Three years come September 1972 WEST HIGH SCHOOL had its beginning. In all reality we have only just begun. Sports programing begun that first year with J.V. Basketball and J.V. Track, it grew to encompass J.V. Football, Varsity Basketball, J.V. Basketball, Varsity Track and Wrestling. This year our program reads: Varsity Football, Freshman Football, Varsity Basketball, Freshman Basketball, Varsity Track and Wrestling. That's what I call growth, but "We have only just begun."

During the school year 1969-70 West had no drama and speech department nor did we have what one would define as fine dramatics programs where students participated freely and willingly. The last two years has shown much growth—in Speech, Drama and Debate, for this we are all proud: but "We have really just begun."

West can be very proud of its Reading Department and the input by all History and English teachers that have worked diligently to raise the overall reading level in grades 8-10 as depicted on the Metropolitan Reading Test by nearly 2 full grade levels in the last two years, but "We have only just begun."

One can readily see the establishment of the pride young people take in their school, although some may not yet profess this pride through the beautiful job produced in your annual yearbook. The events that became noteworthy became greater & greater, but yet "We have only just begun."

College offers persons many opportunities and we see many of our young people following this direction upon graduation and one must stand proud when you look to see that seven of twenty-nine of

our first graduating class of 1970 are now attending college while three of seven are on deans honor rolls of their respective colleges. Seven of twenty-nine represents twenty-five per cent of the graduating class and this is a fine representation. We must also reflect that thirteen of forty-seven graduating seniors of 1971 are also attending college which reflects a percentage increase to twenty-seven, but "We have only just begun."

Apathy becomes the most talked about problems within our schools today and I feel strongly that it is related more to ones attitude about life than any other factor and to maintain our "We have only just begun" feeling and to continue to grow & mature as individuals and as a unit (West High Wolverines) I would identify two short notes. The first-author unknown:

"You may fear you are growing old & there is nothing you can do about it. Now those who retain their youth are those who keep up a HIGH INTEREST LEVEL. Nothing gives on a constant flow of vitality so much as BEING INTERESTED in many different things. If you have allowed yourself to become rather apathetic, TUNE IN AND TURN ON."
