Rounding out his list of accomplishments, Edward currently serves as senior editor for the *Crier* and is senior class president.



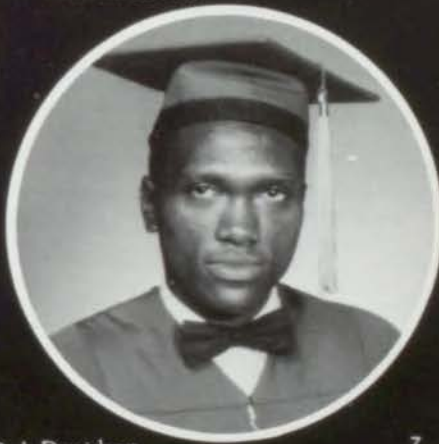
