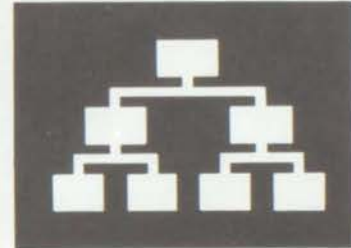
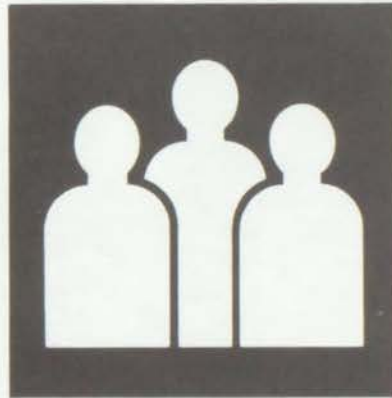
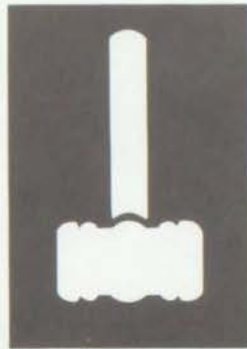
DEDICATION

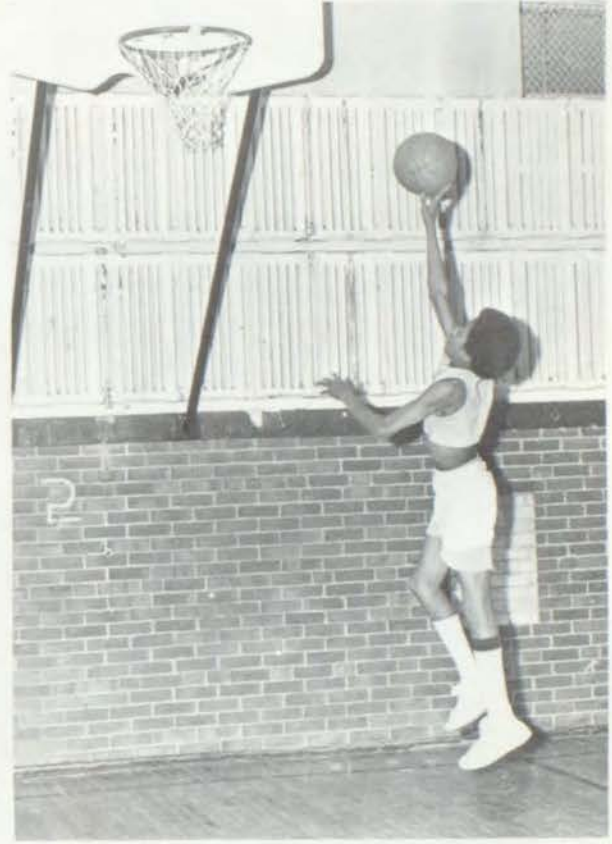

This is an honorable award to a team that has represented us well this past year - an award to be proud of.

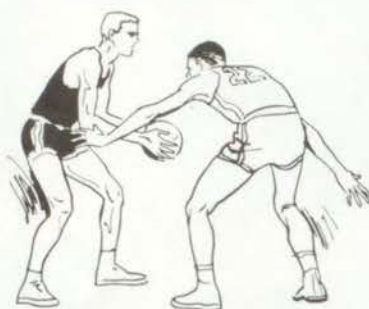
