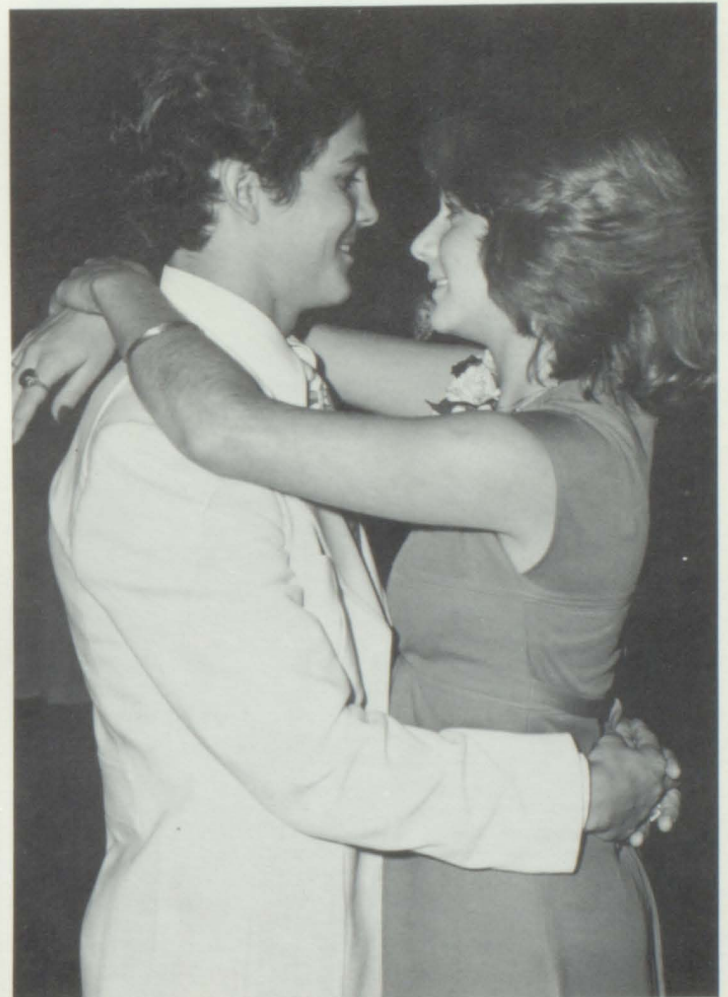






Teresian Dance

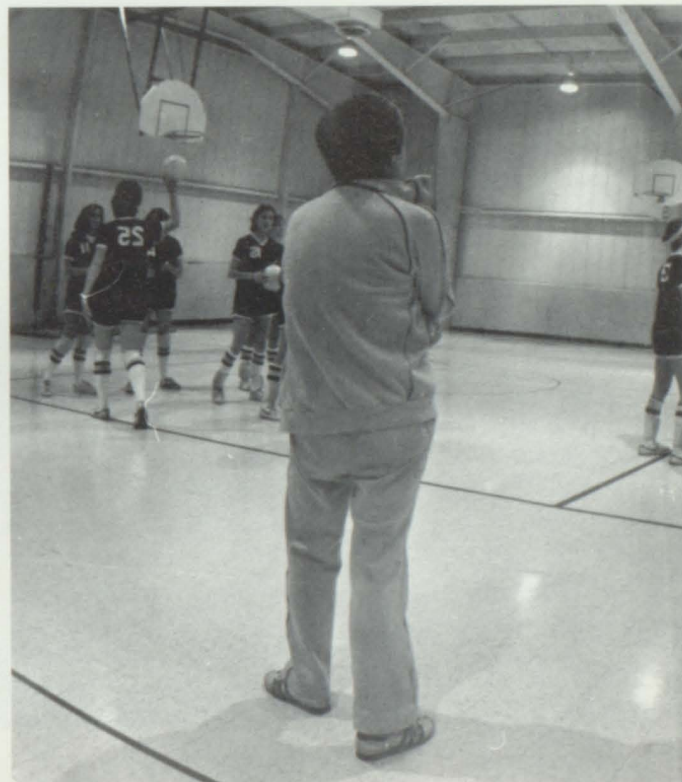
This year's athletics was composed of the volleyball, basketball, track, and tennis teams. The beginning of the school year brought a winning season to the varsity volleyball team. With Ms. Christenson coaching, Therese McNamara, Ellen Schleicher, Eileen McGraw, Sheila Lillis, Candy Anderson, Kathleen Meagher, Katie Geisel, Susan Coppinger and Chris Meagher powered their way to a 19-8 record. The team won 12 while losing only 3 during regular non-tournament play. The two other volleyball teams, the Junior-Varsity and the Freshmen, had very good seasons, also.

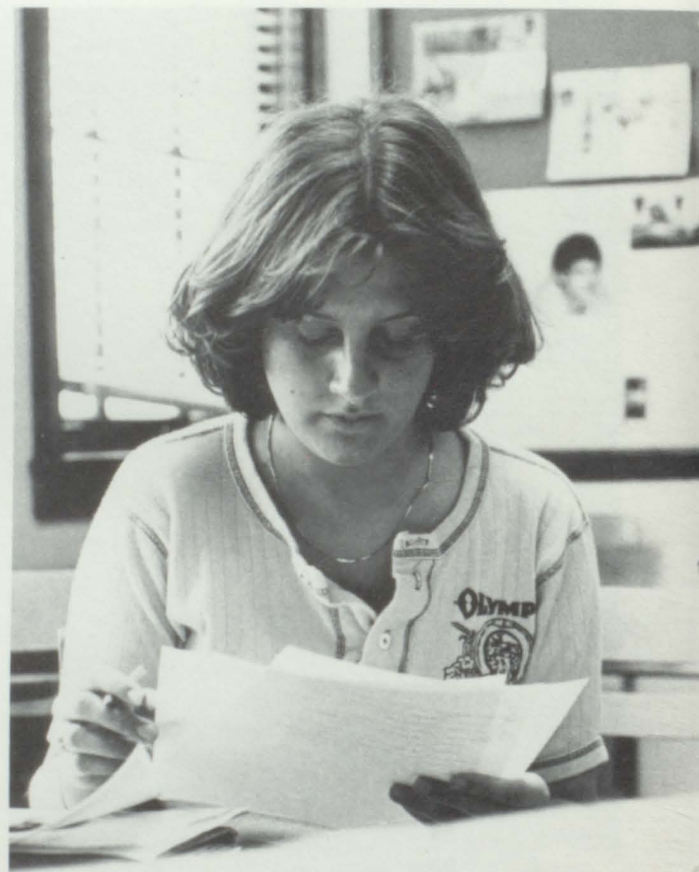
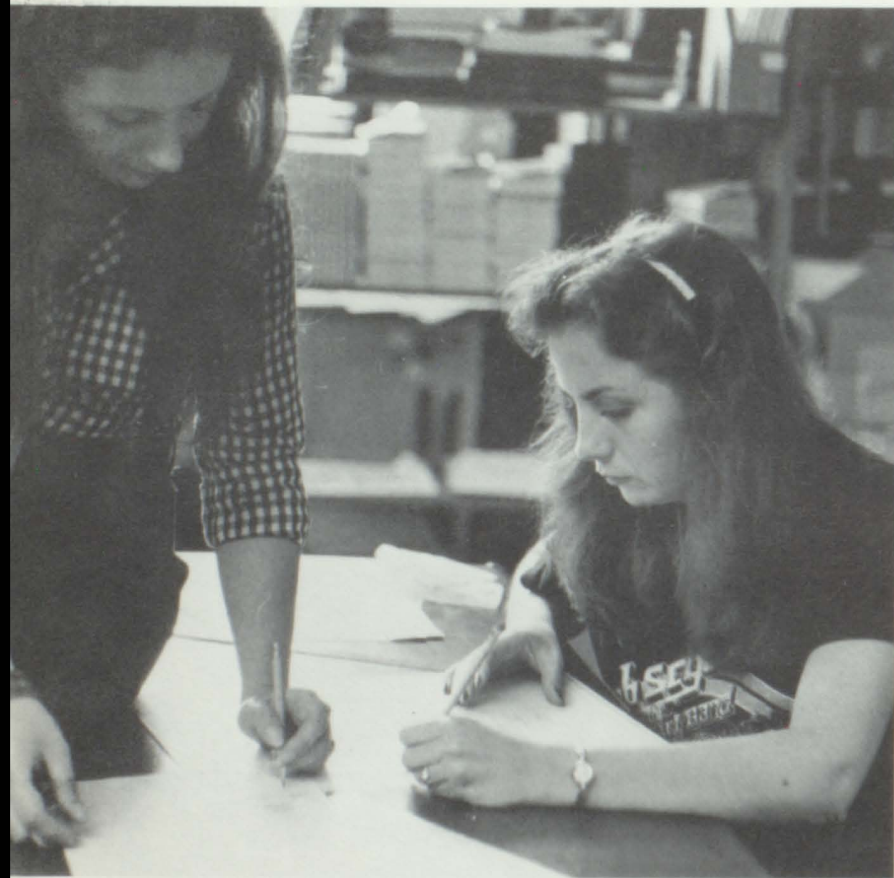
With the tallest member measuring only 5'8", the basketball team did a commendable job. Severely crippled by the height factor, the team still managed a 5-9 record against such teams as Northeast, Paseo, Lillis, Hogan, Sunset, Southwest, Shawnee Mission East, and Notre Dame de Sion. Laurie Smith, Sheila Lillis, Eileen McGraw, Ellen Schleicher, Karen Ireland, Meg Hare, Patty Culver and Liz Yancey formed the team. One star in the group proved to be Eileen McGraw. The fourth leading scorer in the city, Eileen averaged 15.7 points per game. The Junior-Varsity was able to make a good showing against its opponents.

Under the leadership of Ms. Scroggins, the tennis team turned in a remarkable performance. Matched against Winnetonka, St. Mary's, Notre Dame de Sion, Grandview, Shawnee Mission East, Hickman Mills, Barstow, Miego, Ward, Sunset, and Lillis, the team was able to stop many opponents with their serves, volleys, and returns.

The twenty-one members of the track team turned in an outstanding performance, recording two firsts, two seconds, one third and a fifth at their area meets. Three members of the dedicated group managed to qualify for the state competition at Columbia. Ann Cochran, running the 110, 220, and 440, returned home with a first and a second place. Judy Griffin, who repeatedly wiped out her competition in the area meets, qualified for the mile run. Susan Coppinger qualified in the long jump.

Overall the 1978-1979 athletic seasons were successful. The hard work and dedication of the coaches and players certainly paid off.

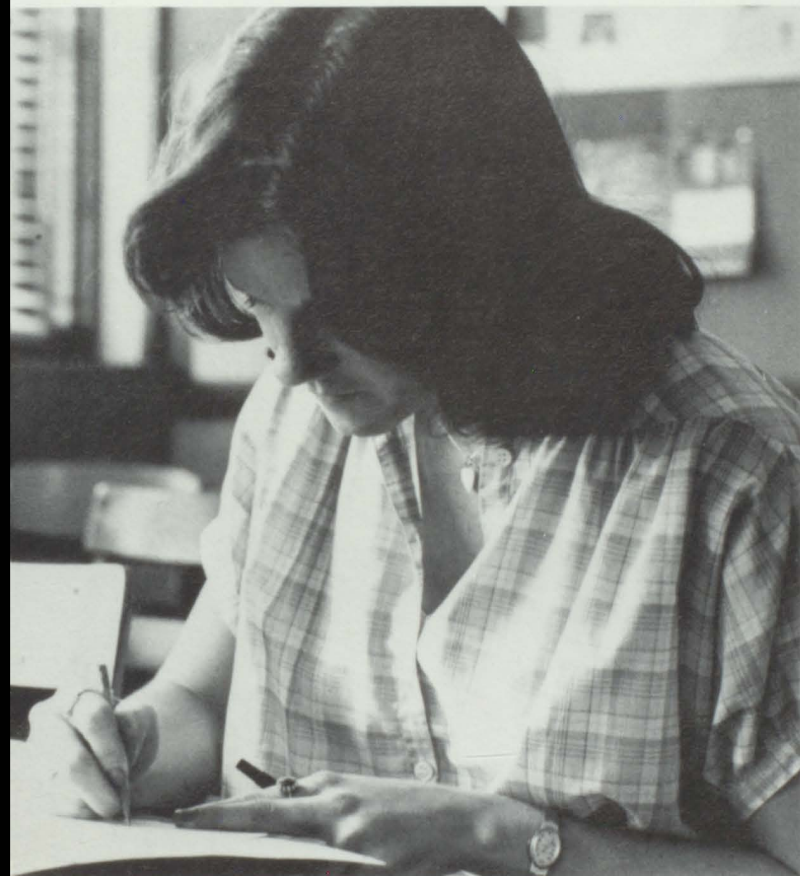


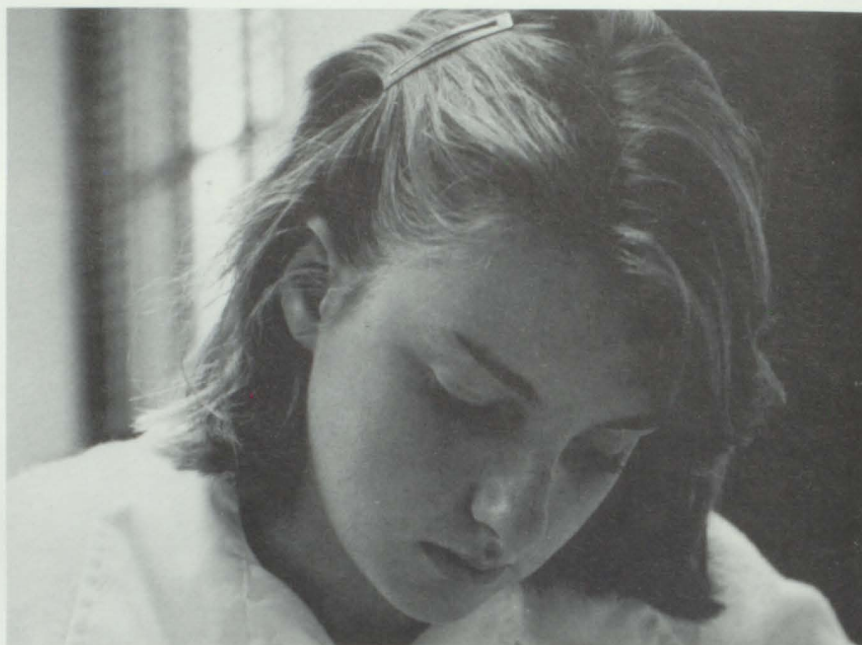

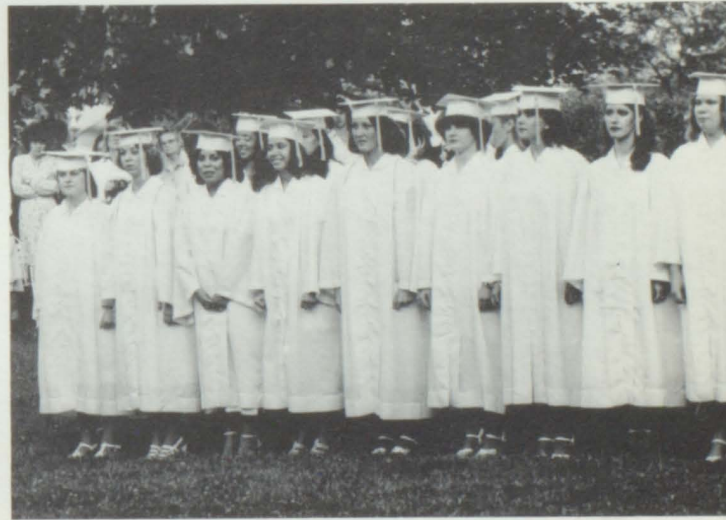
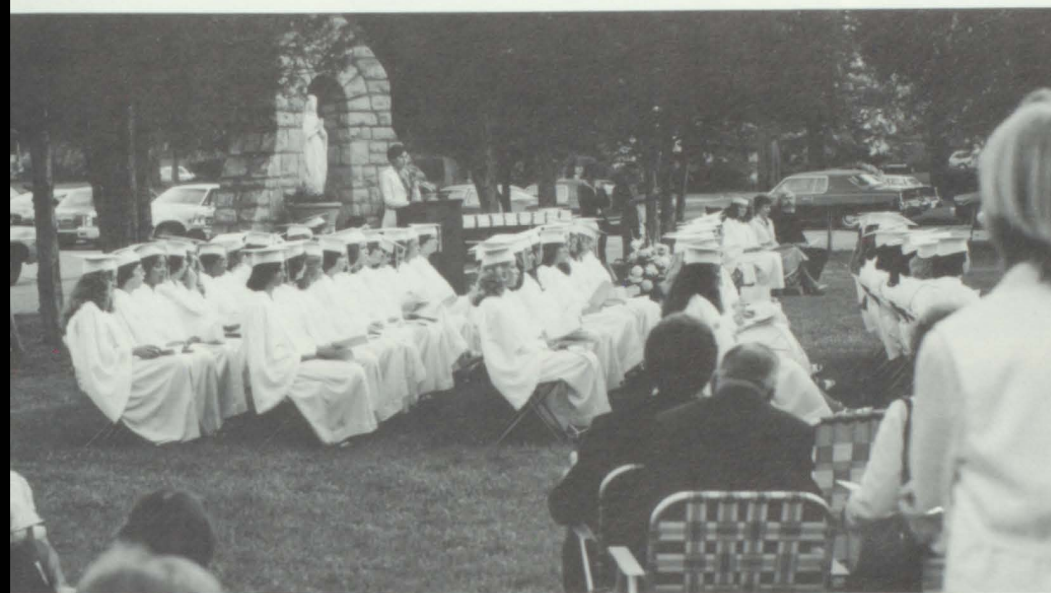


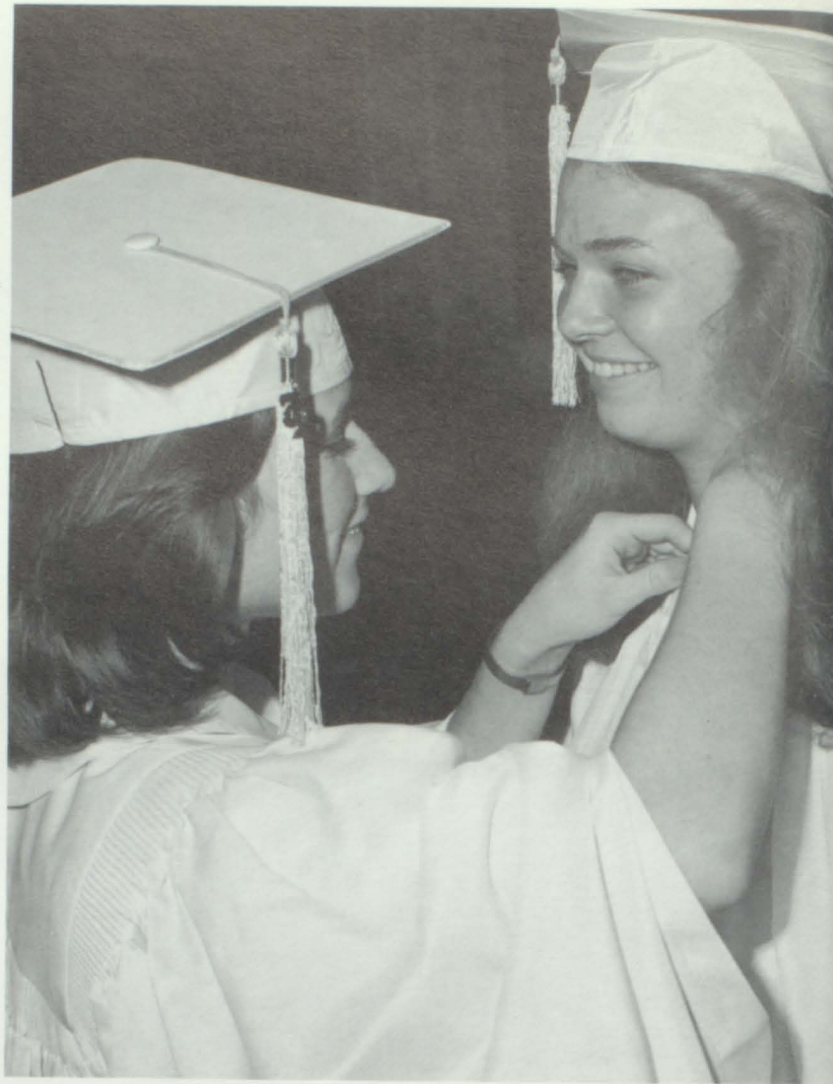


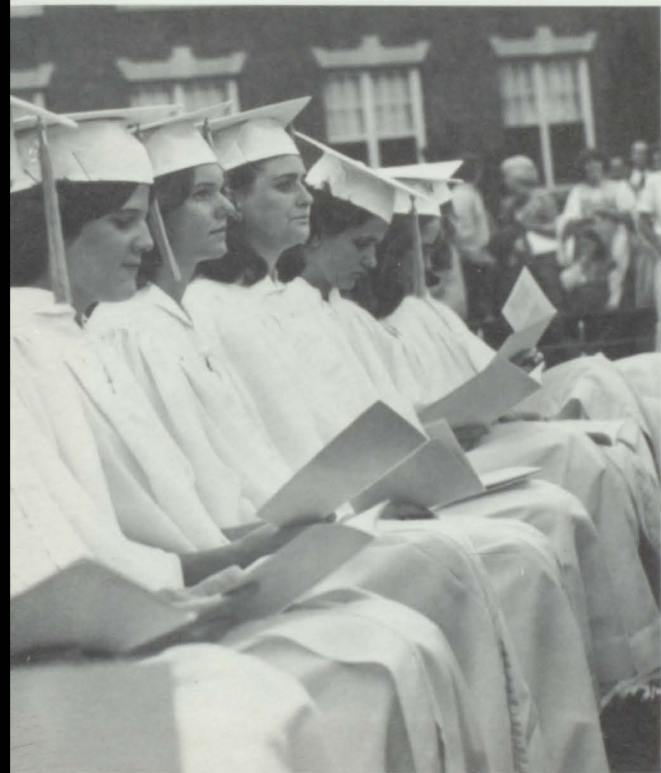


Graduation May 23, 1979
