Historical Sketch

The Historic Kansas City Foundation is a nonprofit organization that advocates for the preservation and rehabilitation of historic buildings, neighborhoods, and places in Kansas City. The organization was founded in January 1974 by Mrs. Whitney E. Kerr, Mrs. George Dillon, and Mr. Hal Sandy. Since its inception, the organization's

mission has been to preserve Kansas City's cultural heritage and built environment, as well as educate the public about historic preservation.

To support its mission, the Historic Kansas City Foundation has been active in engaging with its members and the public through events, educational opportunities and publications, and rehabilitation projects. Throughout the years these have included the annual Possum Trot fundraising event, heritage hikes and historic tours, and publishing the *Historic Kansas City Foundation Gazette*.

Scope and Content Note

This collection contains photographs and supporting documents, publications about preservation, and building and neighborhood pamphlets. The items in this collection document many of the projects and preservation efforts of the Historic Kansas City Foundation. Materials in this collection are arranged by item type and subject.
