Traffic is crippled

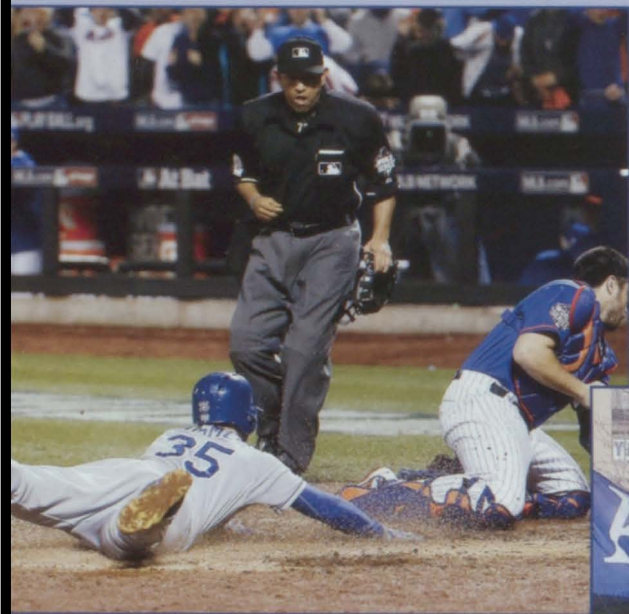
