The Citizens Bond Committee was founded in 1946 by the Citizens Regional Planning Council, a group made up of officials from Kansas City, MO; North Kansas City; Independence; and Kansas City, KS. The Committee's goal was to make recommendations on needed public improvements. They proposed sixteen projects to the Kansas City, MO city council, and in a special election in 1947 bond issues for all sixteen projects were approved.

Scope and Content Note

This collection consists of a booklet with photographs documenting public improvements of the 1947 Bond Program proposed by the Citizens Bond Committee. This booklet was donated with other Landmarks Commission materials but was created prior to the establishment of the Landmarks Commission in 1970.
