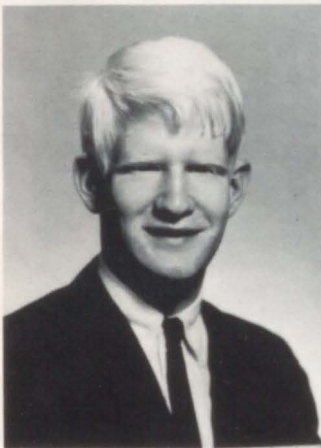
Student Body

At first, I have to admit, I was scared when I had to speak in front of a group about my homeland; but then all you people helped me so much by showing interest and encouraged me, by being usually a very lively audience. This year did not only help me in my knowledge of English, but most of all it helped me as a human being. It broadened my horizon, let me meet so many interesting people and made friends with them.

For all this let me just say thank you to everyone. AFS and a wonderful group of people is just all you need to be happy!

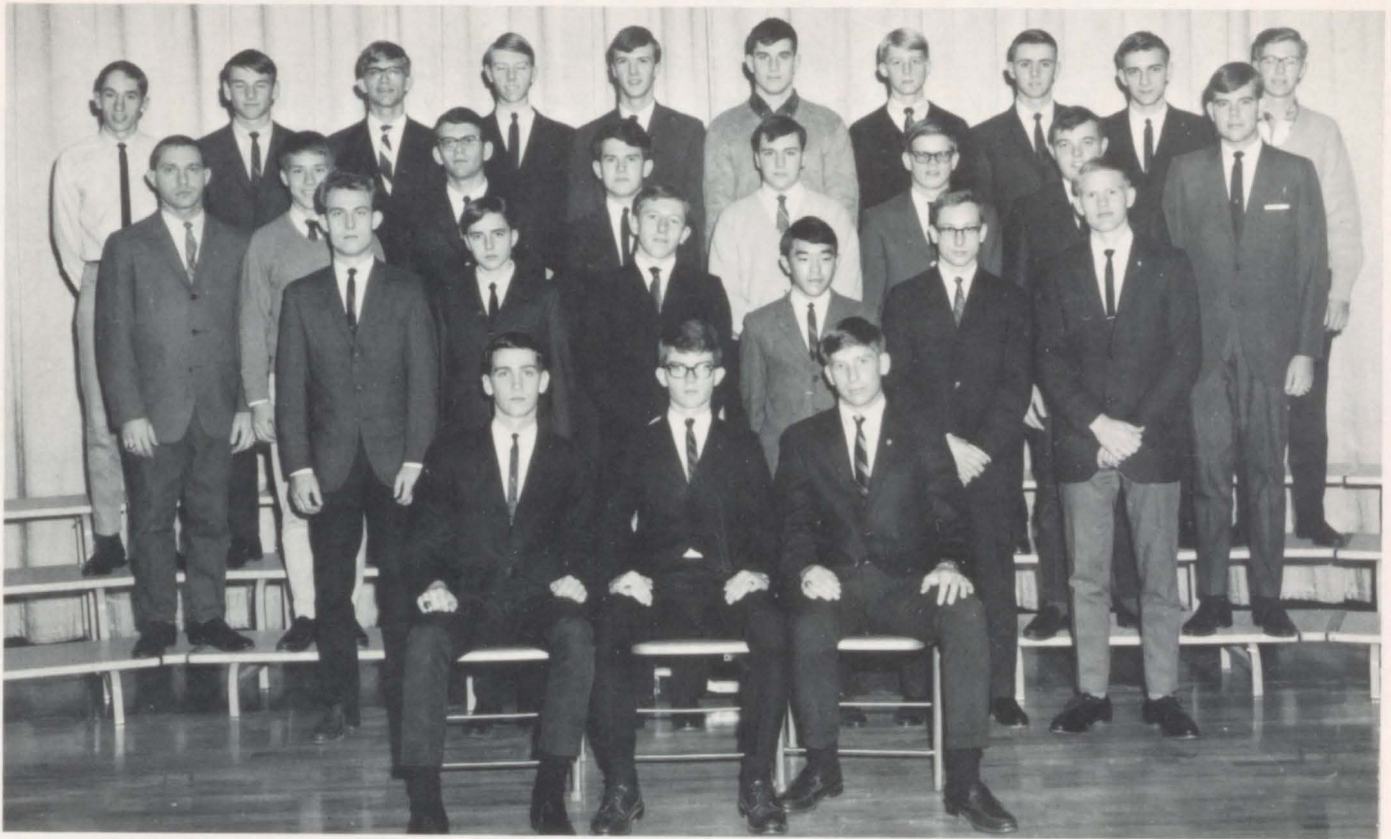



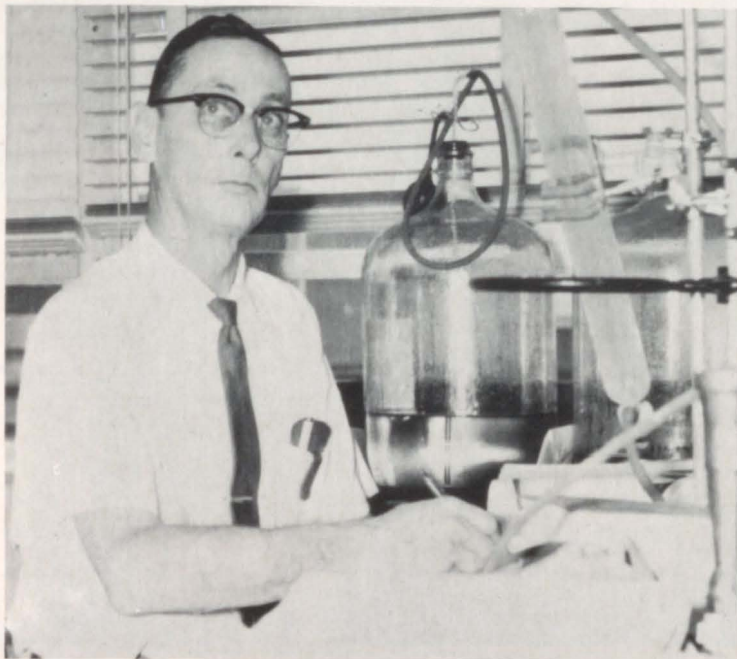

Aside from this duty, they sponsored the 1967 Basketball Homecoming entitled, "It Was a Very Good Year", and provided a merry Christmas for a needy family.

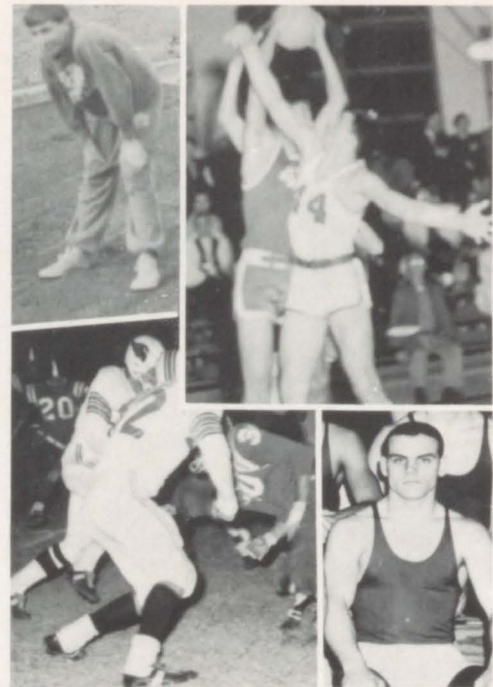
