Even though the student population has decreased, the same tremendous spirit remains. As you can see, we truly are small in number, but big in comparison.









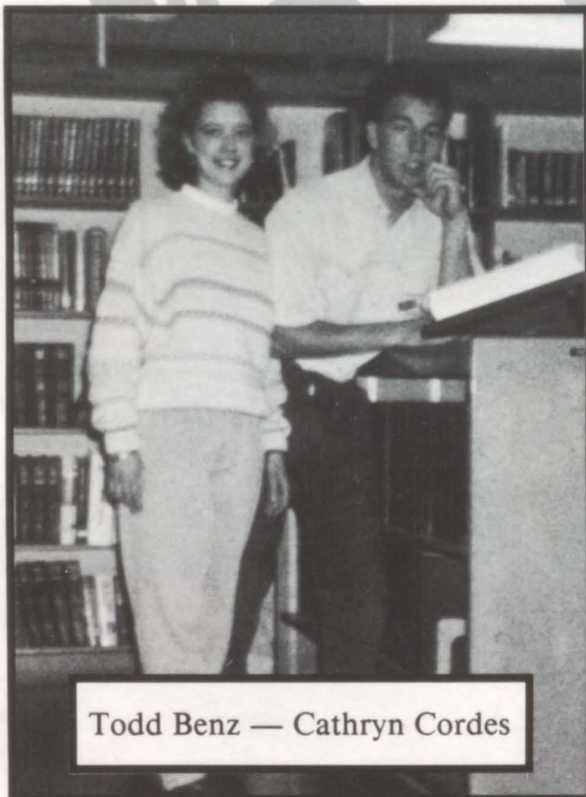

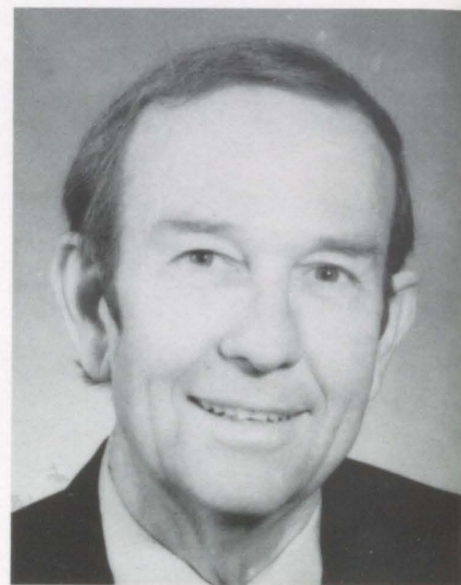


# DEDICATED TO COACH CHANDLER

Prior to the season coach Dick Chandler suffered a stroke and was not able to coach, but he remained a primary inspiration to the team.

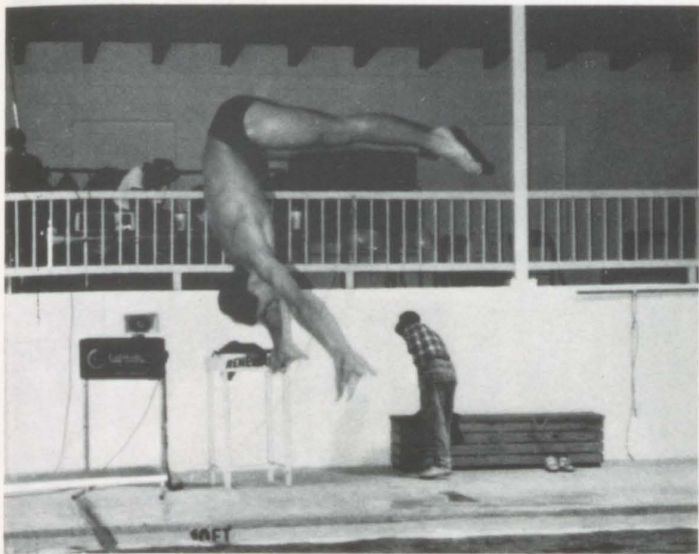
