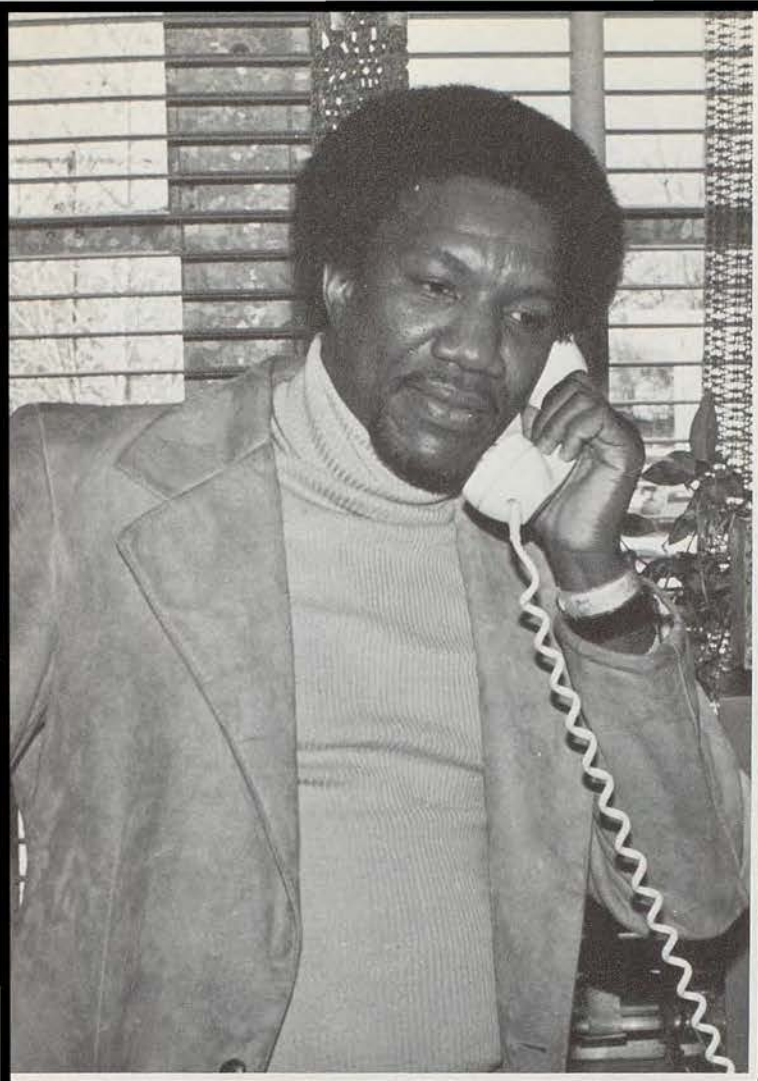




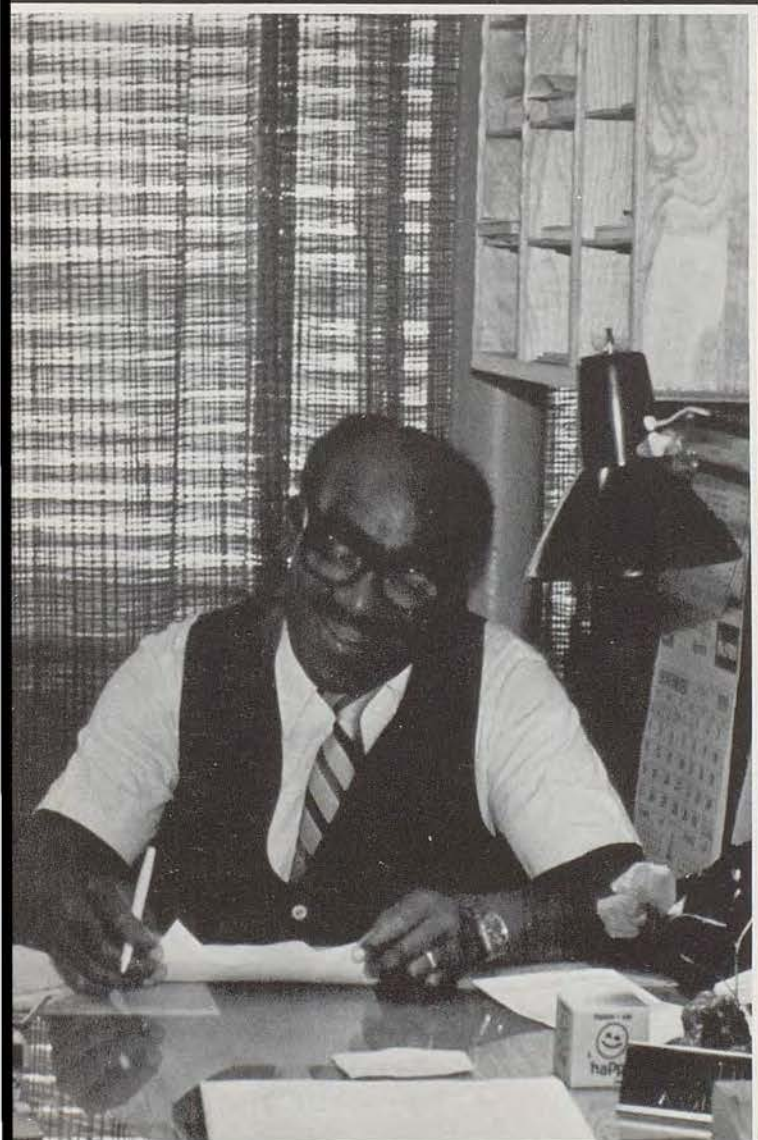
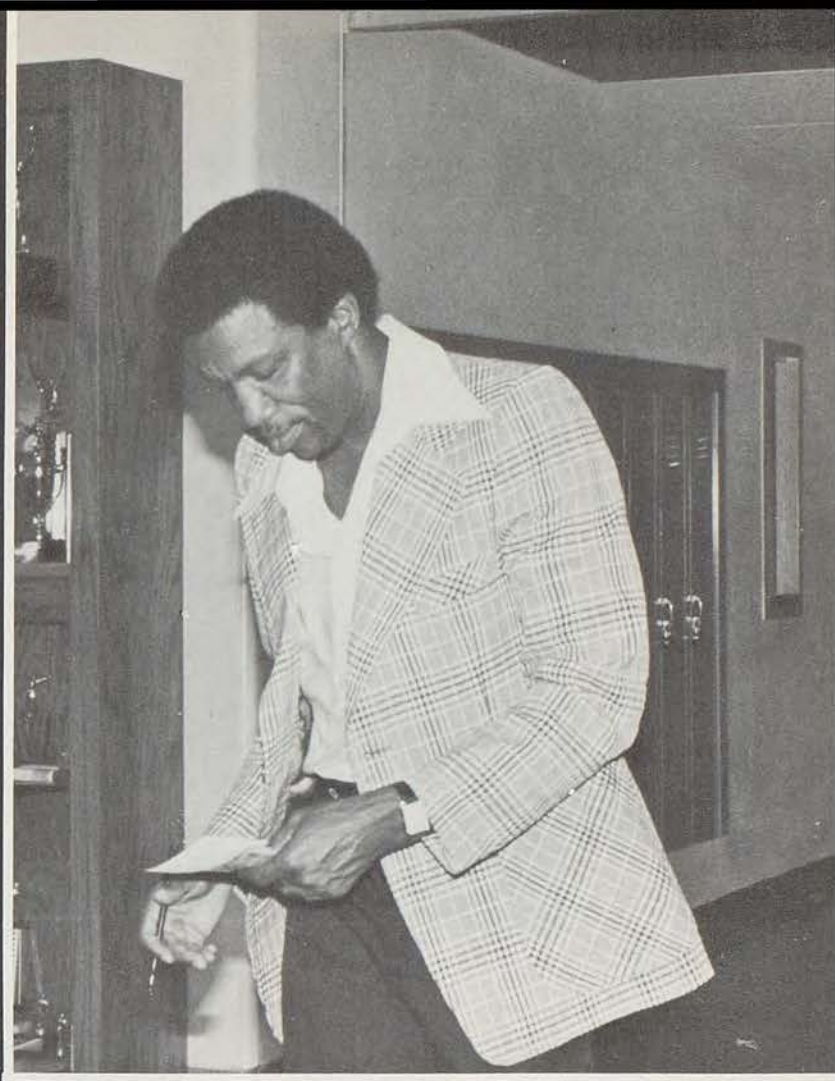
I am assigned the responsibilities of discipline at Van Horn. It is my duty to work with those students who get into difficulties with their teachers or other students at school.
